

amicomo11-8 Soft Merino Luncheon Mat & Coaster



ランチョンマット



コースター

Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino [100% merino wool; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #17 loam brown, 2 skeins [80g]
 - color #19 red brick, 1 skein [40g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- luncheon mat:
 - width 43cm/16.93"
 - height 27cm/10.63"
- coaster:
 - width 10cm/3.94"
 - height 10cm/3.94"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stranded pattern stitch: 21 sts and 25 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Luncheon Mat: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work front piece in pattern stitch. Work back piece in a solid color. Place the two pieces together with wrong sides facing each other, then seam them together by working sc around the outer edges (through both layers). Work 2 more rounds of sc edging (for a total of 3 rounds of sc).

Coaster: Work in the same manner as the luncheon mat, but work only one pattern repeat (as indicated).

✳️**Note:** The pattern stitch is worked in stranded knitting (with the non-working yarn being carried along the back). Refer to chart for color sequences.

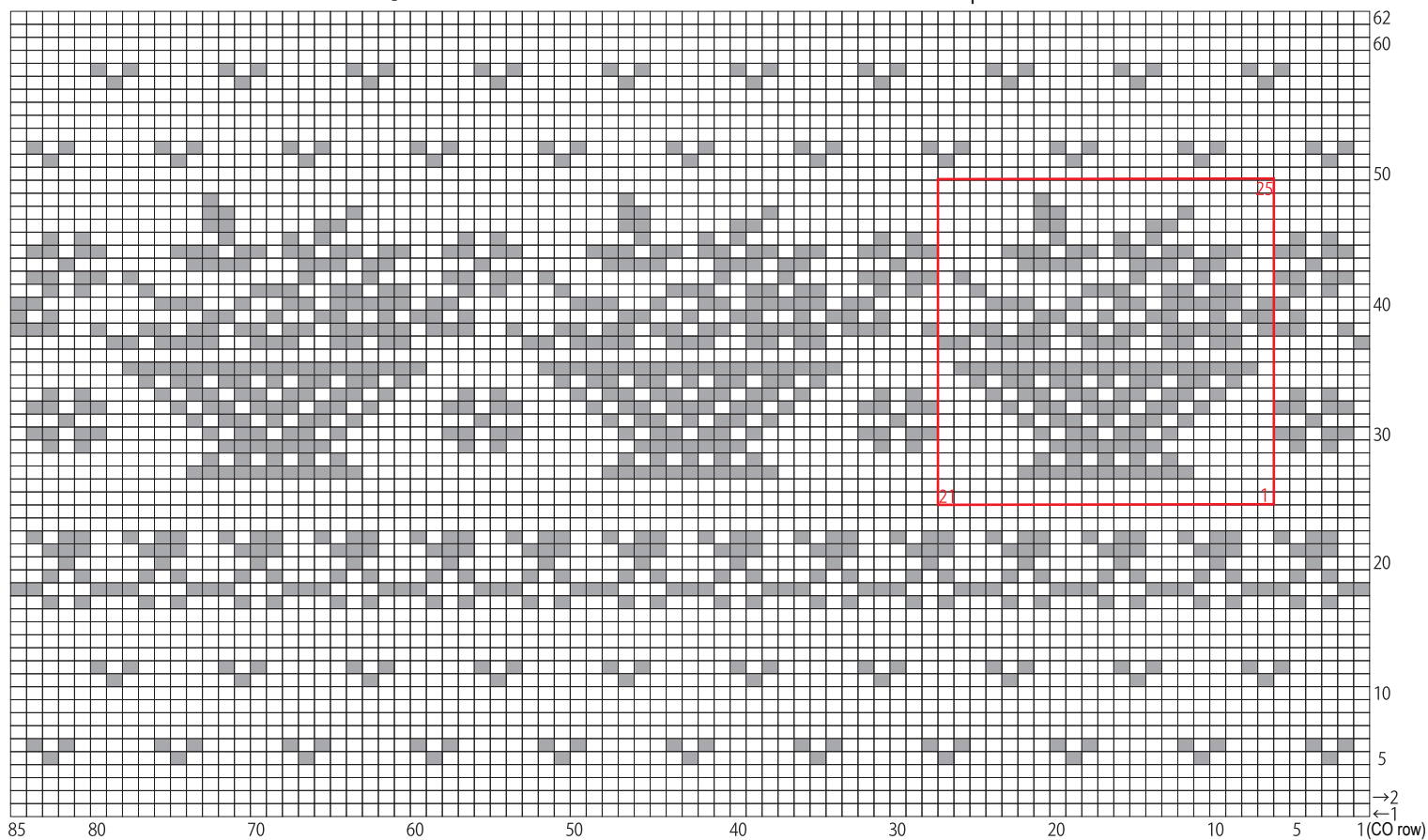
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit stitch
sc = single crochet (US)

Luncheon mat stranded pattern stitch (4.2mm needles)

□ = □ purl

□ = coaster

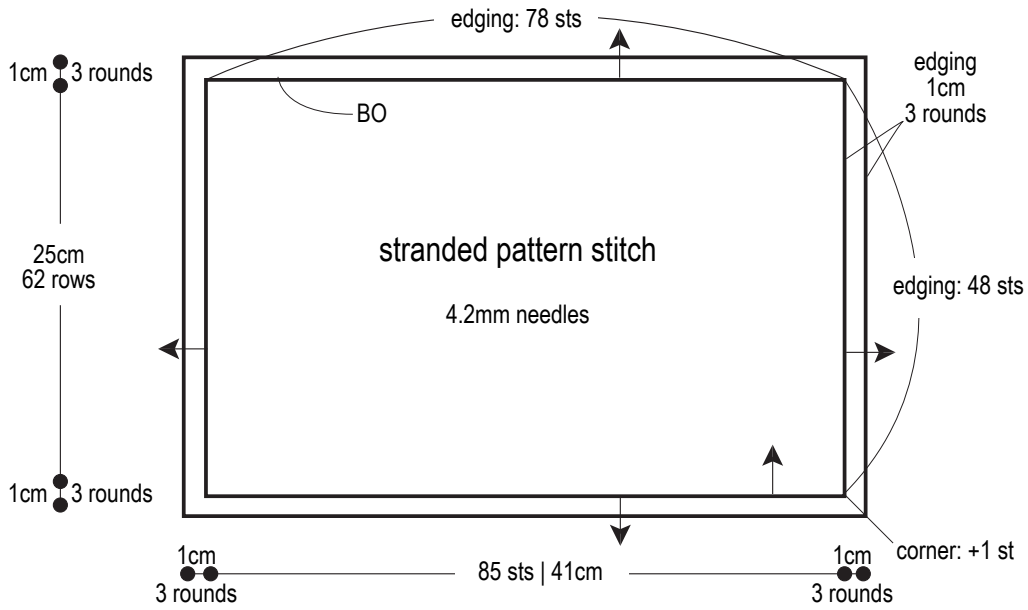

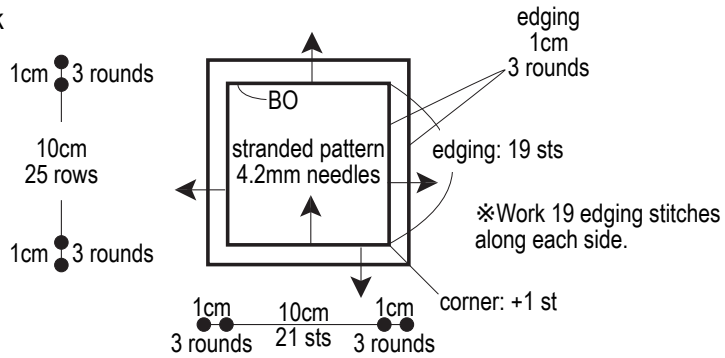
