

Fuwari Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Etoile [30% rayon, 28% mohair, 26% acrylic, 16% nylon; 168 yds/154m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #04 antique rose, 11 skeins [325g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) and 4.8mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- tapestry needle

Finished measurements:

- bust 170cm/66.93"
- back length 65cm/25.59"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 16 sts and 23 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in stockinette stitch. Shape neckline by working increases and decreases as indicated on schematic. When shaping is finished, continue working even in stockinette stitch. Work edge in k1p1 ribbing, then bind off in pattern. Make second piece with shaping reversed.

Finishing: Seam sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam front and back centers with mattress stitch. Fold collar to wrong side and secure with whipstitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on


k = knit

p = purl


pm = place marker
