

# 1252beret Bruno Beret



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Bruno [80% merino wool, 20% yak; 102 yds/93m per 1.1 oz./30g skein]; color #08 outer space, 2 skeins [60g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

## Finished measurements:

- head circumference 48cm/18.9"
- depth 23cm/9.1"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 25 sts and 36 rows
- pattern stitch B: 26.5 sts and 36 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing in the round, then continue in pattern stitches A & B, increasing and decreasing as indicated.

**Finishing:** Cut yarn and thread the tail through all remaining stitches of the last round. Cinch top of beret shut, then weave in the yarn tail. Fold cast-on edge to inside as shown in finishing schematic, then secure in place with whipstitch.

## Abbreviations:

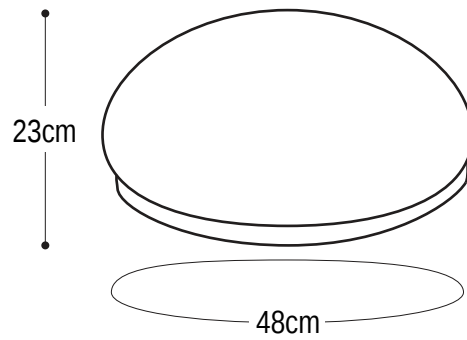
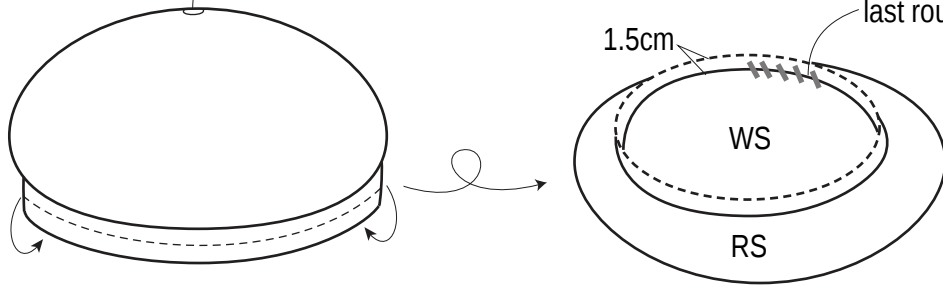
CO = cast on  
k = knit  
p = purl  
RS = right side  
WS = wrong side



# Finishing

Cut yarn and thread tail through all remaining (36) sts of final round. Cinch top of hat closed and weave in tail.

Fold cast-on edge towards inside along "fold here" line marked on schematic above. Whipstitch to last round of k1p1 ribbing.
