

Honnori Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Honnori Tetsumugi Kibun [51% rayon, 49% cotton; 71 yds/65m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - small bag: color #04 blueberry, 3 skeins [90g]
 - large bag: color #13 matcha, 7 skeins [263g]

Tools/Notions:

- small bag: 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- large bag: 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- decorative buttons
 - small bag: 3 floral buttons (20mm/0.79")
 - large bag: 3 sheep buttons (18mm/0.71")

Finished measurements:

- small bag:
 - width 28cm/11.02"
 - depth 14cm/5.51"
- large bag:
 - width 35cm/13.78"
 - depth 18cm/7.09"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch with 3.0mm hook: 12.5 sts and 12 rows
- pattern stitch with 4.0mm hook: 15 sts and 9 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

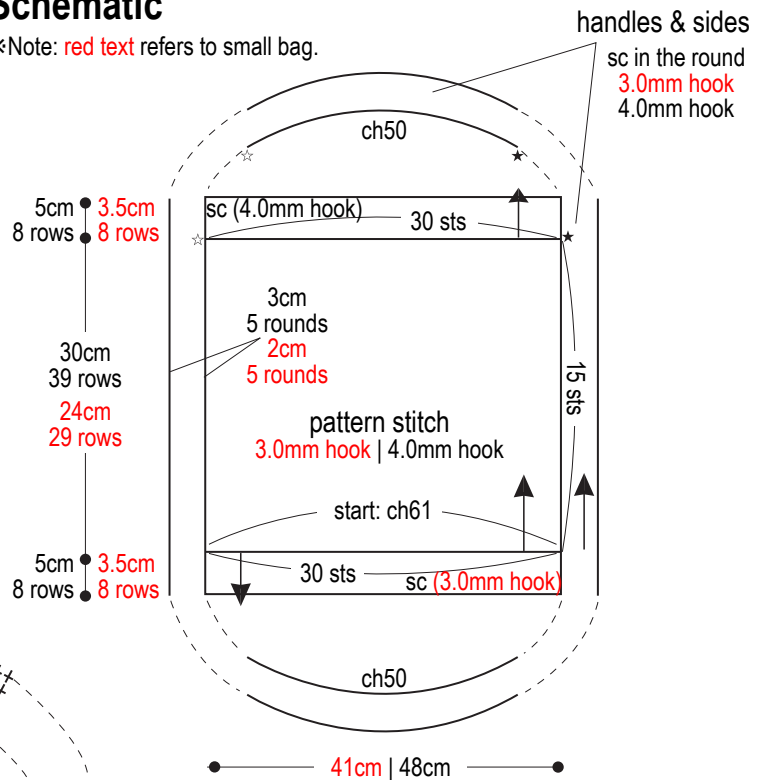
Work chain to begin, then work 29 rows in pattern stitch according to chart. Work 30 sc stitches along mouth edge. Work 8 rows of this sc edging. Join yarn to opposite side and work 8 rows of sc there in the same manner. Work 2 chains of 50 stitches each. Using the yarn tails at the ends of each of these 2 chains, seam each side where indicated with ★ and ☆ markers, respectively. Work 5 rounds of sc in the round, beginning as follows: work 15 sc stitches along side, 50 stitches into first chain, 15 stitches along second side, and then 50 stitches into second chain. Seam ends of mouth edging to handles. Fasten 3 decorative buttons to the right side of each bag as shown on finishing schematic.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
sc = single crochet (US)

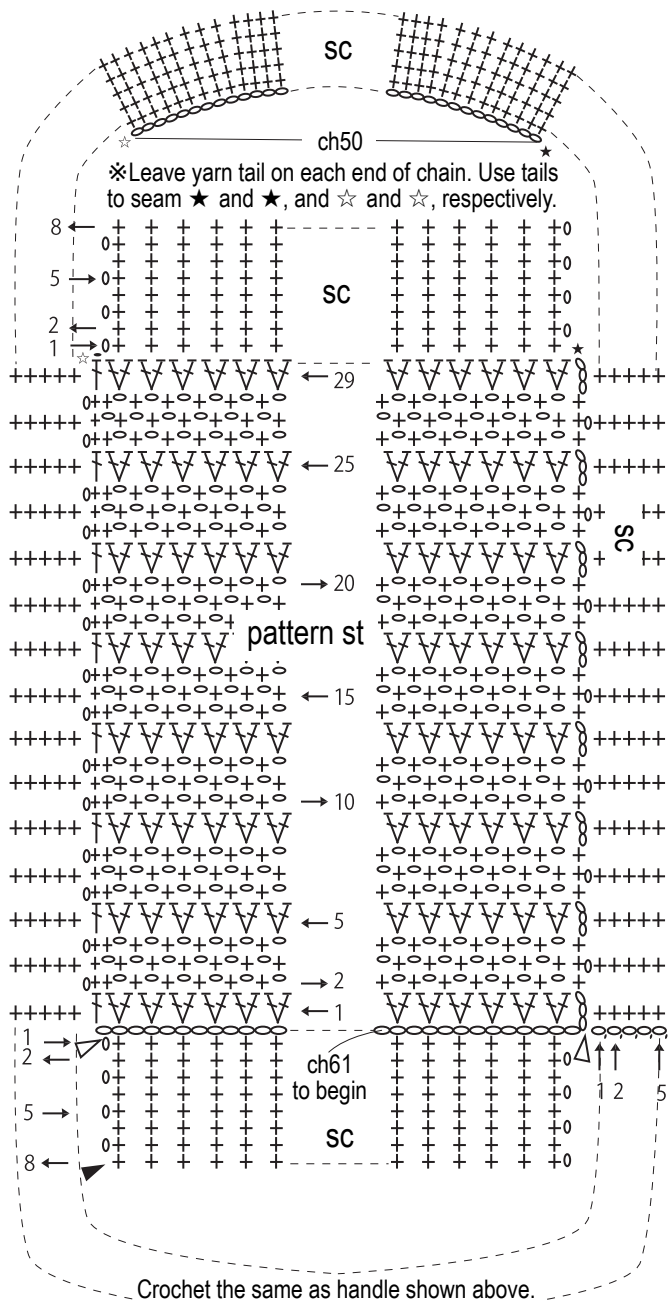
Schematic

※Note: red text refers to small bag.

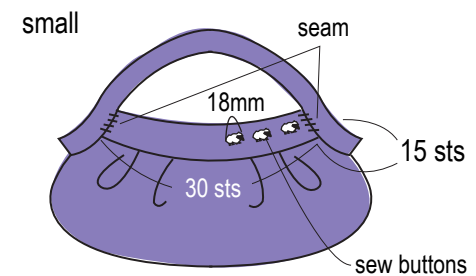
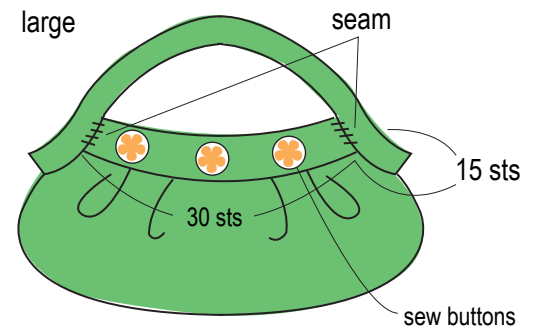


Body & handles
