

amikomo-7 Cleaning Mitt

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Yuttari Acrylic [100% acrylic; 73 yds/67m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - frog:
 - color #84 saxe blue; 1 skein [32g]
 - color #81 white; 1 skein [6g]
 - color #93 dark charcoal gray; 1 skein [small amount]
 - bear:
 - color #85 honey sweet; 1 skein [25g]
 - color #90 cocoa; 1 skein [10g]
 - color #81 white; 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #93 dark charcoal gray; 1 skein [small amount]
 - pig:
 - color #83 smoke pink; 1 skein [35g]
 - color #81 white; 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #93 dark charcoal gray; 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #87 light red brown; 1 skein [small amount]

- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- tapestry needle

Gauge

- single crochet (US): 13 sts and 15.5 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- approximately 13cm/5.12" by 18cm/7.09"

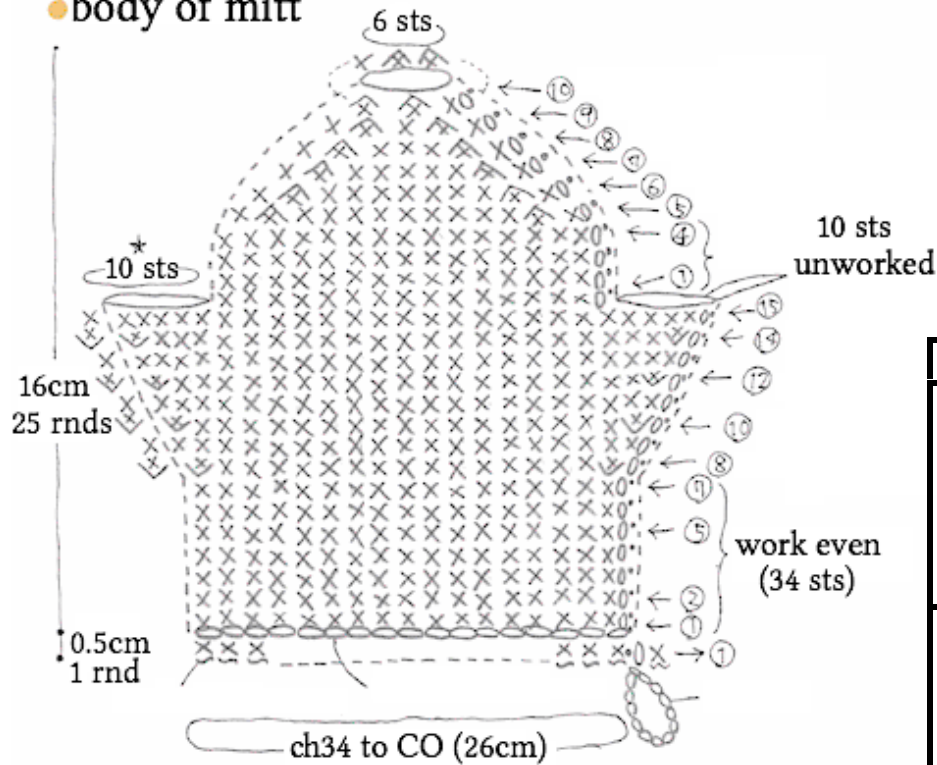
Crochet Tips

Chain 34 to cast on for body; join into round and work in single crochet (US). Work first 7 rounds even; starting from round 8, work through round 15, increasing according to schematics. Leave 10 stitches on each side unworked for hands, join remaining 30 stitches into the round, and work 4 rounds. Starting from the next round, decrease for 6 rounds. Seam remaining 6 stitches with chain seam. Using 10 stitches left unworked for hands, crochet 4 rounds, then cinch shut.

Crochet all required parts and attach to mitt. Embroider eyes and noses. Crochet edging using crab stitch. While working edging, chain 13 to create strap.

Abbreviations: m = magic ring; rnd = round(s)

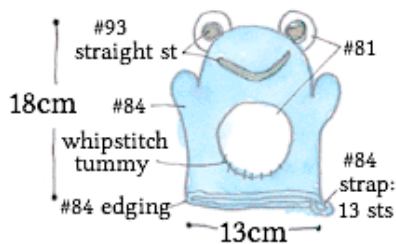

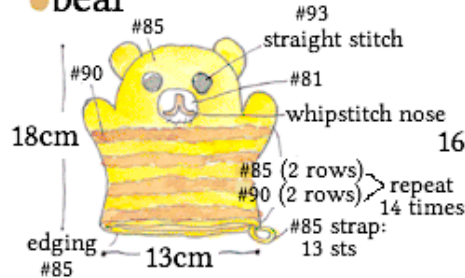
Crochet symbols

- ⊗ work 2 sc into same st

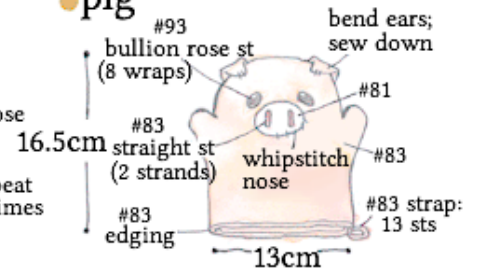

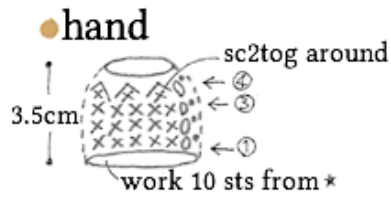

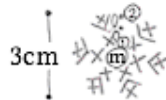




Rounds 1-3: work even (10 stitches)
 Round 4: sc2tog, repeat till end of round (leaving 5 stitches).

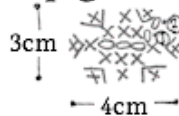
※Left and right hands are identical.

 Round 2: 12 stitches (+6 stitches)

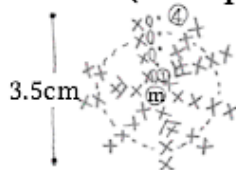
●pig's nose

 Round 2: 15 stitches (+7 stitches)

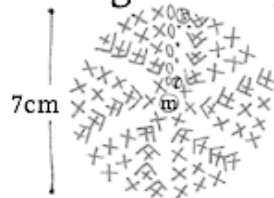
●ear (bear/pig), eye (frog)

 Rounds 3-4: 9 stitches (work even)

Round 1: 6 stitches
 Round 2: 12 stitches (+6 sts)
 Round 3: 18 stitches (+6 sts)
 Round 4: 24 stitches (+6 sts)
 Round 5: 30 stitches (+6 sts)
 Round 6: 36 stitches (+6 sts)
