

# 26-27-30 Baby Blanket



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Angel [100% superwash merino wool; 107 yds/98m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #5 lemon yellow, 6 skeins [230g]
  - color #1 white, 3 skeins [110g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- 91cm/35.83" square

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 16 sts and 21.5 rows
- double crochet (US): 16 sts and 8.5 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

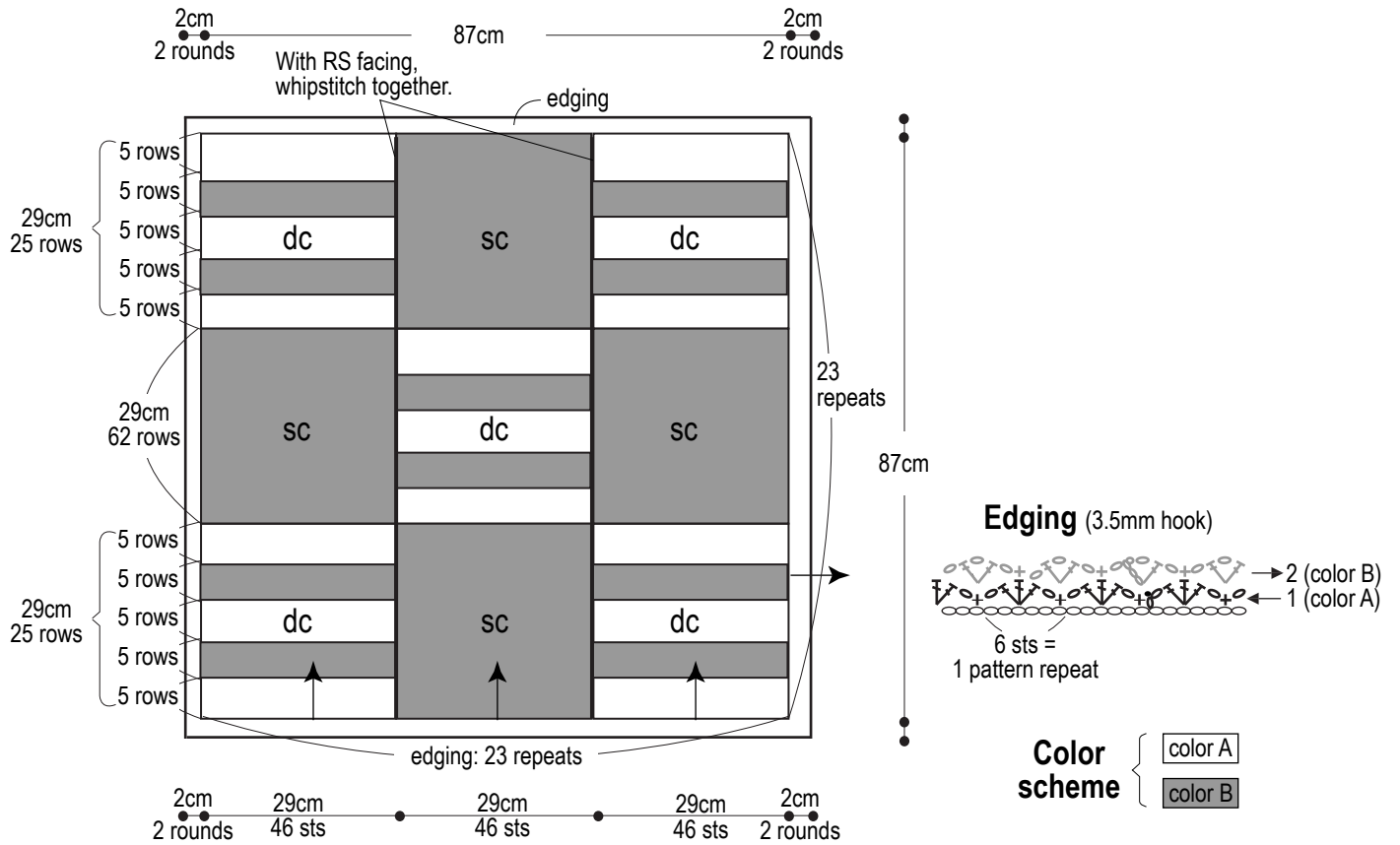
## Crochet Tips

Chain 46 to create foundation row, ch3 for turning post, and work 25 rows in double crochet (US), changing color every 5 rows. Continue with 62 rows of single crochet (US), then 25 more rows of double crochet (US). Make another piece identical to the first. Then make a third piece by working single crochet, then double crochet, then single crochet. With right sides facing, seam the three strips together with whipstitch. Work 2 rounds of edging, changing color for the second round.

## Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- dc = double crochet (US)
- sc = single crochet (US)
