

211-641s Julien Outing Shawl



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Julien [95% silk, 5% polyester; 192 yds/176m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #72 silver gray, 2 skeins [60g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 13cm/5.12"
- length 170cm/66.93"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- net stitch: 11.5 grid squares and 9 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Body of scarf: Chain to create foundation row, and work first row into bottom loops of chain. Work in net stitch pattern.

Pompoms: Create magic ring and work in single crochet (US). Leave a tail of about 30cm/11.81" after finishing. Insert polyfiber stuffing or scrap yarn into pompom, then thread yarn through last round and cinch shut tightly.

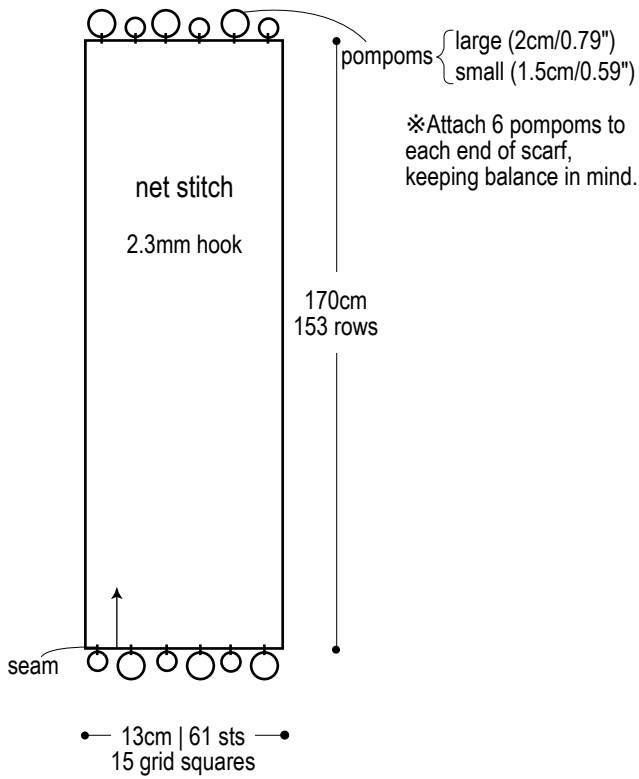
Finishing: Seam pompoms to body of scarf.

Abbreviations:

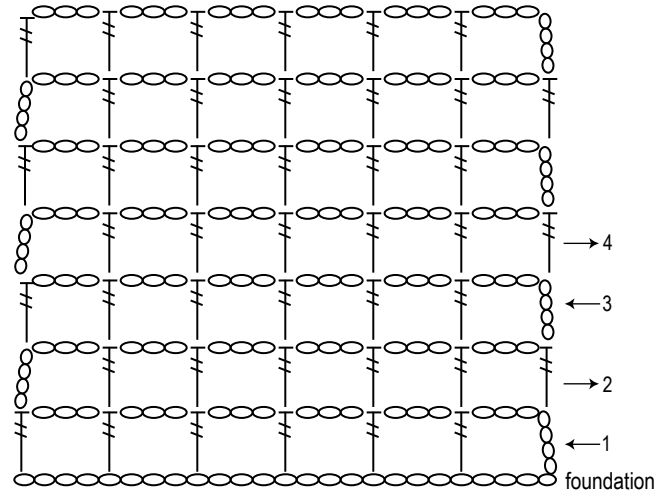
m = magic ring

sc = single crochet (US)

Body of scarf (2.3mm hook)

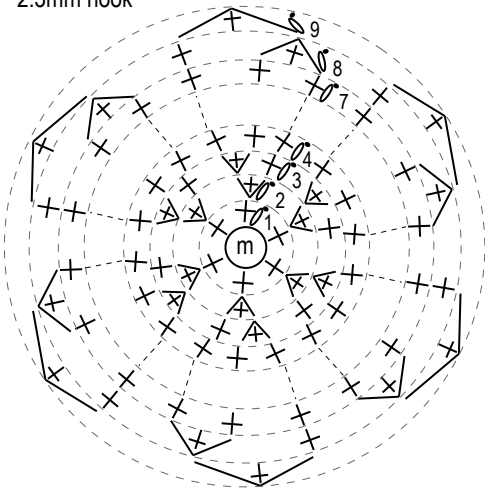


Net stitch (2.3mm hook)

2.3mm hook

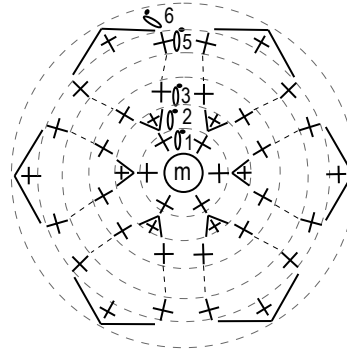

work even

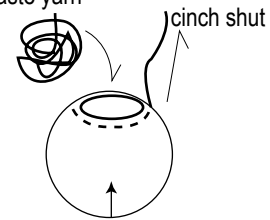
Small pompom (make 6)

2.3mm hook

1	6 sts (work 6sc into magic ring)

fiber fill stuffing
or waste yarn



Using 30cm/11.81" tail from binding off last round, thread through last round and cinch shut.
