

# 210-9 Convertible Shawl

## Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Silk Silpalon [50% silk, 50% silpalon; 273 yds/ 250m per 1.76oz/50g cone]; color #6119 bronze; 3 cones [110g]
- 3.6mm knitting needles or size needed to achieve gauge; closest US needle size is US 4
- 2.5mm crochet hook or size needed to achieve gauge; US B or C is closest equivalent
- 4 buttons (15mm or 5/8 in)
- darning needle

## Knitting Tips

**Shawl:** use general cast on and knit according to chart.

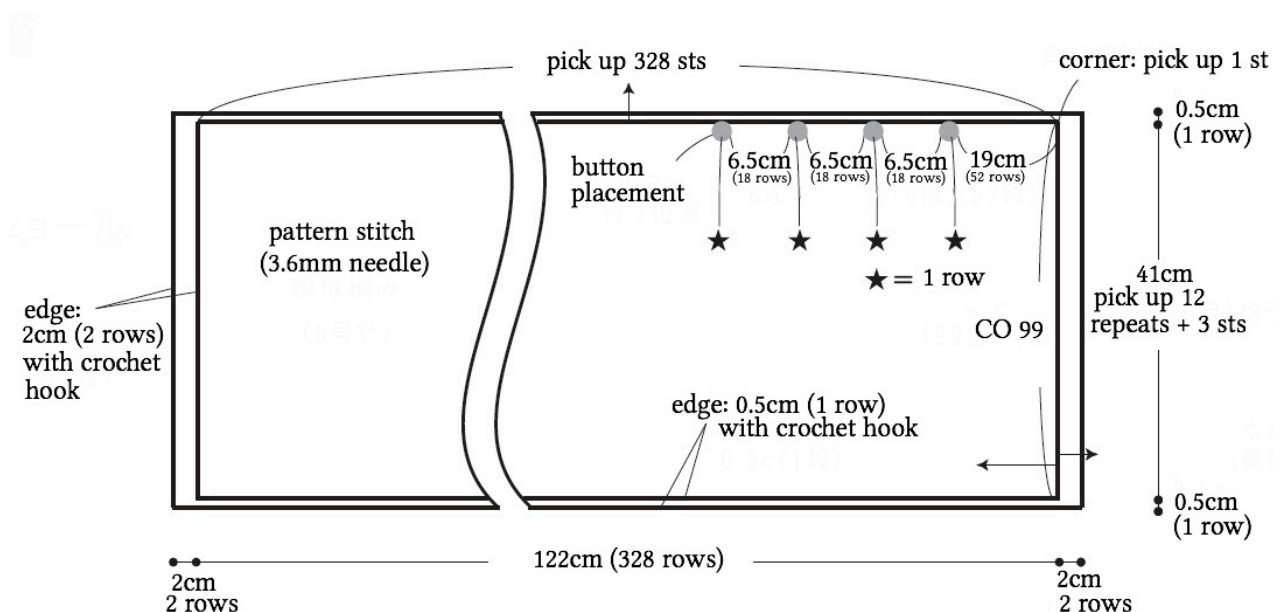
**Finishing:** work 1 round of crochet edging around shawl following schematic below. Crochet row 2 of edging along short edges of shawls *only*. Sew buttons to shawl in locations indicated in schematic. Use holes formed by stitch pattern as buttonholes.

## Gauge

- 24 st and 27 rows in 10cm of pattern stitch

## Finished measurements:

- width: 42cm/16.5in
- length: 126cm/49.6in



Use holes in the pattern stitch as buttonholes.
