

# 212w-12 Gradation Socks



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Chuboso Gradation [50% merino wool, 50% other wool; 164 yds/150m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #1412 yellow/aqua gradation, 2 skeins [60g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.0mm (US 2½) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- foot length 23cm/9.06"
- mouth of sock 12-14cm/4.72-5.51"
- cuff length 27cm/10.62"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 28 sts and 38 rounds

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method, and join into the round. Work in the round from the cuff down. Work 2 rounds of k1p1 ribbing, then continue in k2p2 ribbing. Change needle size, then work in stockinette stitch for 1 round, decreasing 8 stitches as indicated. Work in stockinette from heel to tip of toe, referring to chart. When finished, seam toe with Kitchener stitch.

※The sock is designed somewhat on the small side in order to account for stretching. It should fit the sole size indicated.

## Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

DPNs = double-pointed knitting needles

inc = increase

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)

p = purl

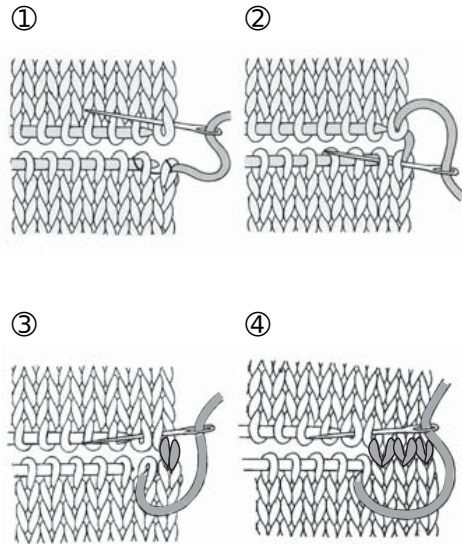
RE = row(s)/round(s) even

ssk = slip, slip, knit

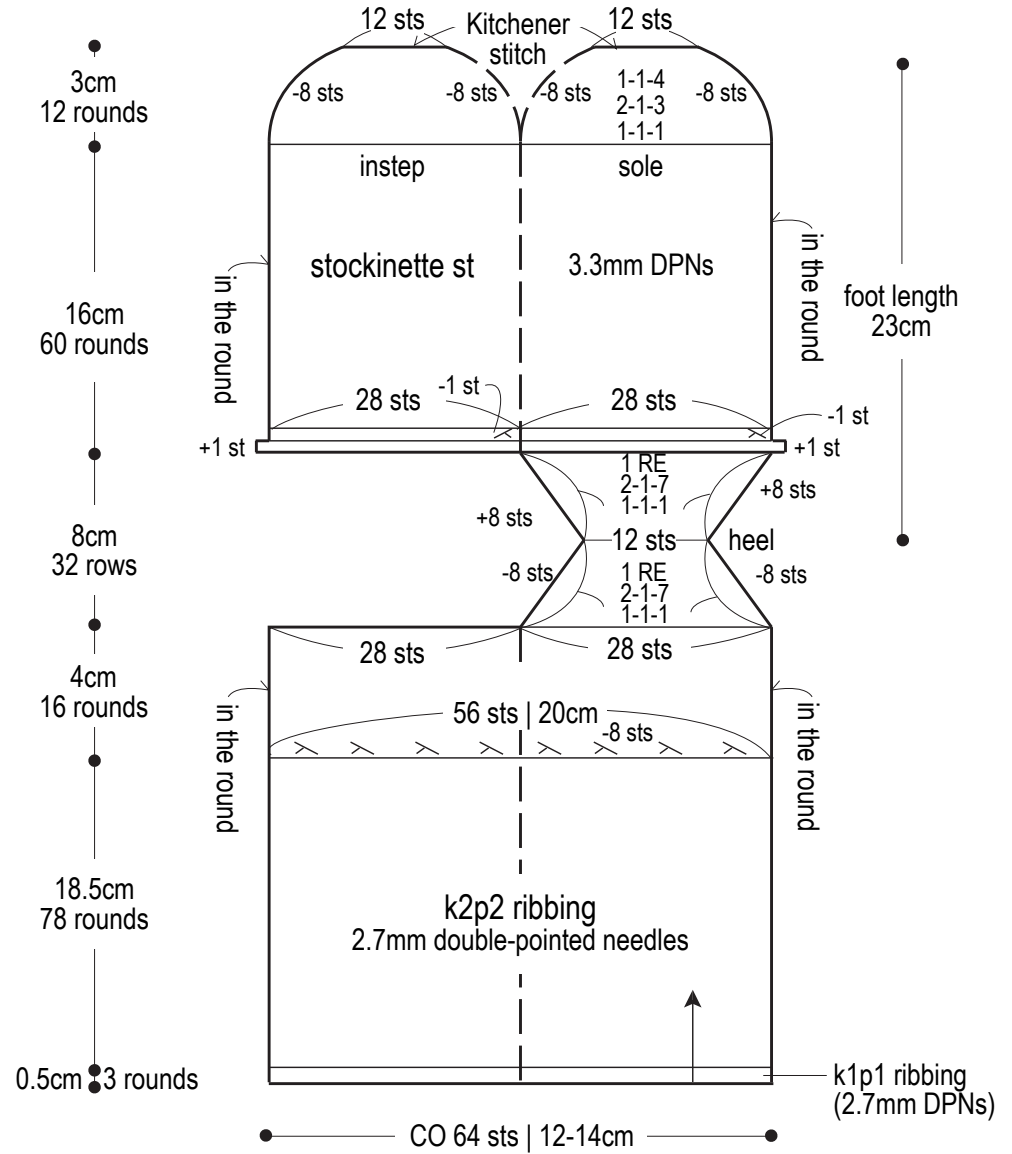
## = rows-stitches-times

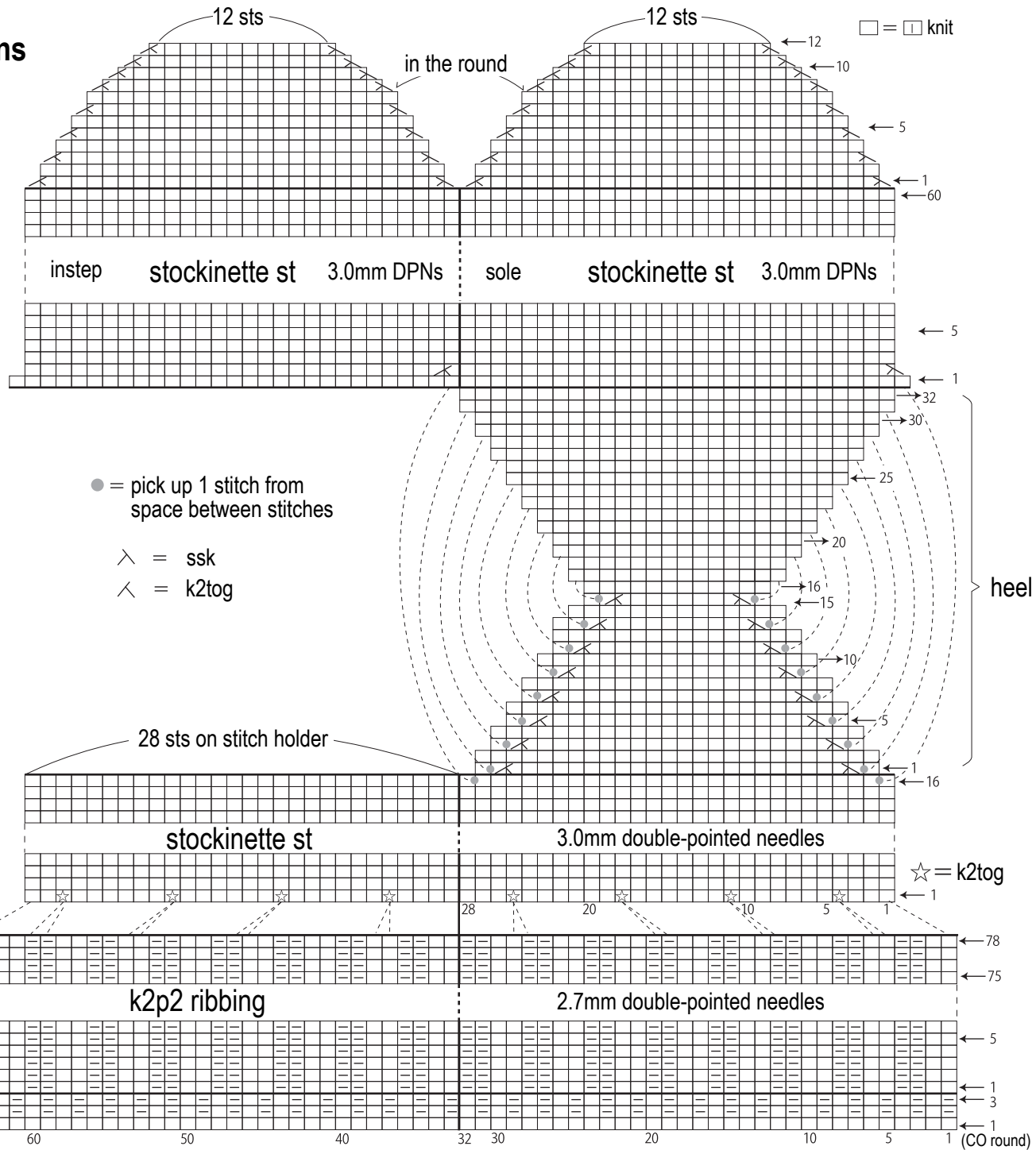
## Kitchener stitch instructions
