# **Craft Cotton Tunic**

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#### Materials

- Keito-Zakka Stores Craft Cotton [60% cotton, 40% acrylic; 39 yds/36m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
  - kids' size: color #2 beige; 17 skeins [420g]
  - ladies' size: color #10 raw umber; 12 skeins [280g]
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

### Gauge

- pattern stitch B: 1 pattern repeat = 6.5cm/2.56" and 9.5 rows = 10cm/4"
- pattern stitch C: 22 sts and 12.5 rows = 10cm/4" square

#### Finished measurements

- kids' size: length 48.5cm/19.09"
- ladies' size: length 63cm/24.80"

### **Crochet Tips**


**Body**: Chain to cast on and work first row in bottom loops of chain. Crochet yoke in pattern stitch A. Working into last row of yoke, continue in pattern stitch B. Work 1 row of edging A along edge of yoke's foundation row. Work shoulder straps starting from edging of front body.

**Finishing**: Seam sides until start of armhole (see schematic) with slip/chain seam (see below). Join straps to back body with whipstitch seam. Work 1 round of edging B around hem.


**Abbreviations**: CO = cast on; R = row(s)/round(s)

**slip/chain seam:** essentially a slip stitch seam with chain stitches interspersed between slip stitches. Sl st through foundation row of both layers. \*ch2, sl st in top of next row\*, continue from \* to \* until end. (*Note:* use ch2 only for dc. Use ch1 for hdc, ch2 for dc, ch3 for treble, and so on.)
