

211s-15 Sawayaka Cotton Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Sawayaka Cotton [100% cotton; 416 yds/380m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #5 light gray, 2 cones [180g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- center back neck-to-cuff 23.5cm/9.25"
- length 53cm/20.87"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 22 sts and 12 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Front & back body: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Work in pattern stitch A, referring to schematic.

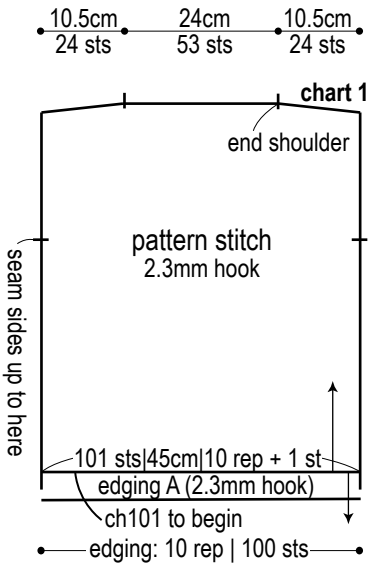
Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain and sc stitches as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sides with chain seam up marker for armholes.

※As the front is longer than the back, the front shoulders overlap to the back side, where they should be seamed (see chart). Work edging B in the round around neckline and armholes. Work edging A in the round around hem edge.

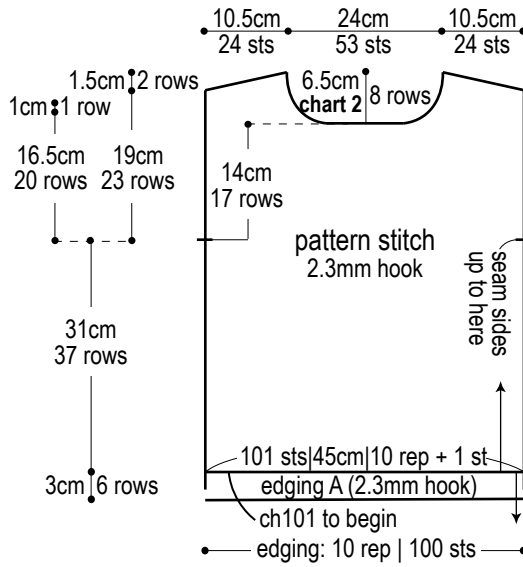
Abbreviations:

- sc = single crochet (US)

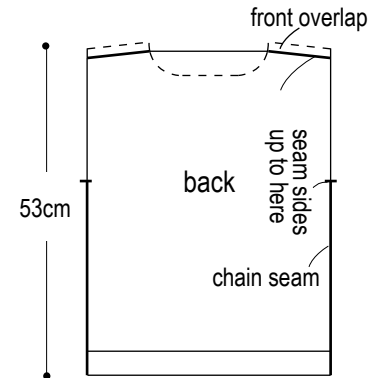
Back



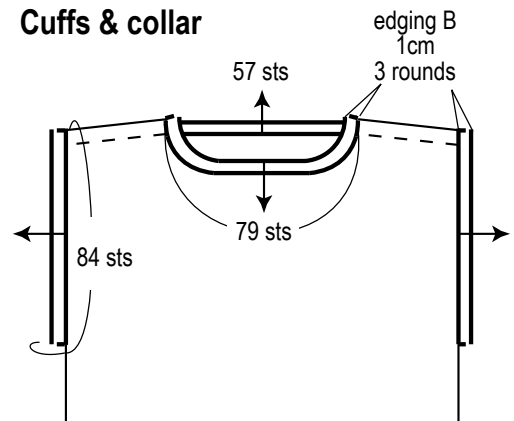
Front



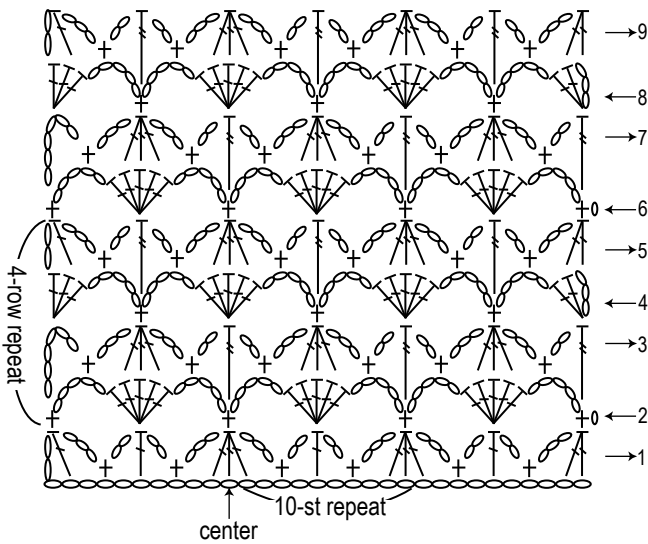
Seaming shoulders & sides



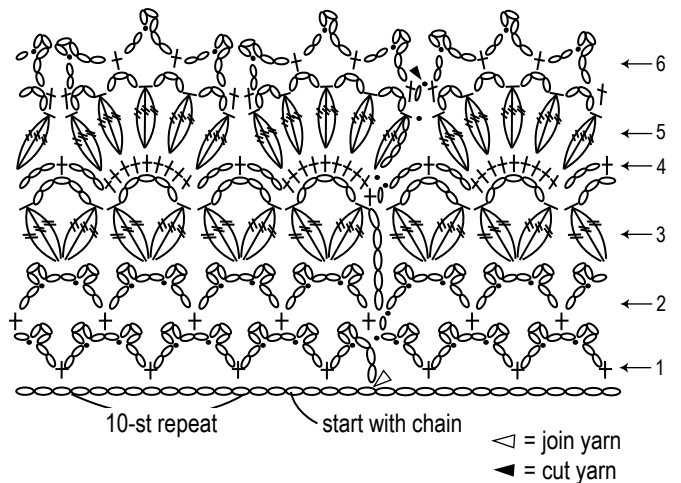
Cuffs & collar



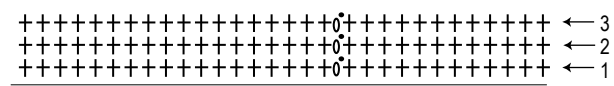
Pattern stitch (2.3mm hook)



Edging A (2.3mm hook)

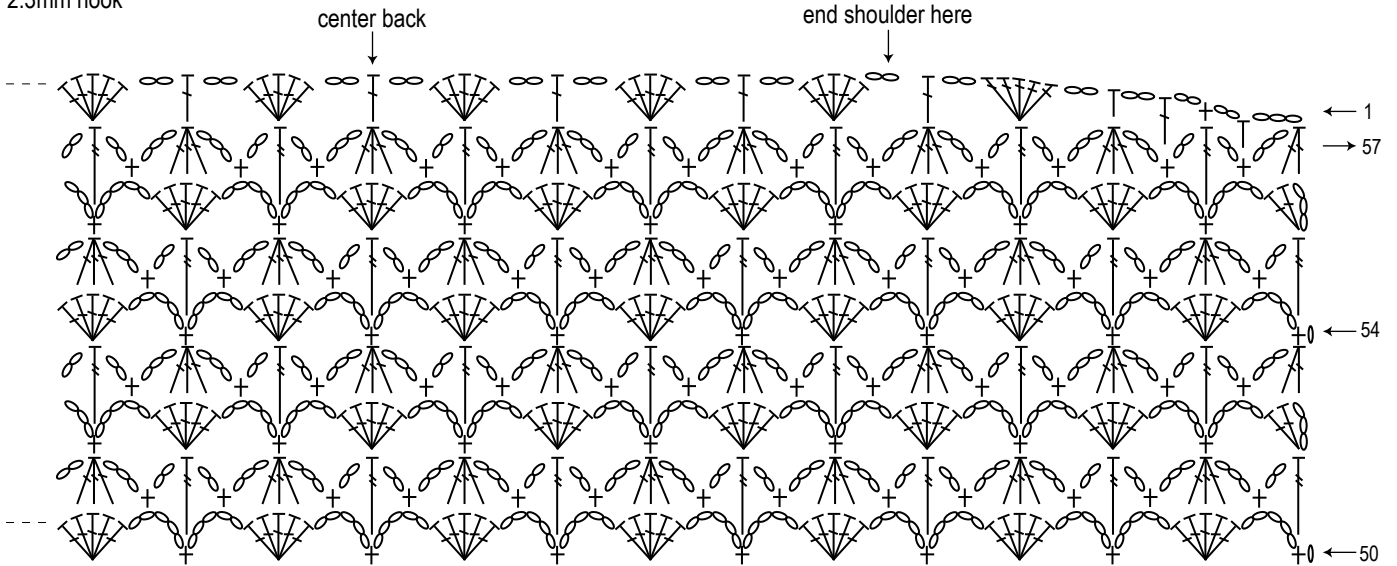


Edging B: sc (2.3mm hook)
