219s-07 Fringe Straw Hat



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Amian [100% Japanese paper (cellulose); 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #28 burnt umber, 3 skeins [90g]

Tools/Notions:

• 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

• head circumference 56cm/22.0"

• depth 10.5cm/4.1"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch A: 19 sts and 16 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Top & sides: Work magic ring to begin, then work pattern stitch A in the round, increasing as indicated.

Brim: Continuing from sides, work pattern stitch B in the round, increasing as indicated. Work edging back and forth in joined rounds.

Finishing: Cut the center of each loop worked in the loop st in the brim edging to finish the fringe. Trim fringe ends as desired.


