

# amicomo10-5 Flower Corsage



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amian [100% washable Japanese paper; 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #21 ivory, 1 skein [10g]
- Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% cotton, 10% silk; 180 yds/165m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #01 white, 1 skein [5g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3 pearl beads (8mm/0.31")
- safety pin or hairpin

## Finished measurements:

- Please see schematics.

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge is provided in the original pattern. It is unimportant for this pattern.

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Crochet Tips

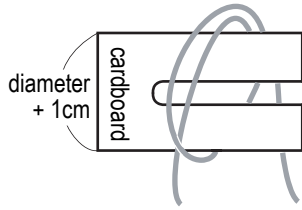
Make flower bases with Amian and Beauty Silk Cotton. Crochet flower motif, backing and fringe according to charts with Beauty Silk Cotton. Seam backing to wrong side of flower base. Sew flower motif and beads to right side of flower base. Attach fringe, fanned out as desired.

## Abbreviations:

m = magic ring

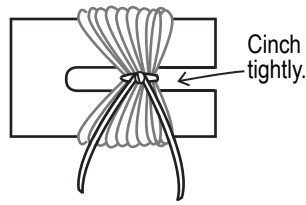
## ◆ Flower Base ◆

① Wrap Amian & Beauty Silk Cotton around 60 times each.

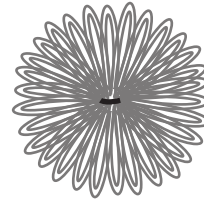


- Amian: 9.5cm diameter
- Beauty Silk Cotton: 6.5cm diameter

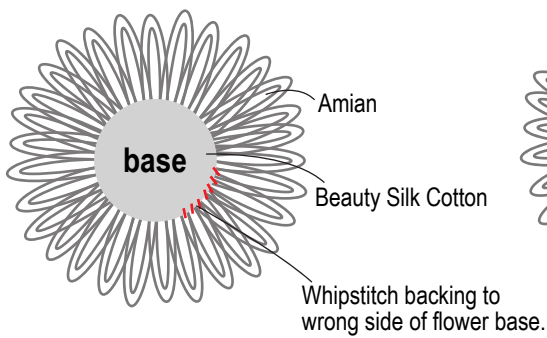
② Cinch at center.



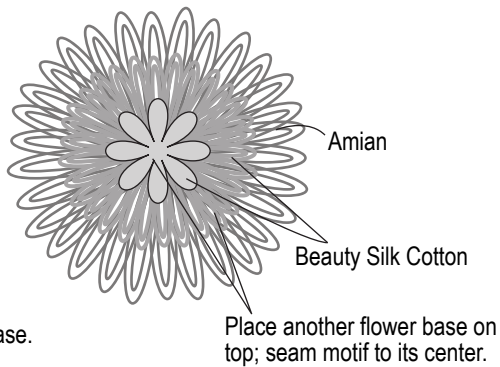
③ Make round.



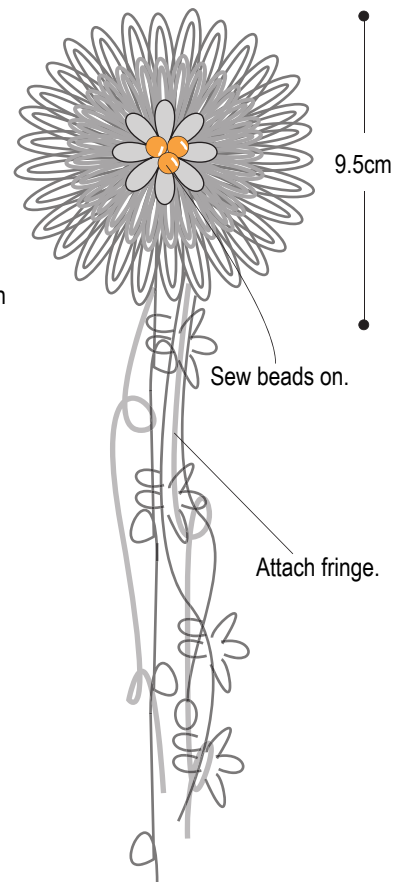
### Back side of corsage



### Front side of corsage

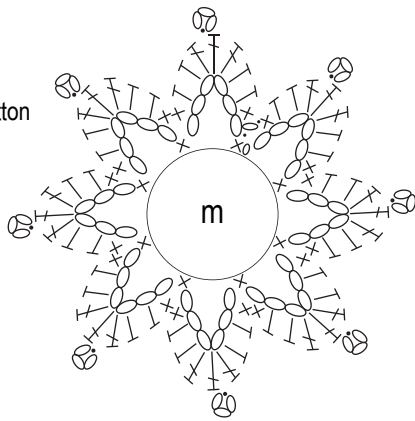

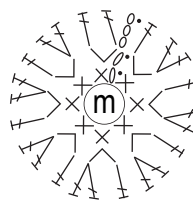
### Motif

Beauty Silk Cotton



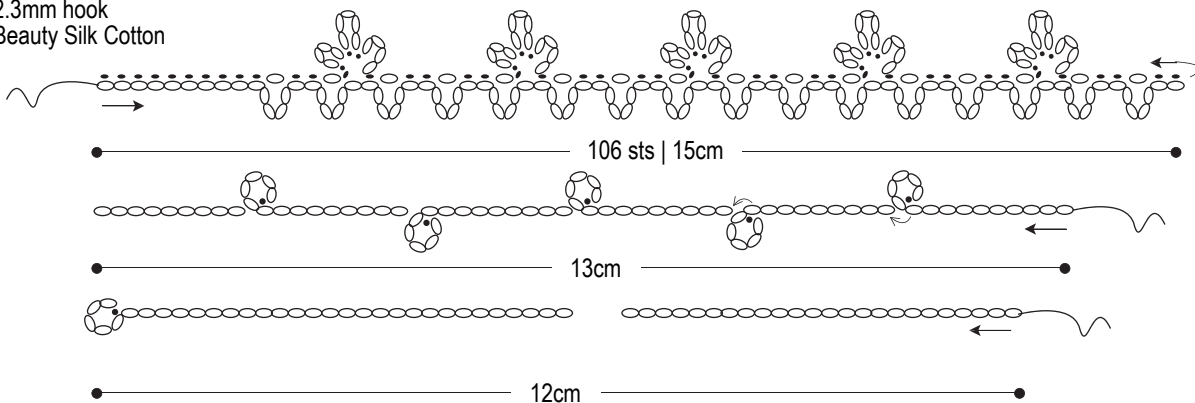
### Backing
