## 219s-07 Fringe Straw Hat



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amian [100\% Japanese paper (cellulose); 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color \#28 burnt umber, 3 skeins [90g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge


## Finished measurements:

- head circumference $56 \mathrm{~cm} / 22.0^{\prime \prime}$
- depth $10.5 \mathrm{~cm} / 4.1$

Gauge ( $10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4$ " square):

- pattern stitch A: 19 sts and 16 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.


#### Abstract

Summary *Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts. Top \& sides: Work magic ring to begin, then work pattern stitch $A$ in the round, increasing as indicated. Brim: Continuing from sides, work pattern stitch B in the round, increasing as indicated. Work edging back and forth in joined rounds Finishing: Cut the center of each loop worked in the loop st in the brim edging to finish the fringe. Trim fringe ends as desired.
