533tie Vintage Cashmere Necktie



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Vintage Cashmere 100 [100% cashmere; 112 yds/102m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #325 blue green, 2 skeins [60g]
 - color #327 light gray, 2 skeins [35g]

Tools/Notions:

• 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 6cm/2.36"
- length 145cm/57.09"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• single crochet (US): 25 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body of tie: Work foundation chain to begin, then crochet tie in striped sc, increasing and decreasing as indicated.

Keeper (loop): Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing each other, seam sides of tie together with whipstitch. Seam foundation chain edge to bind-off edge with whipstitch. Fasten keeper (loop) in place.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

RE = row(s) even

sc = single crochet (US)



Body of tie: schematic striped sc, 2.5mm hook 8cm 20 sts 28 RE 28-1-2 6.5cm 16 sts +2 sts +2 sts 6.5cm 16 sts 145cm 80cm 224 rows 28 RE 28-1-7 -7 sts -7 sts

start: 30 sts 12cm 30cm 84 rows

35cm 98 rows
