
amikomo3-20 Mini Ornament Wall Hanging

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns ett [100% merino wool; 82 yds/75m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
 - hat: color #1 ivory; 1 skein [8g]
 - cardigan: color #2 mustard; 1 skein [15g]
 - purse:
 - color #3 American cherry; 1 skein [6g]
 - color #10 biscuit; 1 skein [2g]
 - scarf: color #8 aqua mint; 1 skein [7g]
 - dress:
 - color #11 Santa Fe; 1 skein [12g]
 - color #3 American cherry; small amount
- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook
- 1 meter/39.37" length of string or cord
- 7 mini clothespins
- 40cm/15.75" length of red ribbon (4mm wide)

Scarf

#8 aqua mint


• overall height 12cm/4.72"

Crochet Tips

Crochet each item and suspend from string (which is knotted at both ends) with mini clothespins.

Scarf

Make 2 of the same; whipstitch together. Make 2 pompoms (3cm/1.18" diameter) and fasten to each end.






Purse


Crochet body of bag according to schematics. Fold at row 12 and seam by working single crochet where shown. Attach strap where indicated by \star and attach buttons. With color #1 ivory, embroider a flower.

Body #3 American cherry




Hat

Create magic ring and crochet according to schematics. Work round 20 in crab stitch. Tie a 40cm/15.75" length of ribbon in a knot around hat. Fasten ribbon to hat to prevent ribbon from falling off.



Dress

Crochet two dress pieces and two straps according to schematics. Seam sides of dress from rows 1-24 using whipstitch. Seam straps to back of dress with whipstitch and sew buttons to front. Embroider row 4 with color #3 American cherry at 2-stitch intervals.



Cardigan

Referring to schematics, crochet 1 body and 2 sleeves. Join shoulders and sleeve undersides with whipstitch, then join sleeves to body with whipstitch. While working edging, make buttonholes. Fasten buttons.
