

1263nl Flower Lace Necklace



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Bene [100% cotton; 205 yds/187m per 0.9 oz./25g skein];
 - color #02 ecru beige, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #04 frosty gray, 1 skein [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- 0.9mm (US steel size 14) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 102 transparent beads
- 1 necklace clasp

Finished measurements:

- length approximately 50cm/19.7"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Use hook size necessary to achieve desired finished measurements.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✿**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Parts A, B & C: Crochet according to chart.

Part D: String the beads onto your thread before beginning to crochet. Crochet part D according to chart, sliding beads up to the hook when needed.

Finishing: Loosely entwine the four strands. Fasten one half of clasp to each end of the necklace.

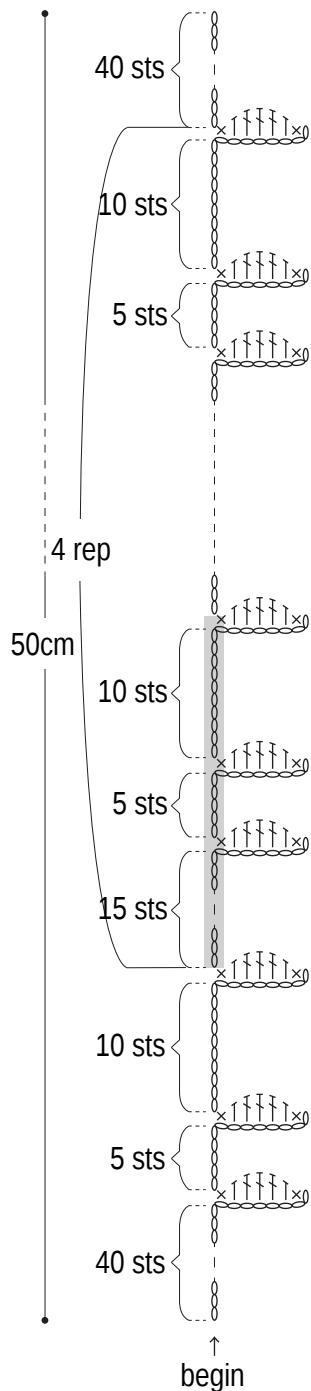
ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)

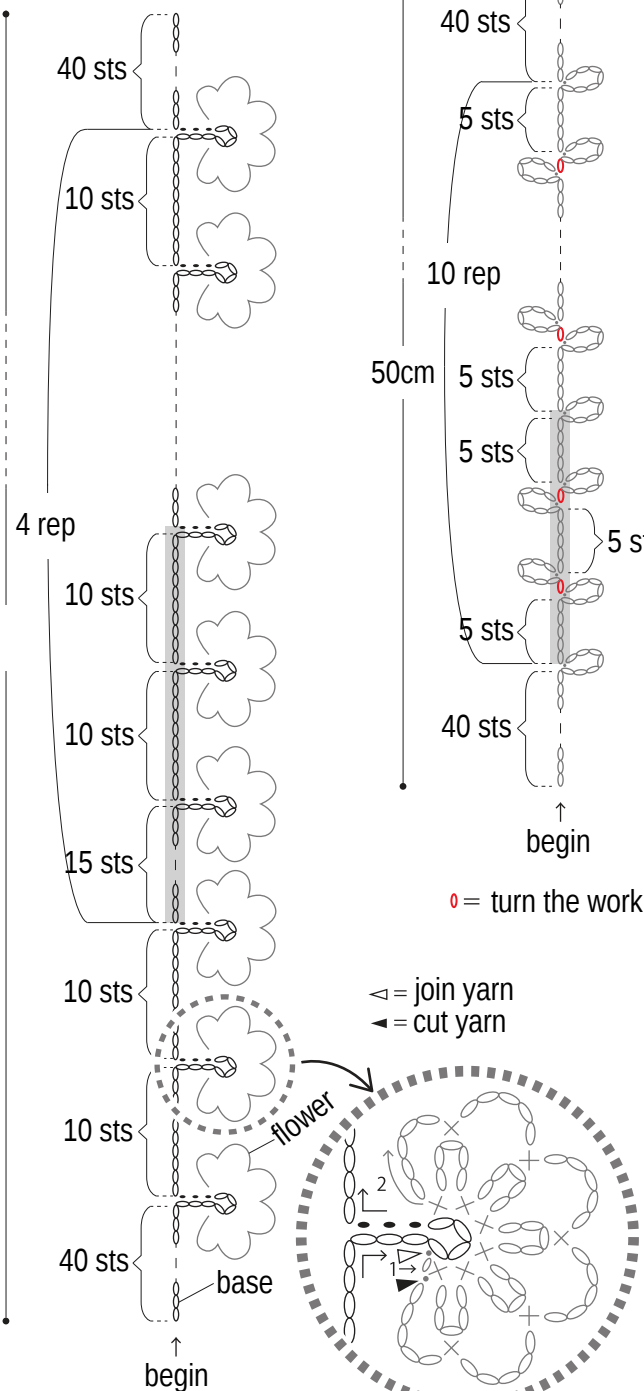
— = color #02 — = color #04 █ = 1 repeat

※For each piece, leave a 15cm/5.9" yarn tail at beginning and end of work.

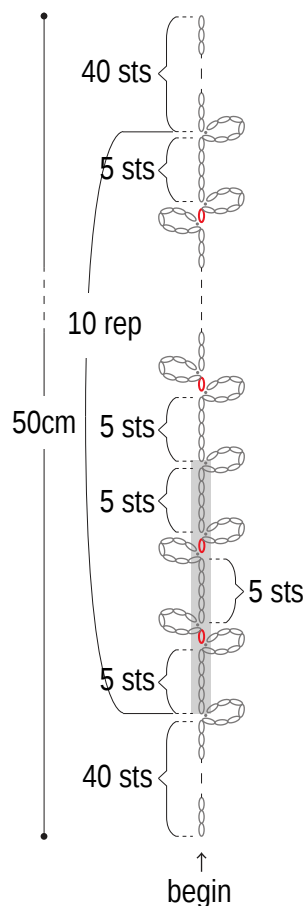

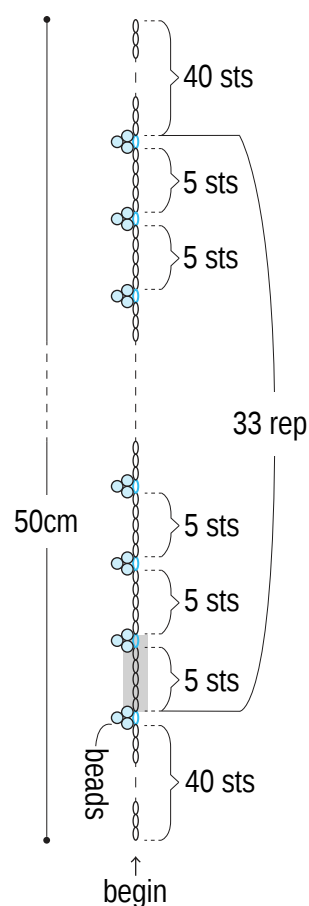

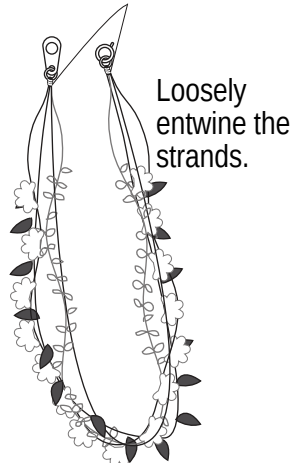


Part D



o = ch1, slide 3 beads (strung ahead of time) close to hook, then continue chart

Fasten one half of clasp to each end of the necklace.



- ① Crochet the base piece in color #04.
- ② Crochet flower with color #04 and attach to base piece.
