

217ss-14 Earrings



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Le Cotton #50 [100% cotton; 282 yds/258m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
 - color #10 aqua, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #12 orchid, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #20 antique gold, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #21 olive, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #25 egyptian blue, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #28 mahogany, 1 skein [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- 1.0mm (US steel hook #12) lace crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- earring fittings (hooks or clip-ons)
- diamond-shaped earrings: 2 pearl beads (6mm/0.24" diameter)
- clover earrings: 2 pearl beads (4mm/0.16 diameter)
- flower earrings: 6 beads

Finished measurements:

- clover length 4cm/1.57"
- flower length 4.5cm/1.77"
- diamond length 5.5cm/2.17"

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Use either pierced studs, pierced hooks, or clip-on fittings as desired.

Clover: Work magic ring to begin, then form leavings using ch and hdc and working sc into magic ring. Change to color #21 and work border around leaves. Crochet stem last.

Flower: Work magic ring to begin, then work petals according to chart. Make 3 flowers per earring in colors indicated.

Diamond: Work magic ring to begin, then follow chart. On round 2, ch5 as indicated, join to earring finding, then slip st into chain sts and resume rest of round. For ribbon, also start with a magic ring, then crochet according to chart.


Abbreviations:

ch = chain hdc = half double crochet (US) m = magic ring/circle sc = single crochet (US)

Clover

make 2


Work sc into sc from round 1, then slip st into magic ring. Work next sc into ch from first round.




Flower

make 4 with color #10
make 2 with color #25

◁ = join yarn
◄ = cut yarn



Attach one bead to center of each flower.



Diamond

make 2 of each
