

# 26-34 Cotton Lilian Hat



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Lilian [100% cotton; 101 yds/92m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #4, 2 skeins [70g]; discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute

## Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- head circumference 54cm/21.26"
- length 23cm/9.06"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 18 sts and 30 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

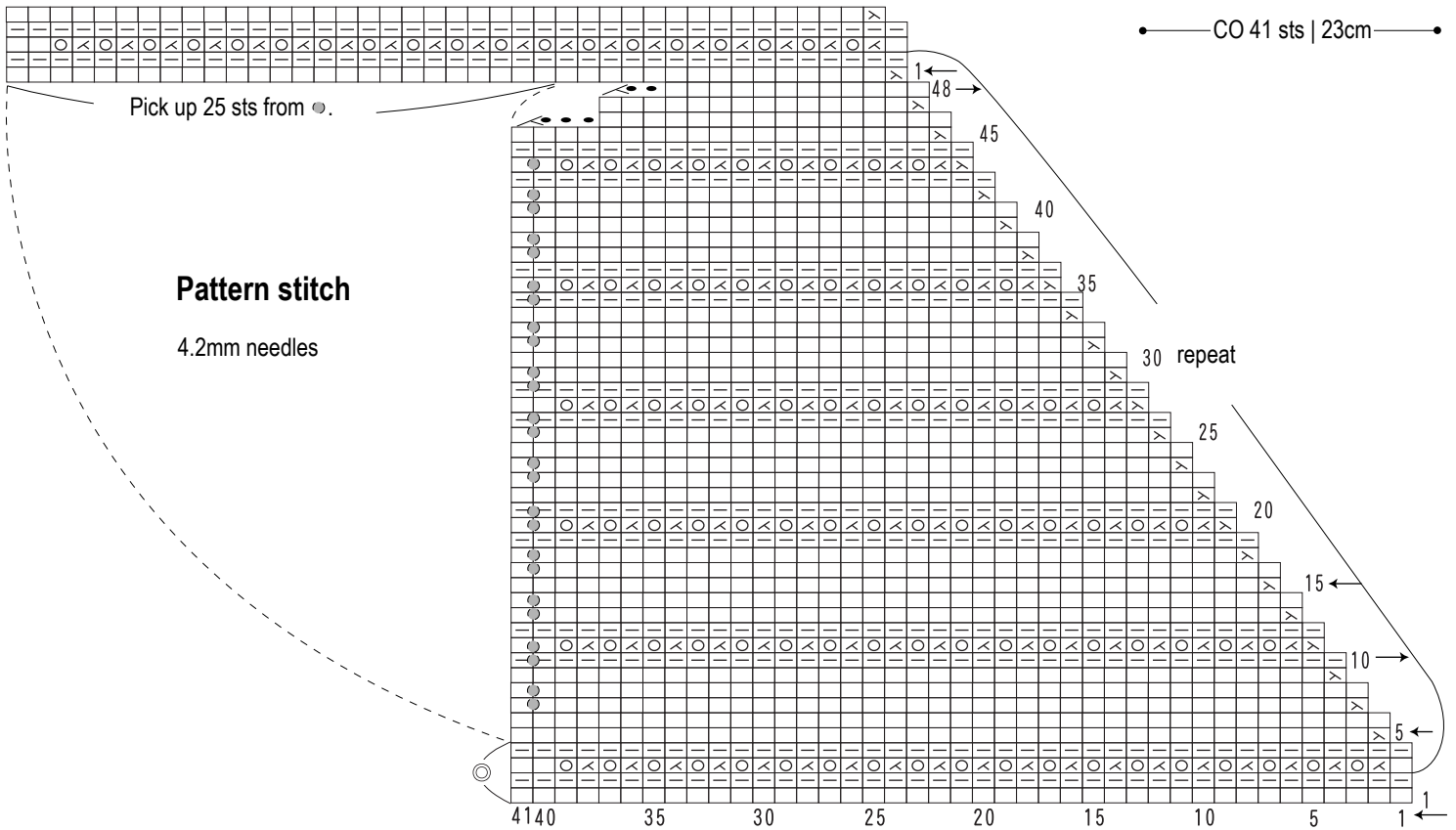
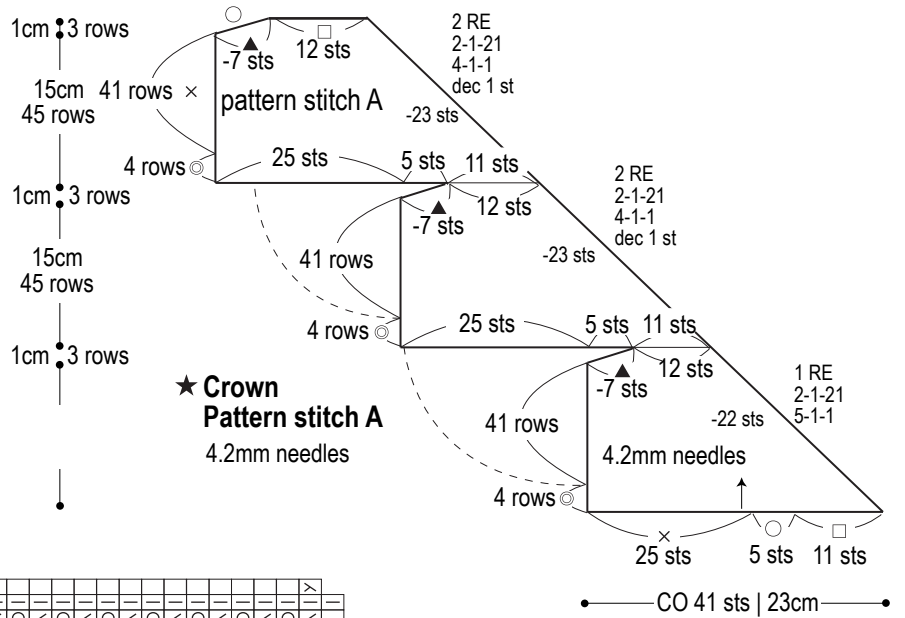
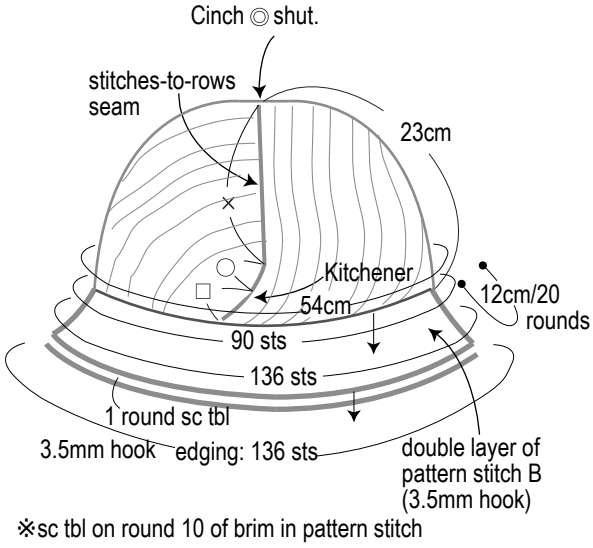
Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Knit 48 rows, decreasing as indicated in schematic. On row 49, decrease 1 stitch at right edge (to 11 sts), pick up 5 stitches from the 7 bound-off stitches, then pick up 25 stitches from the gray circle symbols along the edge. Work through row 96 in this manner. Work row 97 the same as row 49; continue to row 144. When finished, bind off in pattern while decreasing 1 stitch at right edge. Align 41 CO stitches to BO edge using symbols and seam together. Thread yarn through crown sections marked with ☉ and cinch shut. For brim, work 90 single crochet (US) stitches along slope of crown. Work 2 rounds while increasing and decreasing as indicated. At round 11, fold in two (towards the inside) and work single crochet (US) through back loop only. On wrong side, blindstitch end of brim to first round (of brim), forming a brim of two layers.

## Abbreviations:

- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- dec = decrease
- RE = row(s) even
- sc tbl = single crochet (US) through back loop only
- # # # = rows-stitches-times
