

212s-16 Fresco Lino Collars



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns New Fresco Lino Fine [100% linen; 164 yds/150m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
 - version A: color #101 off-white, 1 skein [30g]
 - version B: color #109 sand beige, 1 skein [35g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- Please see schematics.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

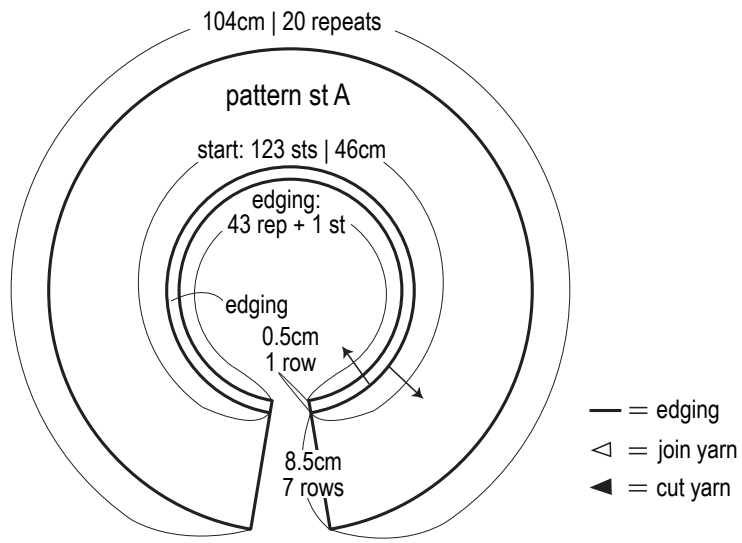
Version A: Chain to begin, and working first row into bottom loops of chain, work in pattern stitch A. Work edging A along cast-on row (first row). For cord, start by creating magic ring and crocheting decorations, then continue by making cord from chain stitches. Thread cord through collar where shown, then work second decoration and attach to end of cord.

Version B: Chain to begin, and working first row into bottom loops of chain, work in pattern stitch B. Join yarn and crochet button loop where shown. Make amigurumi button starting with magic ring; fasten to collar where shown.

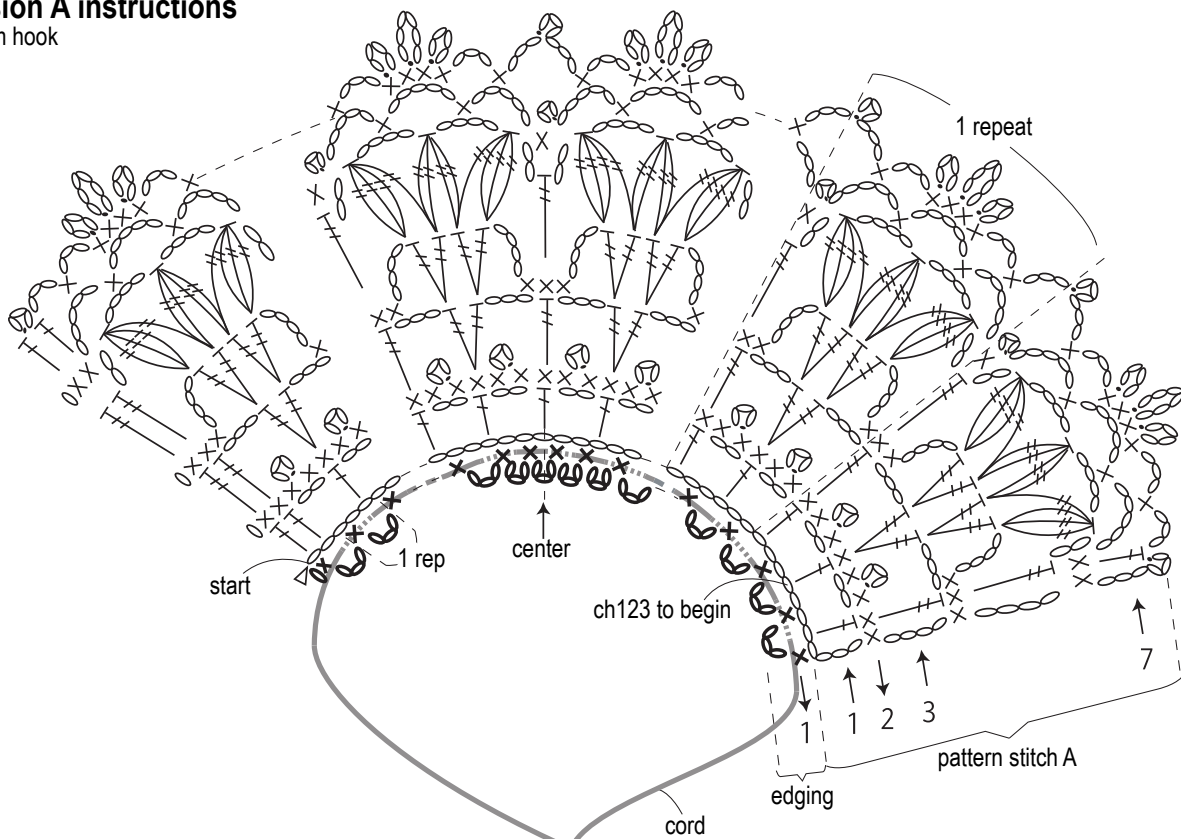
Abbreviations:

ch = chain
m = magic ring
sc = single crochet (US)

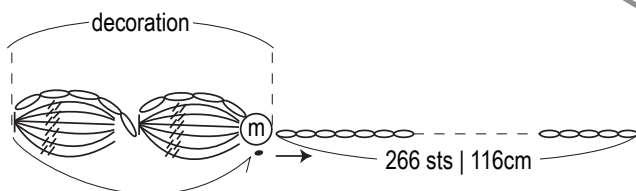

2.3mm hook

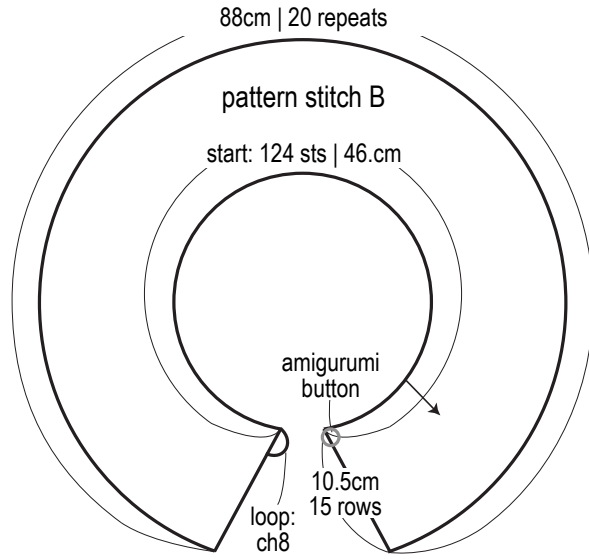


※After crocheting the first decorative end, work cord in chain stitch. After threading cord through collar, crochet second decorative end and attach to end of cord.

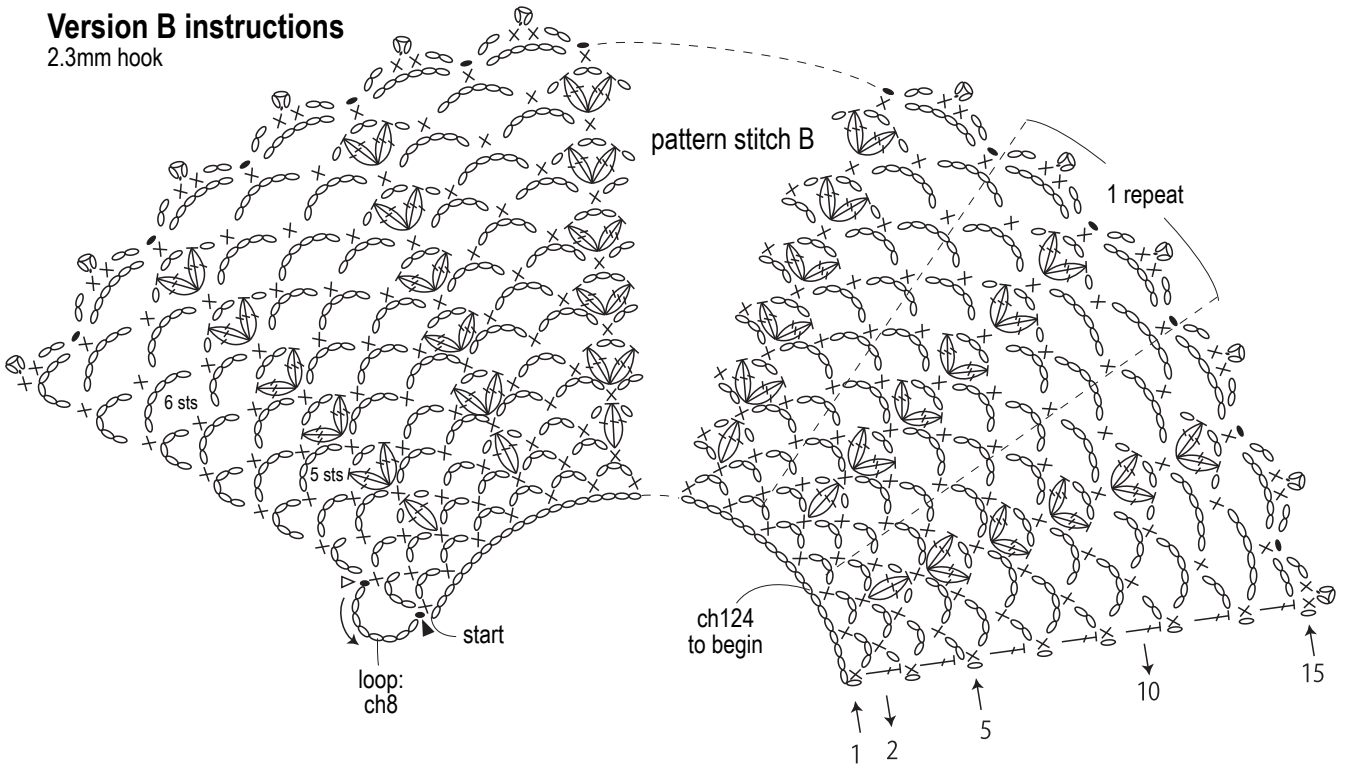
Attach decorations after threading cord through collar.

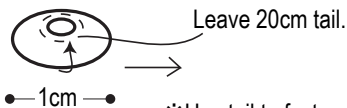

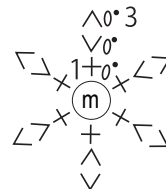


Amigurumi button
