

425shawl Fringe Shawl



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pochette [50% superwash merino wool, 50% cotton; 131 yds/120m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - with fringe:
 - color #01 pure white, 5 skeins [200g]
 - color #10 moss green, 3 skeins [100g]
 - without fringe:
 - color #01 pure white, 5 skeins [180g]
 - color #10 moss green, 2 skeins [80g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 140cm/55.12"
- length (excluding fringe) 70cm/27.56"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 8.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body of shawl: ch1 for foundation chain, then work according to chart. After body of shawl is complete, continue by working edgings A and B around outer edges.

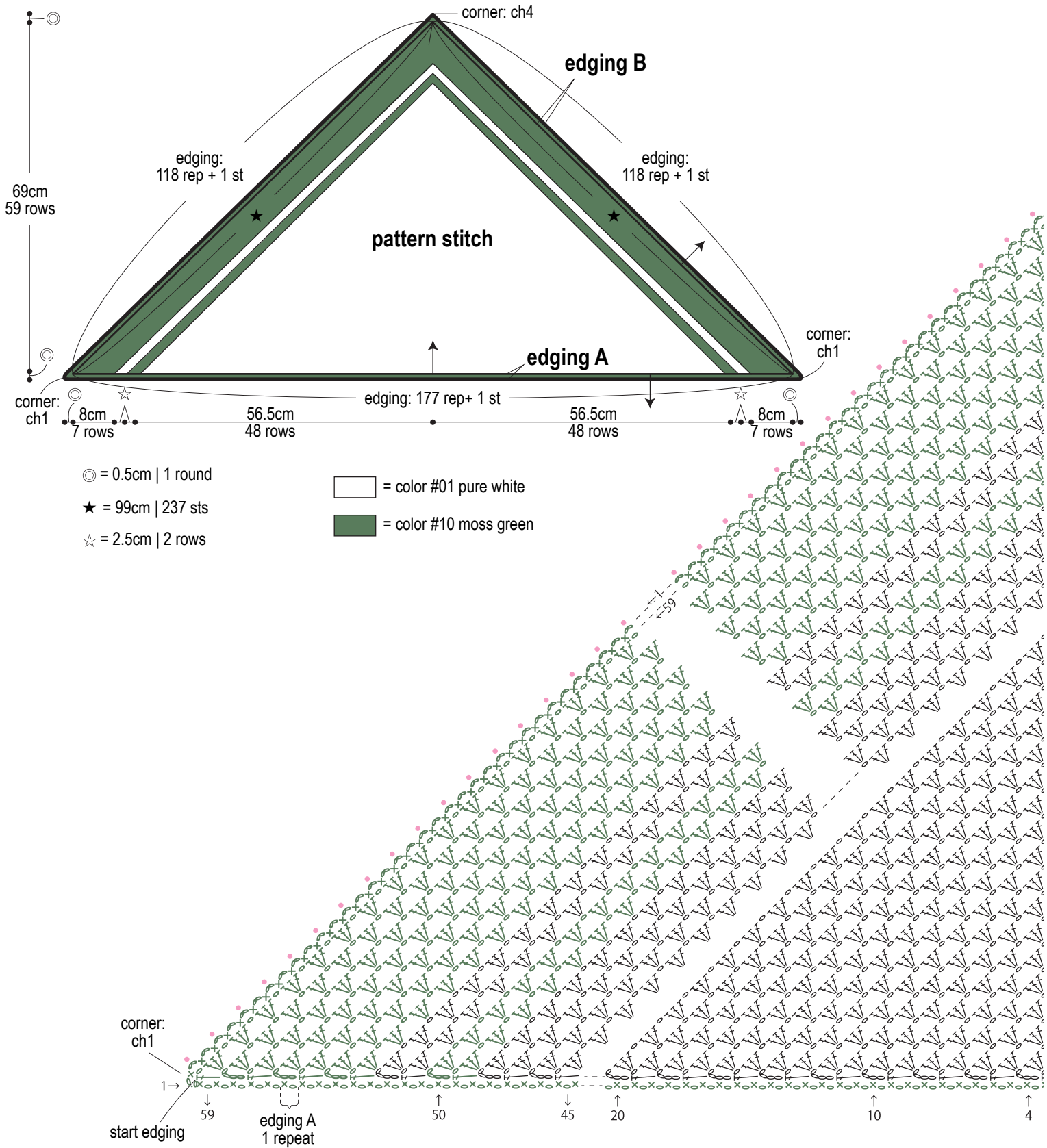
Finishing: Make and attach fringe in 119 places indicated.

Abbreviations:

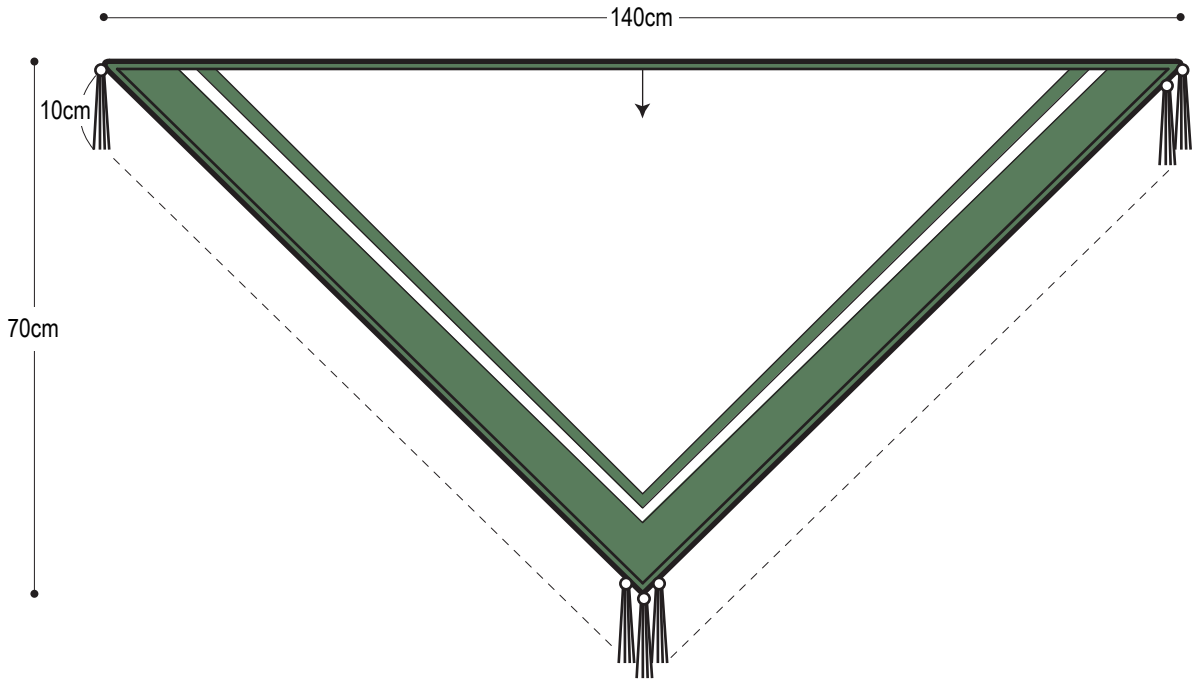
ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)

*Fringe: take 4 strands of yarn (each 25cm long) and fold in half. Fasten to edge of shawl in each of the 119 places shown.
