# amicomo7-10 Needle Case

#### Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Wash a la Mode [70% acrylic; 30% superwash wool; 138 yds/126m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #18 wine red; 2 skeins [75g]
  - color #19 crimson; 1 skein [25g]
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 button (30mm/1.18")
- 1 piece fabric for lining (40cm/15.75" by 110cm/43.31")
- tapestry needle

#### Gauge

• pattern stitch: 18 sts and 8.5 rows = 10cm/4" square

#### Finished measurements

- width 38cm/14.96"
- length 45cm/17.72"


### **Crochet Tips**


**Body**: Chain 65 with color #18 and crochet 35 rows in pattern stitch. Crochet 3 rounds of edging with color #19.

Lining: Referring to schematic, cut lining fabric.


**Finishing:** Sew lining to body with whipstitch. Crochet cord, leaf, and motifs; attach to needle case. Attach button.








### 2) Form seam allowance with iron.








### 3) Sew pockets to lining.

- 1. Arrange ② and ③ on top of ① and baste (i.e., sew temporary seam).
- Backstitch foundation of

   adjusting pockets as desired based on needle thickness.
