

553slippers Cleaning Slippers



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Poapoa Cute [100% acrylic; 57 yds/52m per 2.82 oz./80g skein]; color #39 red mix, 2 skeins [140g]
- Pierrot Yarns Zakka Acrylic Namibuto [100% acrylic; 77 yds/70m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #101 creamed corn, 3 skeins [70g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.0mm (US G) and 6.0mm (US J) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- Refer to schematics.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (with 4.0mm hook): 15 sts and 14 rows
- pattern stitch (with 6.0mm hook): 10.5 sts and 11 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Soles: Work foundation chain to begin, then work part A in sc and part B in pattern stitch, respectively.

Instep pieces: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc. Starting with row 10, begin working right and left sides separately. Change yarn and work sc edging along foundation chain edge as well as curved edge.

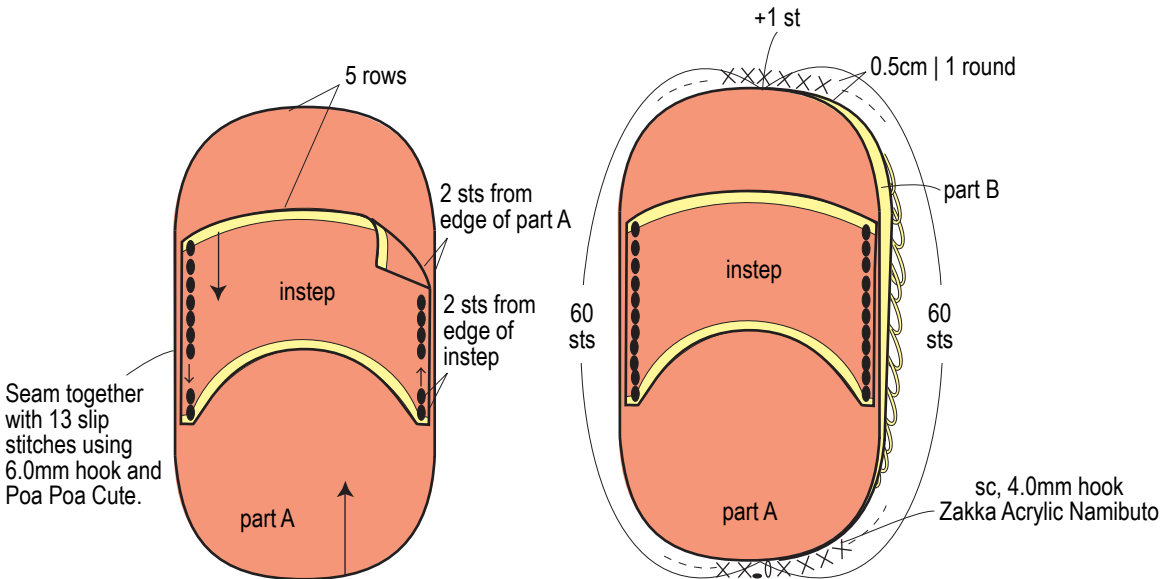
Finishing: Place instep on top of part A as indicated in finishing schematic. Seam together by working slip stitch seam 2 stitches in from the edge of both pieces. Seam parts A and B together with wrong sides facing each other using sc worked as edging through both layers. (Note: for part B, right side is the one with loops.)

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

sc = single crochet (US)
