

214s-12 Ruffled Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Haruiro Pearl Rame [93% cotton, 4% polyester, 3% rayon; 107yds/98m per 1.06oz/30g skein]; color #21 vanilla beige, 5 skeins [130g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 handbag frame (21cm/8.27") by (9cm/3.54")
- size 3 (0.285mm thick) nylon beading thread (or fishing line)
- 6 metal O-rings (1cm/0.39" diameter)
- teknorote (84cm/33.07" long) or polypropylene memory wire

Finished measurements:

- Please see schematics.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 29 sts and 34 rows
- pattern stitch: 29 sts and 40 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Bottom: Work foundation chain to begin, then sc in the round (working first round along both sides of foundation chain), increasing as indicated. Work last round of bottom in bp sc.

Sides: Continuing from bottom, work pattern stitch in the round. For ruffle section, change direction as indicated and continue crocheting. Place markers on stitches of last round where indicated (6 markers in total).


Finishing: Align markers on sides with handbag frame; pin or clip securely in place. Thread nylon thread onto needle, then sew sides of bag to handbag frame with backstitch.

Handle: Create magic ring, then work sc in the round. Fold teknorote in three, then insert it into the middle of the handle. On final round, thread yarn through stitches and cinch shut. Seam each end of handle to a metal O-ring. At each end of handle, fasten third O-ring to ring on handbag frame.


Abbreviations:

bp = back post ch = chain fp = front post m = magic ring sc = single crochet (US)

Purse schematic




Finishing

※The sc gauge for handle differs from that of the body of the purse.



Purse chart


