

# Neko Mat



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Milly [65% linen, 35% ramie; 112 yds./102m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #02 oriental red, 2 skeins [80g]
  - color #05 greige, 16 skeins [620g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- length 61cm/24.02"
- width 46cm/18.11"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 19 sts and 24 rows
- double crochet (US): 19 sts and 8.5 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

❖**Note 1:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

❖**Note 2:** entire mat worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

**Right side:** Work foundation chain to begin (114 sts). Work in sc. Work only cat section in colorwork pattern.

**Wrong side:** Begin with foundation chain as for right side, then work in dc.

**Finishing:** Place 2 pieces together with wrong sides facing each other. Seam together by working sc around edges.

## Abbreviations:


ch = chain

dc = double crochet (US)

sc = single crochet (US)


## RS of mat

※Work only cat in intarsia colorwork. Hide color #02 ends by working color #05 stitches around them.



☆ = To cover color #02 worked across this section, work color #05 stitches around them.



## WS of mat



■ = color #02 oriental red  
Elsewhere, use color #05 greige.
