

27-28-36 Fruit Tawashi



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Yuttari Acrylic [100% antibacterial deodorant acrylic; 73 yds/67m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - version A:
 - CC: color #90 cocoa, 1 skein [5g]
 - MC: color #91 dust brown, 1 skein [20g]
 - version B:
 - CC: color #88 light navy, 1 skein [5g]
 - MC: color #81 white, 1 skein [20g]
 - version C:
 - CC: color #83 smoke pink, 1 skein [5g]
 - MC: color #87 light red brown, 1 skein [20g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- height 7.5cm/2.95"
- width 7cm/2.76"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

No gauge information is provided in the original pattern.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

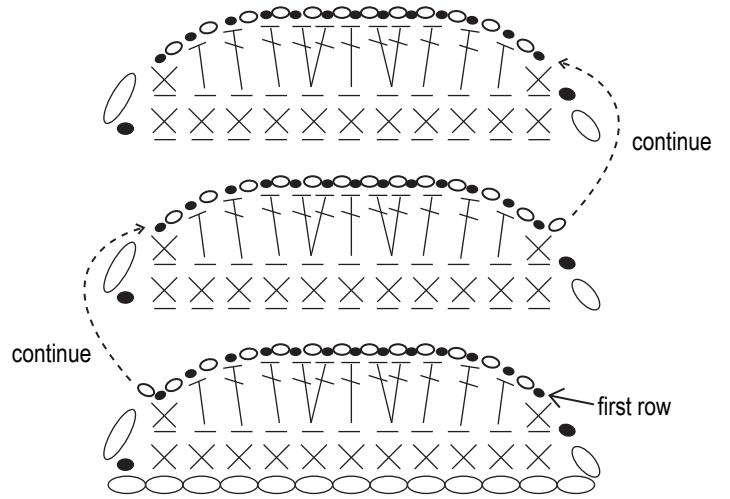
Scrubber: ch13 for hanging loop and join into ring. ch13 more and turn. On row 1, ch1 for turning post, sc 11, slip stitch 1. Work row 2 into front loops of previous row, referring to chart (ridge section). Turn ridge to other side for ridge 3; work sc into front loops of row 1. Continue in this pattern, making 14 ridges total. Bind off and cut yarn, leaving a tail long enough for seaming.

Finishing: Crochet edging along ridges of scrubber according to chart. Be sure not to cut yarn before moving on to next ridge; work across edge of next ridge. Seam first and last rows with whipstitch. Tuck yarn tails inside, then cinch each end shut by threading yarn through end stitches two times.

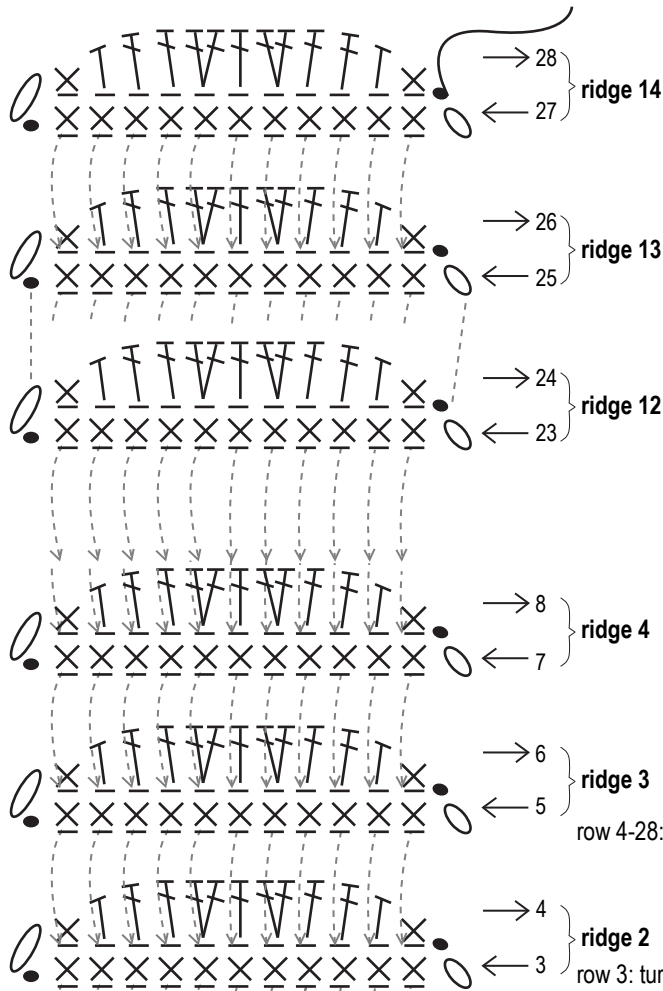
ch = chain
sc = single crochet (US)

Edging (CC)

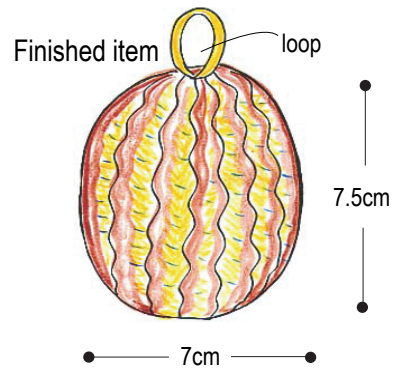
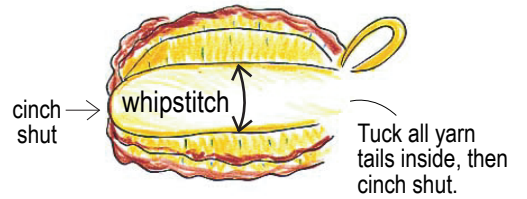


※Continue to next ridge without cutting yarn.

row 4-28: repeat rows 2 and 3.

row 3: turn ridge to other side; sc into front loops of row 1.

row 2: work into front loops of previous row (refer to chart)

ridge 1

row 1: ch13 for and join in the round to form loop. ch13 more, ch1 for turning post, then sc 11 into top loop of chain stitches.
