

Wood Tweed Shoulder Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Wood Tweed [100% wool; 30 yds/27m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #11 cocoa brown, 18 skeins [520g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- small amount polyfiber stuffing

Finished measurements:

- Please see schematic.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 12 sts and 14 rounds
- pattern stitch: 12 sts and 8 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Bottom: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc in the round according to chart.

Sides: Continuing from bottom, work in dc and sc as indicated. Work decreases to shape mouth of bag, then continue to handles.


Finishing: Seam handles with mattress stitch. Work sc edging around mouth of bag and edges of handles. Crochet button and button loop, then seam to bag with yarn tails.

Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- dc = double crochet (US)
- m = magic ring
- sc = single crochet (US)


Bag instructions

5.0mm hook




Bag schematic

5.0mm hook





Crochet button

5.0mm hook, 2 strands held together




round 4: 6 sts (-6)
round 3: 12 sts (work even)
round 2: 12 sts (+6)
round 1: 6 sts



*Insert stuffing. Then thread yarn through stitches on last round and cinch shut.

Button loop

5.0mm hook, 2 strands held together



*Pull yarn through to wrong side of fabric and tie a knot. Leave a 5cm yarn tail on each end of chain for this purpose.
