

216aw-12 Yuyake Legwarmers



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Yuyake no Sora LL [100% wool; 144 yds/132m per 3.53 oz./100g hank]; color #302 tropical fish, 1 hank [80g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) circular knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- height 18cm/7.09"
- width 11.5cm/4.53"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- width of block: 2.5cm/0.98" ~ 3.0cm/1.18"
- height of block:: 3.0cm/1.18" ~ 3.5cm/1.38"

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.



Summary

Body of legwarmer: Cast on 5 sts with long-tail cast-on method. Work 2 rows of garter stitch, then 7 rows of stockinette stitch. *Cast on 5 new stitches using backwards loop cast-on method. Work 3 rows garter stitch, then 7 rows stockinette stitch.* Repeat from * to * 3 times. This forms the base row of blocks. Referring to chart, work every other row of 5 blocks in the other direction.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing each other, seam sides with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

blco = backwards loop cast-on increase

BO = bind off


CO = cast on

inc = increase

k2tog = knit 2 sts together

PU = pick up

Entrelac chart 4.5mm needles



□ = 1 knit

- = BO on 11th row. Work final BO st as k2tog with st on previous row of block (7th row of blocks).
- = BO 5 sts on 11th row



- ☆ = PU 5 sts from sts of row 11 on previous block. k first st together with BO st of previous row.
- △ = slip st on even-numbered rows. On odd-numbered rows, k slipped st together with st of previous block.
- ★ = PU 5 sts as for ☆, but do not k2tog with first stitch.
