# 27-28-779KC Earflap Hat



#### Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns ett [100% superwash merino; 82 yds/75m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #6 black, 3 skeins [62g]
- Pierrot Yarns Fine Mall [100% nylon; 53 yds/48m per 1.41oz./40g skein]; color #78 dark steel/black/white gradation, 1 skein [12g]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

- 5.5mm (US I) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 black buttons (21mm/0.83" diameter)

#### Finished measurements:

- head circumference 44cm/17.32"
- length 16cm/6.30"

#### Gauge (10cm/4" square):

 No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Use hook and needle sizes necessary to yield a suitable fabric.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

#### **Crochet Tips**

Crochet hat according to schematics using 2 strands of ett held together. Continue to edging, but for visor section, work as follows: on round 3, work post stitches around dc stitches of round 2, alternating between front post dc and back post dc. On round 4, work slip stitch with wrong side facing, being careful to work the slip stitches along the visor edge loosely. Knit 2 earflaps according to schematics with 1 strand of Fine Mall.


Whipstitch earflaps to first round of edging. Attach buttons. Decide where buttonholes in earflaps should be based on button placement. Make a hole (by finding a spot between stitches) and, with 1 strand of Fine Mall, stitch around the hole to form a buttonhole. Thread 1 strand of Fine Mall through the sections of the hat worked in post stitch.

#### Abbreviations:

ch = chain


dc = double crochet (US)

sc = single crochet (US)
