

Z017-113 Sankaku Motif Stole



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores India Zakka Lace [100% cotton; 612 yds/560m per 3.53 oz./100g skein];
- color #03 apricot, 2 skeins [120g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm (US steel hook #4) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width of rectangle (not including motifs) 18cm/7.09"
- length 142cm/55.91"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 34 sts and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Rectangular base piece: Work foundation chain to begin, then work rectangular piece in pattern stitch.

Triangle motif (make 12): Work according to chart.

Finishing: Seam motifs to long edge of rectangular base piece with whipstitch (with wrong sides facing each other).

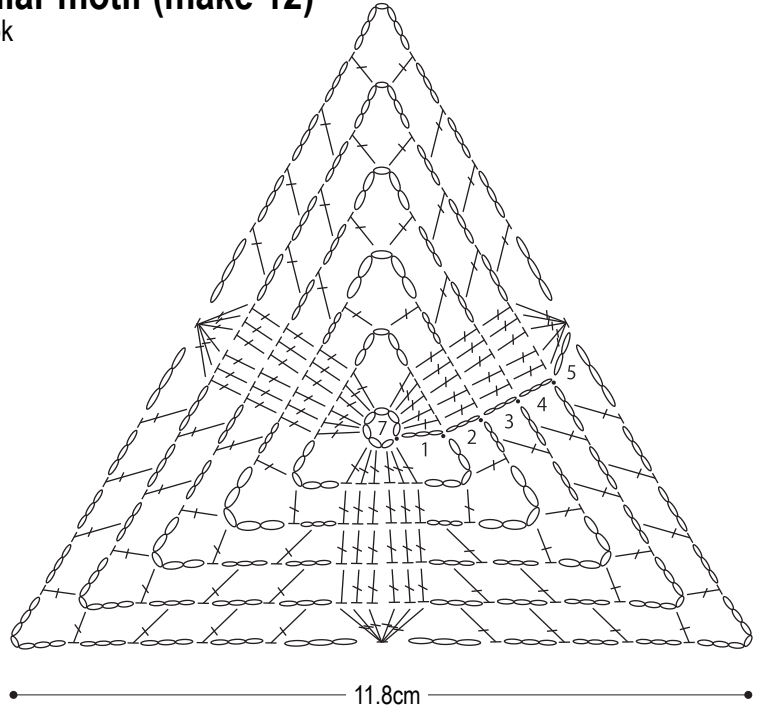
Abbreviations:

ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)

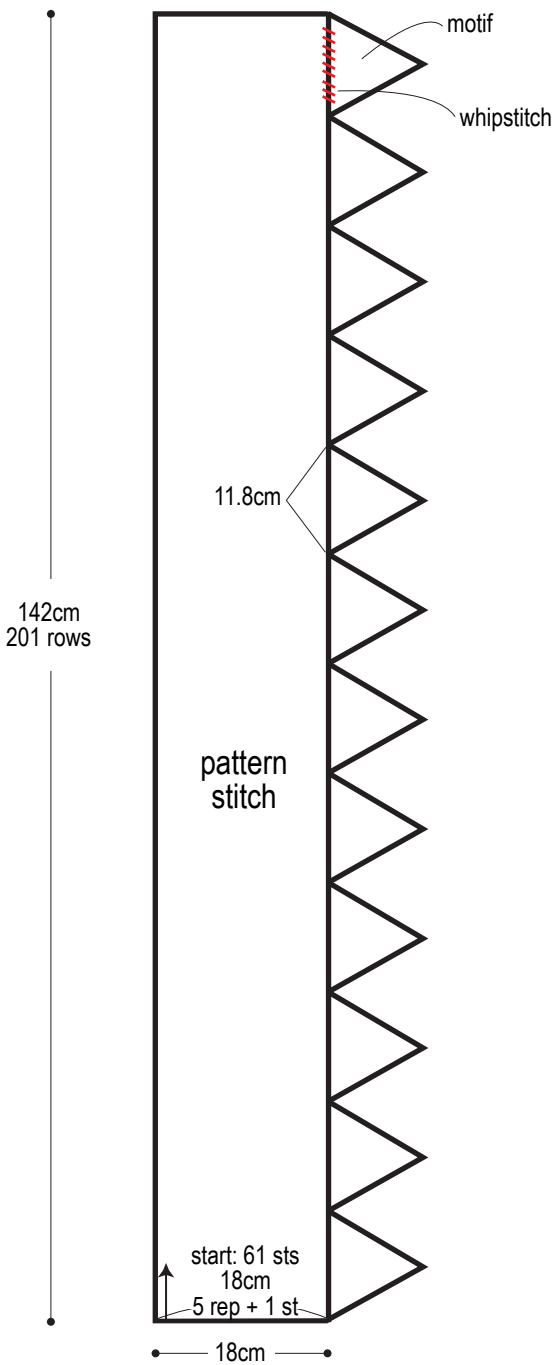
Triangular motif (make 12)
