# 215w-14 Green Socks



### Suggested yarn:

- Malabrigo Yarn Sock [100% merino wool; 440 yds/402m per 3.53 oz./100g hank];
- small: color #37 lettuce, 1 hank [80g]
- large: color #37 lettuce, 1 hank [80g]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.0mm (US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

## Finished measurements (with negative ease):

- small:
  - foot length 23cm/9.06"
  - mouth of sock (circumference) 19cm/7.48"
  - sock length 27cm/10.63"

# Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 29 sts and 45.5 rounds
- pattern stitch: 34.5 sts and 43 rounds
- twisted k1p1 ribbing: 32.5 sts and 43 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

sock length 27cm/10.63"

Summary

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and join into the round. Working from base of toes upward, begin working twisted k1p1 ribbing and pattern stitch in the round. Place instep stitches on stitch holder and work heel from sole stitches. After heel is completed, return instep stitches to needles and resume working in the round. Work cuff in k1p1 ribbing, then bind off in the round. Pick up stitches from around cast-on edge at toe area; work tip of toe in stockinette stitch in the round, decreasing as indicated. Seam tip of toe with Kitchener stitch.





k = knit stitch k2tog = knit 2 sts together #-#-# = rows-stitches-times


OH = on hold (place on stitch holder) p = purl stitch


RE = row(s) even
