

amicomo9-5 Arles Patterned Mittens



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Arles Fingering [100% baby alpaca; 117 yds/107m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #02 light beige, 2 skeins [45g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- palm circumference 20cm/7.87"
- length 22.5cm/8.86"



Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US) through back loop only: 24 sts and 24 rows
- double crochet (US): 24 sts and 10 rows
- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 10 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Body of mitten: Chain to cast on and work sc tbl (US) in the round. Work palm side in dc (US) and back of hand in pattern stitch. With separate piece of yarn, ch8 and reserve for later. When working palm of hand, insert the 8-st chain, forming a hole for the thumb. Seam the parts marked with ☆ with whipstitch.


Thumb: Working into palm of hand and 8-st chain segment, work dc in the round. Thread yarn through last stitches and cinch shut.

※Reverse shaping for left mitten.


Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- dc = double crochet (US)
- hdc = half double crochet (US)
- sc = single crochet (US)
- tbl = through back loop only

Right mitten (3.0mm hook)




Thumb (3.0mm hook)



— = ch8 (in advance)


*Reverse shaping for left mitten.

Thumb instructions (3.0mm hook)




Finishing


Align ☆ and seam with whipstitch.

Bobble instructions (5 hdc)



- Just as for a regular 5 hdc bobble, work 5 incomplete hdc into a single stitch, then draw yarn through all loops on hook as pictured at left.



2. Slip stitch through the two loops already on the hook.
