

211F-31 Nursing Poncho



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Marshmallow Cotton [100% cotton; 153 yds/140m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; 11 skeins [310g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) and 4.2mm (approx. US 6) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) and 4.2mm (approx. US 6) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- 2 snaps (12mm/0.47")

Finished measurements:

- length 46.5cm/18.31"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 21 sts and 26.5 rows
- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 31 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 27 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body and front panel: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in k1p1 ribbing followed by stockinette stitch. At body and front sides where marked with ☆, purl third stitch from edge. Work fully fashioned decrease 4 stitches in from edge. Seam body with mattress stitch (which will result in a decrease of 2 stitches).

Yoke: Pick stitches around top of body and front panel (overlapped by 12 stitches where indicated). Work pattern stitch in the round with evenly spaced decreases. Pick up stitches from pattern stitch and work in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Fasten snaps to ribbed part of hem where indicated.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

C6F = cable 6 front (Slip 3 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of work. k2 from left needle, k3 from cable needle.)

CO = cast on

dec = decrease

DPNs = double-pointed needles

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

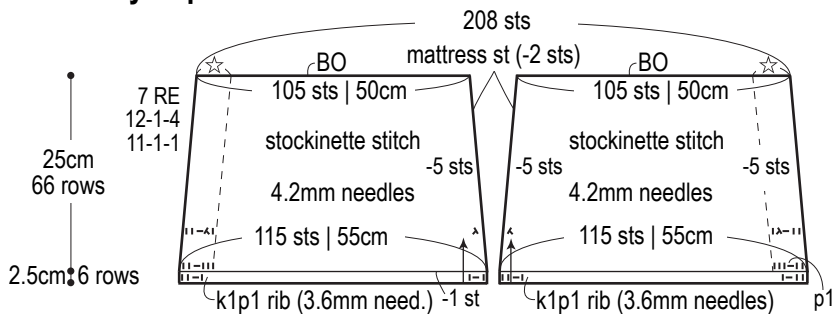
rep = pattern repeat(s)

ssk = slip, slip, knit

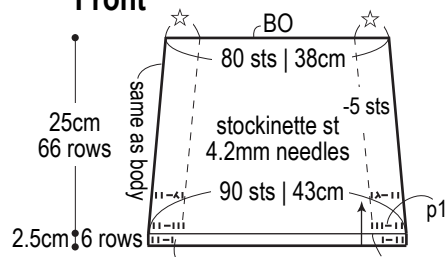
= rows-stitches-times [for decreases worked at edges]

= rows-places-stitches-times [for evenly spaced decreases worked across entire width of an item]

CO 116 sts

CO 115 sts

CO 91 sts

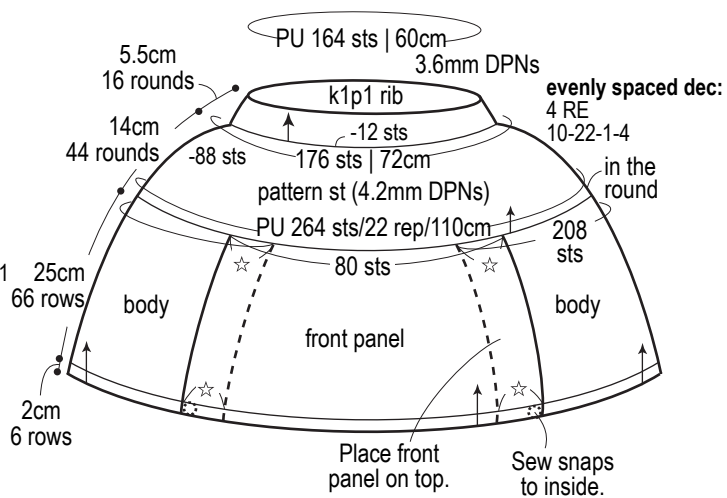
☆ = overlap by 6cm (12 sts)

※Overlap body and front panel by 12 sts (indicated by ☆), then pick up stitches and begin workings in the round.

Body & front panel:

- 7 RE = work 7 rows even
- 12-1-4 = every 12 rows, dec 1 st; rep 4 times
- 11-1-1 = every 11 rows, dec 1 st; rep 1 time

Yoke



Yoke:

- 4 RE = work 4 rounds even
- 10-22-1-4 = every 10 rounds, dec 1 st at each of 22 evenly spaced locations; rep 4 times

Place front panel on top. Sew snaps to inside.

Pattern stitch (4.2mm double-pointed needles)
