

# 215aw-04 Lucy Stole



## Suggested yarn:

- PurpleYarns Lucy [78% acrylic, 12% mohair, 10% polyester; 219 yds/200m per 3.53 oz./100g skein]; color #102 black, 3 skeins [300g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 8.0mm (US 11) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- width 60cm/23.62"
- length 225cm/88.58"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 10 sts and 12 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

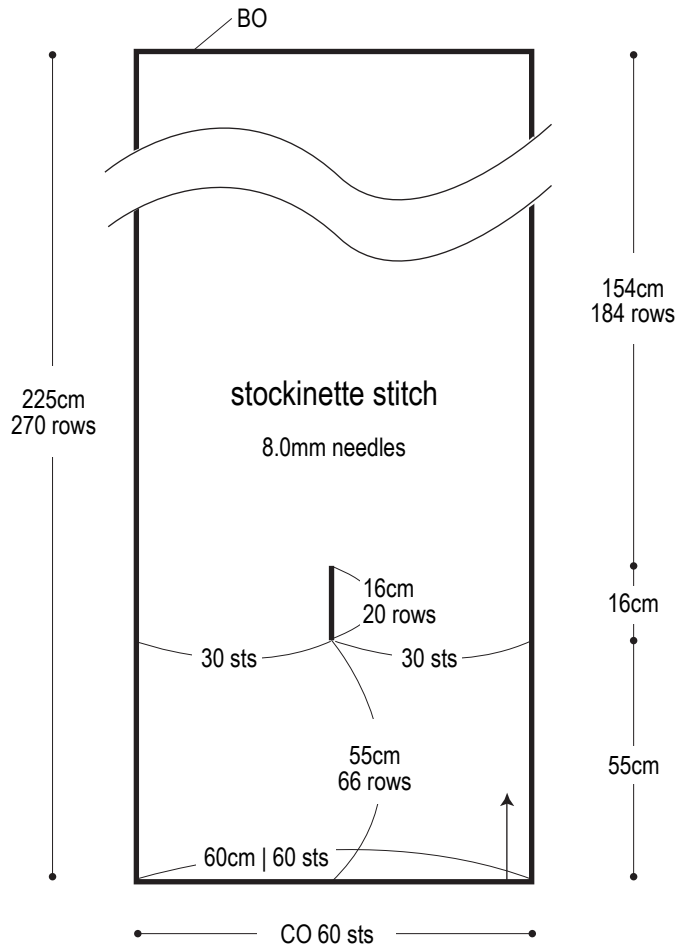
Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work stockinette stitch loosely with 8.0mm (US 11) needles. After working 66 rows, work right and left sides separately (each with its own yarn) for 20 rows, then resume working as one piece again until 2.5m/98.43" of yarn remains. Bind off loosely.

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

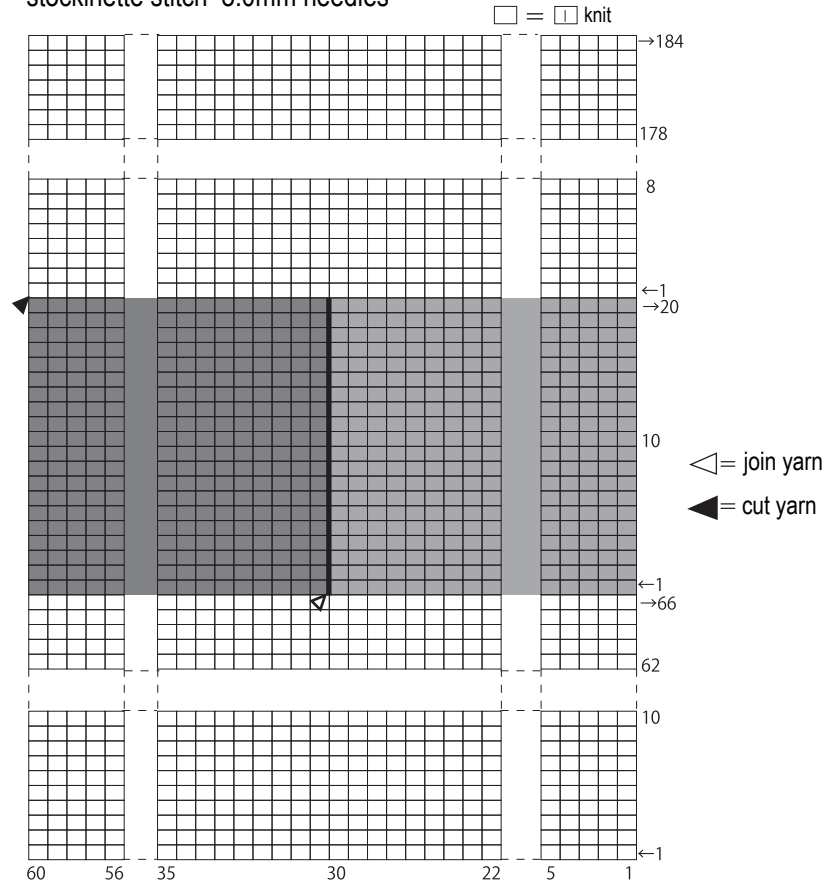
CO = cast on

※After working 66 rows, work      section, then drop yarn (do **not** cut yarn). Join yarn where indicated and work      section. Cut yarn. Pick up resting yarn and continue working.
