

211s-17 Amian Purse



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amian Space Dyed [100% washable Japanese paper; 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #08 brown beige, 3 skeins [110g]
- Pierrot Yarns Marshmallow Cotton [100% cotton; 153 yds/140m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; natural color, 1 skein [10g]
- Pierrot Yarns Ami Cotton Bulky [100% cotton; 115 yds/105m per 3.42-3.53 oz./97-100g hank];
 - color #01 off-white, 1 hank [small amount]
 - color #03 flamingo pink, 1 hank [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B) and 4.0mm (US G) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 pair bamboo purse handles (approx. 21.5cm/8.46" wide and 11.5cm/4.53" tall)

Finished measurements:

- bag:
 - mouth circumference 96cm/37.80"
 - depth 23.5cm/9.25"
- lariat decoration: refer to schematic

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Use hook size necessary to achieve firm fabric.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Bottom: Work chain to begin, then work sc in the round, increasing as indicated.

Sides: Continuing from bottom, work sides in pattern stitch and sc. Work 2 rounds of edging in crab stitch and chain stitch.

Finishing: Fasten handles to bag where indicated.

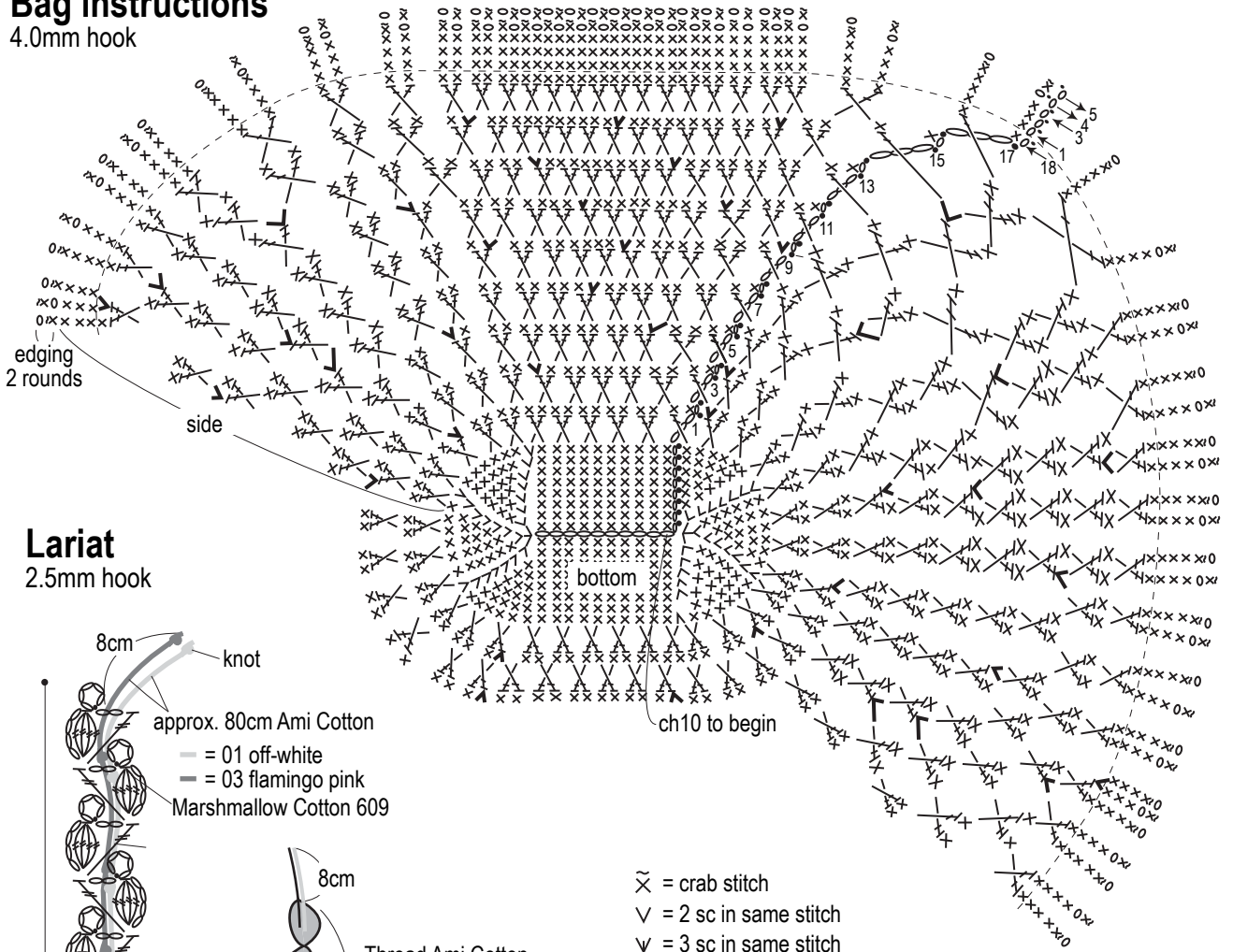
Decorative lariat: Crochet lariat, then thread Ami Cotton (1 strand of color 01 and 1 strand of color 03) through it. Gather it, shortening overall length of lariat. Tying knots with Ami Cotton is intended to keep gathers secure.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
dc = double crochet (US)
sc = single crochet (US)

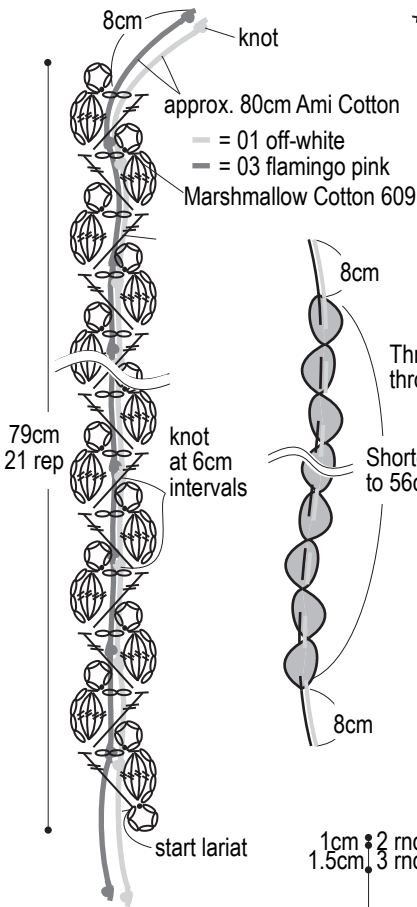
Bag instructions

Lariat

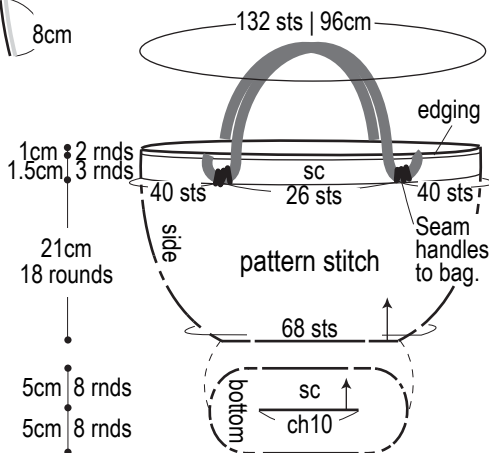
2.5mm hook



- ∞ = crab stitch
- ∨ = 2 sc in same stitch
- ∇ = 3 sc in same stitch
- ⌘ = crossed dc (2 sts total)

Bag finishing

4.0mm hook



- 1cm : 2 rnds
- 1.5cm : 3 rnds
- 21cm : 18 rounds
- 5cm : 8 rnds
- 5cm : 8 rnds

*Tie knots at ends of Ami Cotton strands and at 6cm intervals along entire piece.
