

29-40 Pocket Sweater

Materials

- MC: Pierrot Yarns Organic Cotton DK [100% organic cotton; 43 yds / 39m per 0.88 oz. / 25g skein]; color #3 unbleached cotton; 11 skeins [210g]
- CC: Pierrot Yarns Mjuk [52% cotton, 48% wool; 67 yds / 61m per 1.06 oz. / 30g skein]; color #19 grass green; 1 skein [15g]
- 3.6mm knitting needles (US 5 is the closest equivalent) or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 7 buttons (15mm / approx. 5/8")

Gauge

- in 10cm/4" square: 19 st and 26 rows in stockinette stitch

Finished measurements

- chest 66cm/26"
- back width 30cm/11.8"
- back length 34.5cm/13.6"
- sleeve length 25.5cm/10"

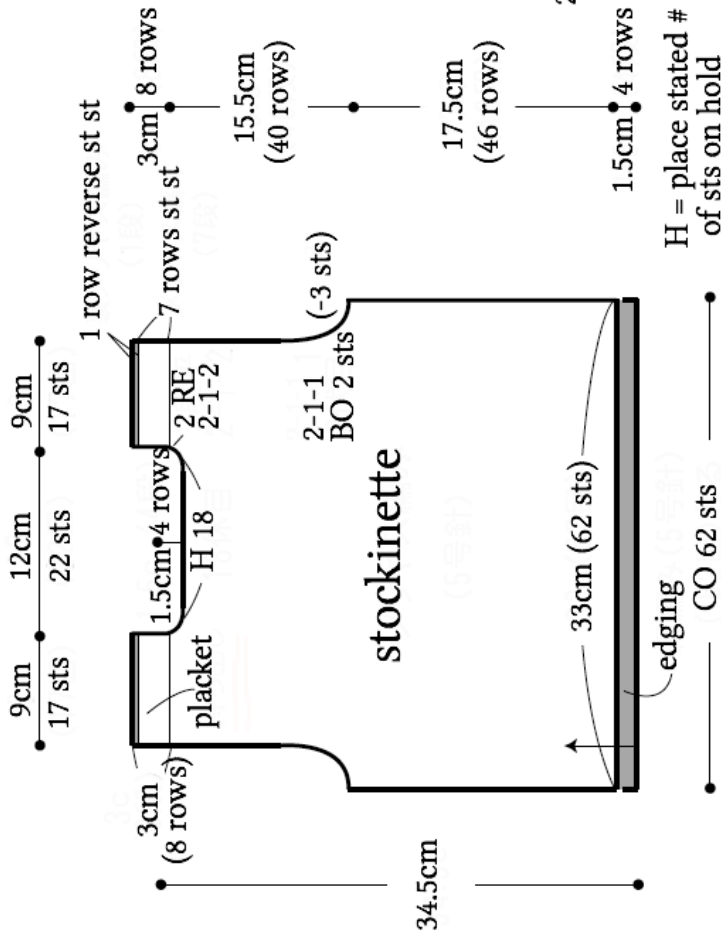
Knitting Tips

Body & sleeves: Cast on and knit in stockinette stitch according to schematic. On back, work plackets (button bands) at shoulders. On both front and back, finish shoulders by working one row reverse stockinette stitch. Bind off on wrong side. Work slip stitch around collar. On sleeves, work twisted increases one stitch in from edge.

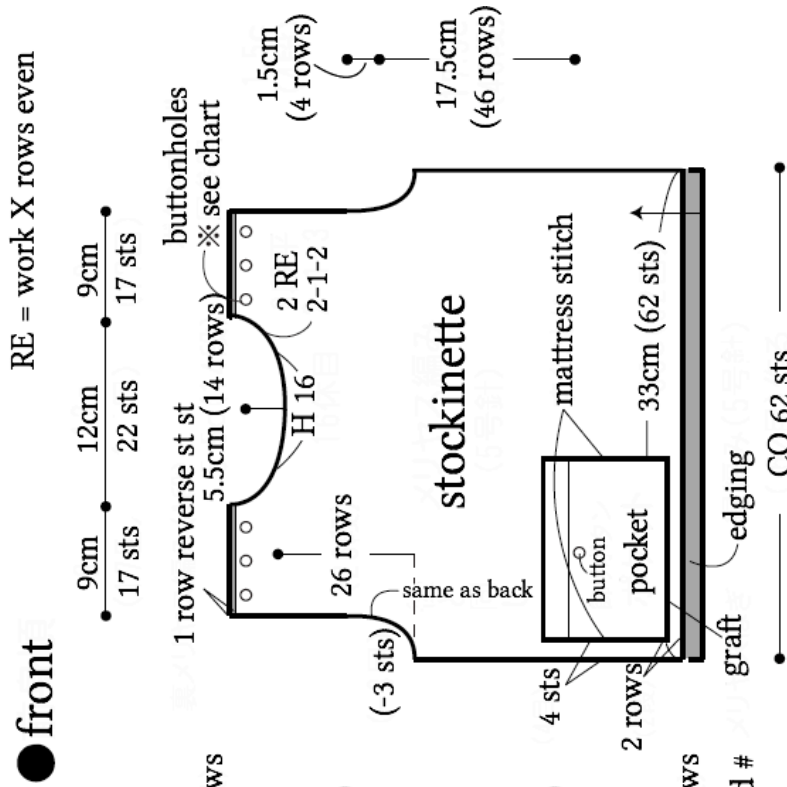
Pocket: Cast on and knit in stripes (stockinette) according to schematic. Knit the last 4 rows in k1p1 ribbing and bind off in pattern. Join sides of pocket to front of sweater with mattress stitch, and graft bottom of pocket to body of sweater.

Finishing: Seam sleeves and sides using mattress stitch. Align back and front shoulders, taking care to center buttonholes above plackets, then work slip stitch seam. Work one row of reverse stockinette at collar, then bind off from wrong side. Sew on buttons.

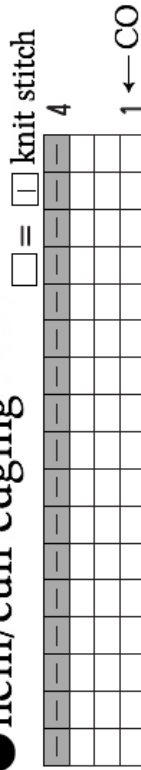

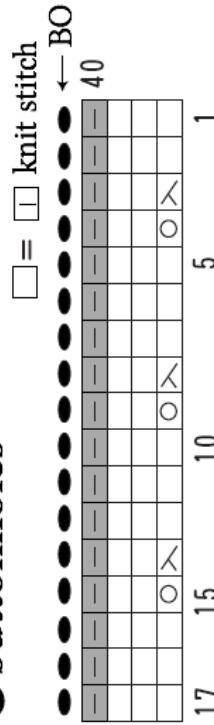
● **front**



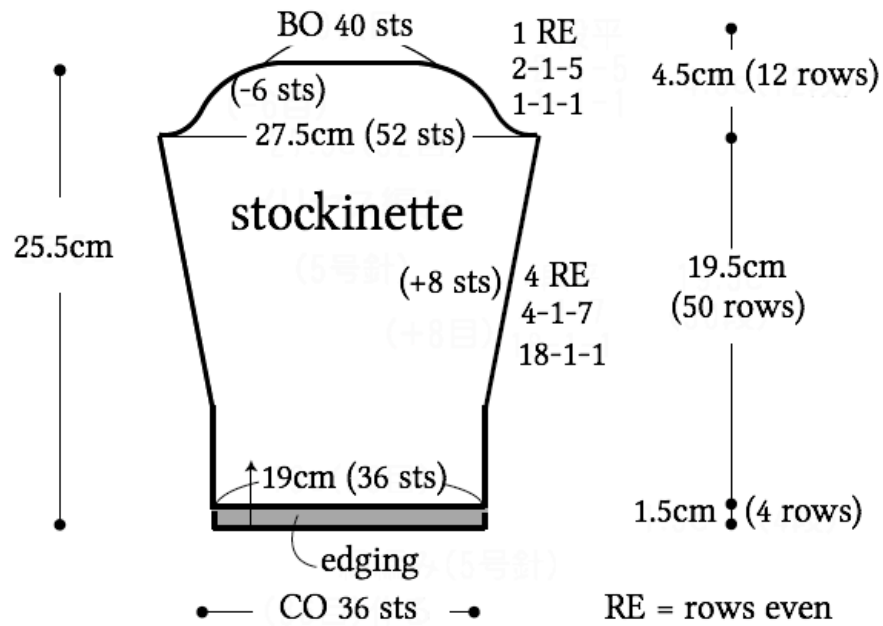
● **hem/cuff edging**



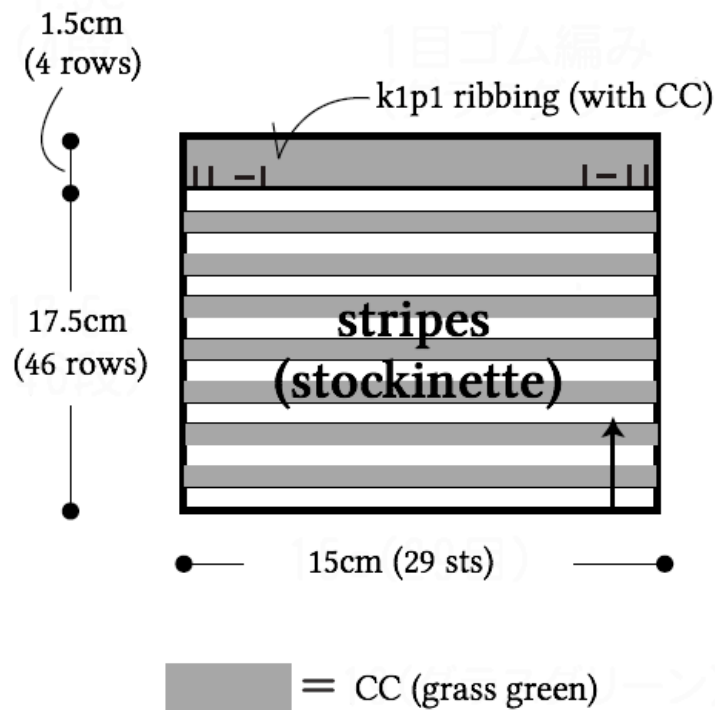
● **buttonholes**



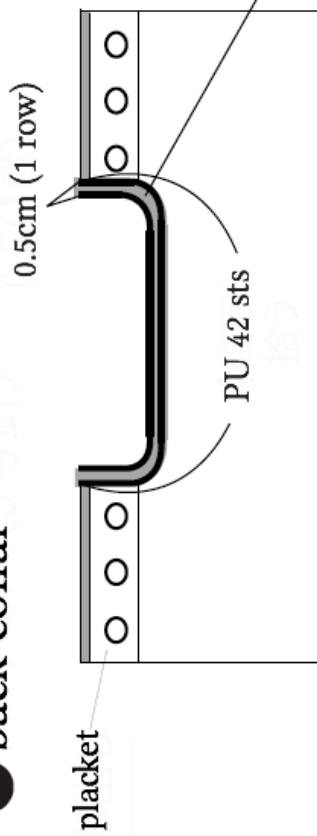
● sleeve



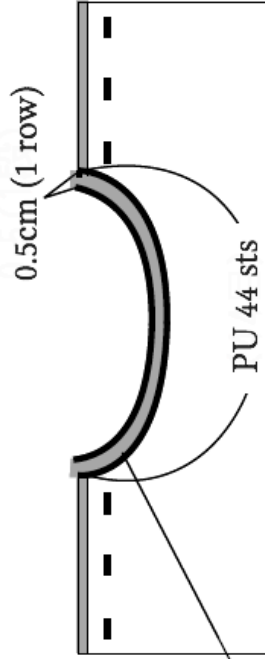
● pocket
