

213fw-06 Silk Rosa Triangular Shawl



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk Rosa [75% super kid mohair, 25% silk; 213 yds/195m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #11 dusty green, 5 skeins [115g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 160cm/62.99"
- length 71.5cm/28.15"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 19 sts and 11 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

✳️**Note:** entire shawl worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body of shawl: Ch277 to begin (**not** including any chain stitches needed for turning post). Work in pattern stitch, decreasing at left and right edges.

Finishing: Work edging A along edges of body. Work edging B along long edge of body and ends of edging A strips.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

ch-sp = chain space(s)

dc = double crochet (US)

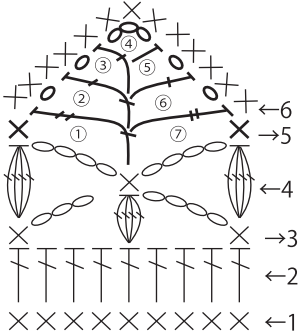
dtr = double treble (US)

hdc = half double crochet (US)

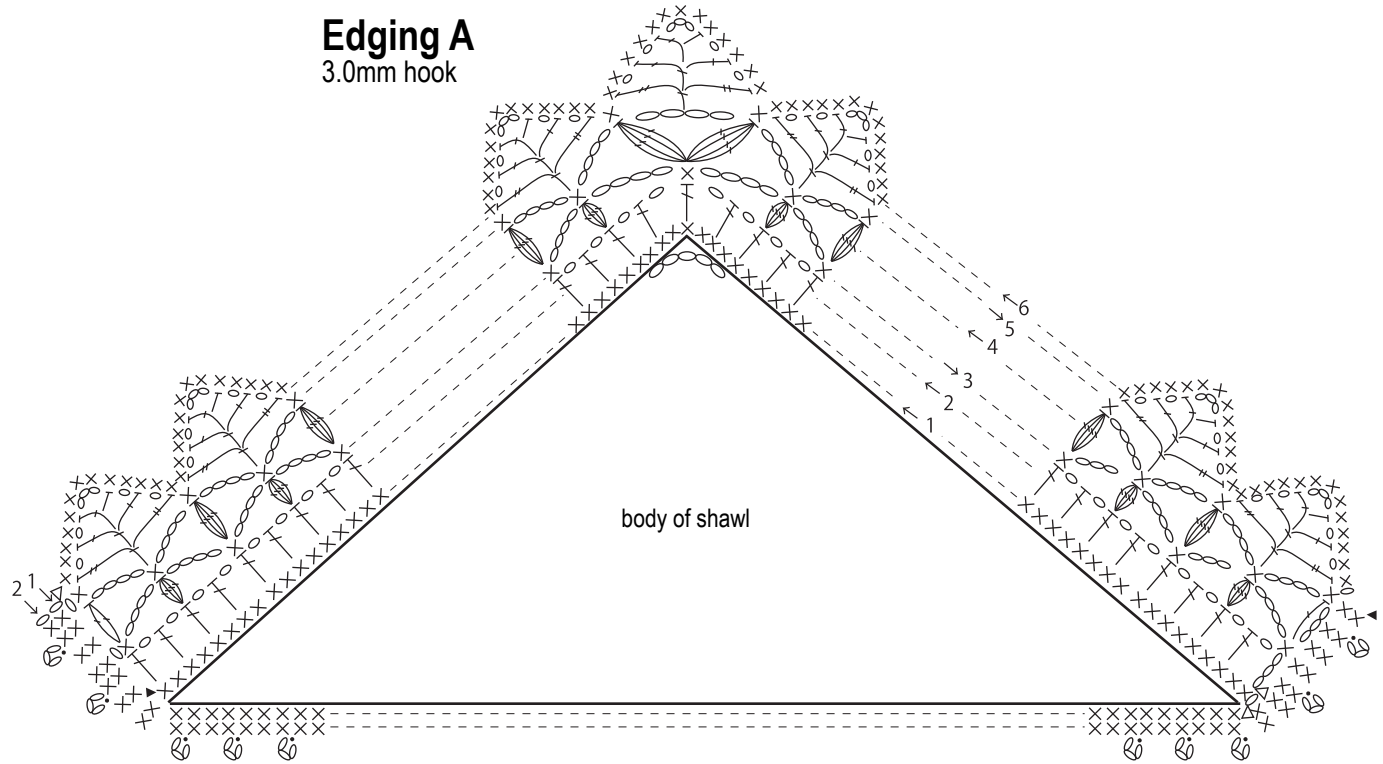
tr = treble crochet (US)

Instructions for row 5 of edging A


- ①... Work 1 double treble.
↓ (ch1)
- ②... Work tr.
↓ (ch1)
- ③... Work dc.

- ④... Work ch3.
↓
- ⑤... Work hdc.
↓ (ch1)
- ⑥... Work dc.
↓ (ch1)
- ⑦... Work tr.
