

Yuru Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Fuwari [88% acrylic, 12% mohair; 71 yds/65m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #15 puppy brown, 7 skeins [255g]

Tools/Notions:

- 7.0mm (no US equivalent) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 64.5cm/25.39"
- back length 50cm/19.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 10.5 sts and 12 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch. When finished, place shoulder stitches on stitch holders (do not bind off). Bind off neckline stitches.

Finishing: With right sides facing each other, seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)


p = purl

PU = pick up


RE = row(s) even

= rows-stitches-times

Back & front (make 2)
