

215s-04 Lace Cape



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Le Cotton #50 [100% cotton; 246 yds/225m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #03 light beige, 3 skeins [75g]

Tools/Notions:

- 1.50mm (US steel hook #8) lace crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- hem circumference 168cm/66.14"
- collar circumference 83cm/32.68"
- back length 29cm/11.41"

Gauge:

- pattern stitch: 1 pattern repeat = 10.5cm/4.13" wide and 17.5 rounds = 10cm/4" tall

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✿**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do **not** include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Cape: Work foundation chain and join into the round. Work pattern stitch in the round. When finished with body of cape, continue by working edging A in the round. Then work edging B in the round along the hem edge.

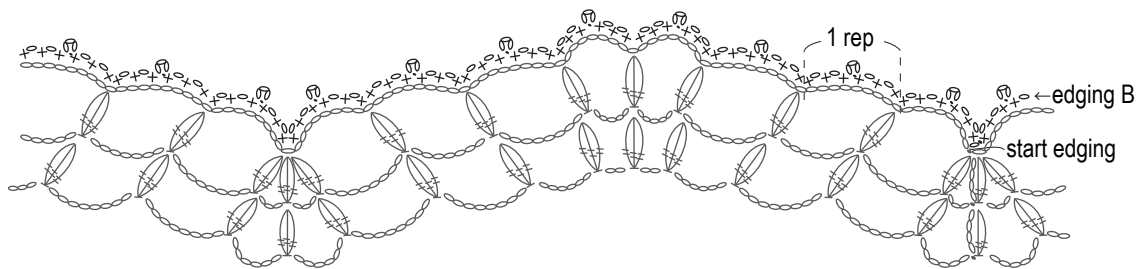
Abbreviations:

ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)

tr = treble crochet (US)
