Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Tre [100% cotton; 98 yds/90m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #5 apricot pink; 1 skein [12g]
 - color #11 coffee brown; 1 skein [small amount]
- Pierrot Yarns Organic Cotton Chuboso [100% organic cotton; 77 yds/70m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; natural (undyed); 1 skein [10g]
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- darning needle
- small amount polyfill fiber stuffing (or scrap yarn)
- 1 plastic bell

Gauge

• single crochet (US): 20 sts and 21 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

• length 14cm/5.51"

Crochet Tips

* Head and body are worked with one strand of yarn. Wings and antennae are worked with yarn held double.

Head: Make magic ring and crochet in the round, inserting stuffing and plastic bell as you go.


Body: Make magic ring and crochet in the round. Fill with stuffing and seam body to head with darning needle.

Wings: Chain to cast on; crochet. Whipstitch to body with darning needle. Crochet antennae.

Finishing: Seam antennae to head. Embroider eyes and mouth.


