

Omomuki Openwork Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Omomuki Cotton [78% cotton, 22% polyester; 295yds/270m per 1.41oz/40g skein];
 - color #06 iris, 4 skeins [145g]
 - color #09 blue, 4 skeins [145g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 116cm/45.67"
- center back neck-to-cuff 32cm/12.60"
- back length 68cm/26.77"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 21 sts and 36 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of color 06 and 1 strand of color 09).

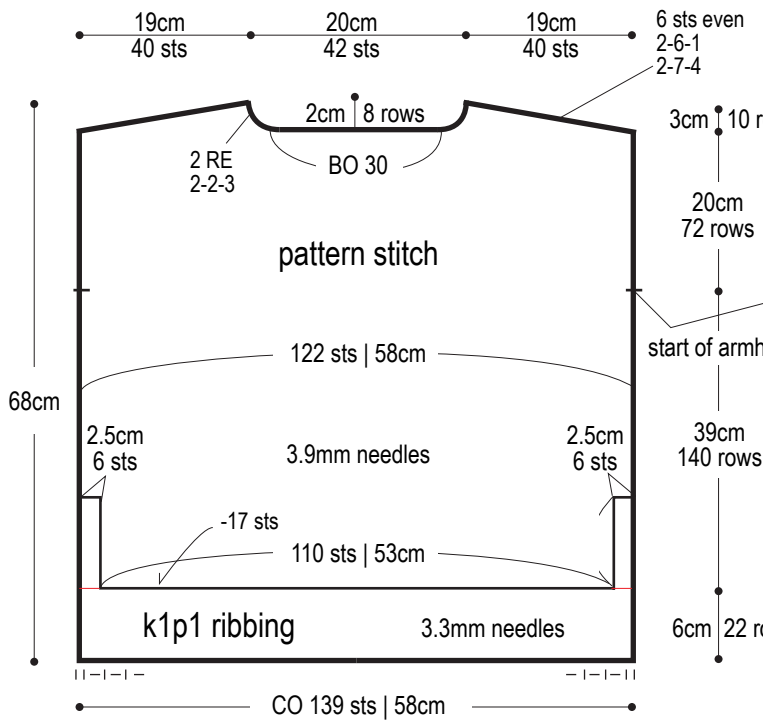
Body: Cast on for back with long-tail cast-on method, then work 22 rows in k1p1 ribbing. Change needle size, then work decreases in one row. Continue in pattern stitch, working 6 stitches at each side in k1p1 ribbing through row 29. Work front as for back, but work k1p1 ribbing at edges for only 7 rows.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches along armhole but do not join into the round. Work arm edging back and forths in rows in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Pick up stitches along neckline and join into the round. Work neckline edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides from end of ribbing to underarm using mattress stitch.

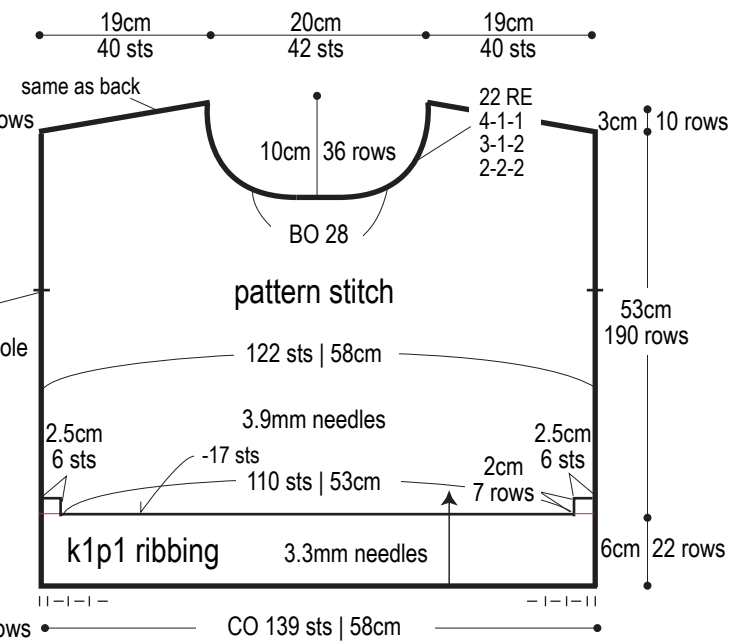
Abbreviations:

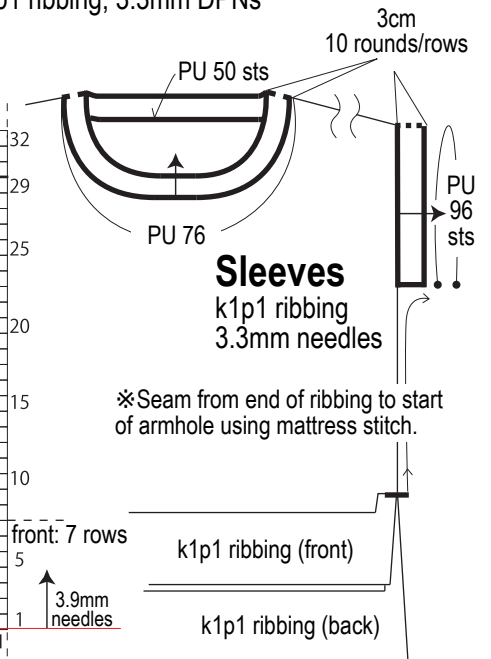
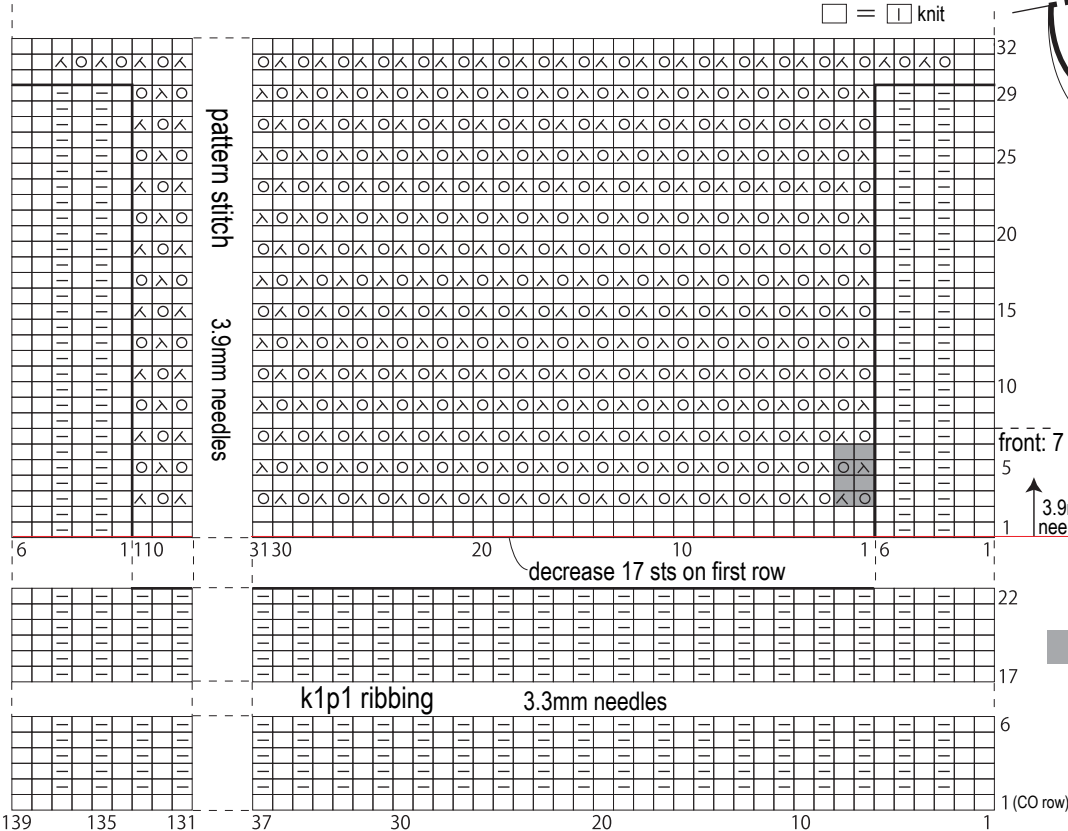
Front
