

29-6 Flare-sleeve Pullover

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Sawayaka Cotton [100% cotton; 416 yds/380 m per 3.5 oz / 100g cone];
 - MC: color #8 smoke blue; 1 cone [90g]
 - C1: color #13 maroon; 1 cone [80g]
 - C2: color #16 pink; 1 cone [80g]
 - C3: color #26 artichoke; 1 cone [80g]
- 2.3mm crochet hook or size needed to achieve gauge; US B is closest equivalent

Gauge

- in 10cm/4" square, 29 st and 12 rows in pattern stitch

Finished measurements

- bust 88cm/34.6"
- back width 34cm/13.4"
- back length 58.5cm/23"
- sleeve length 34.5cm/13.6"

Crochet Tips

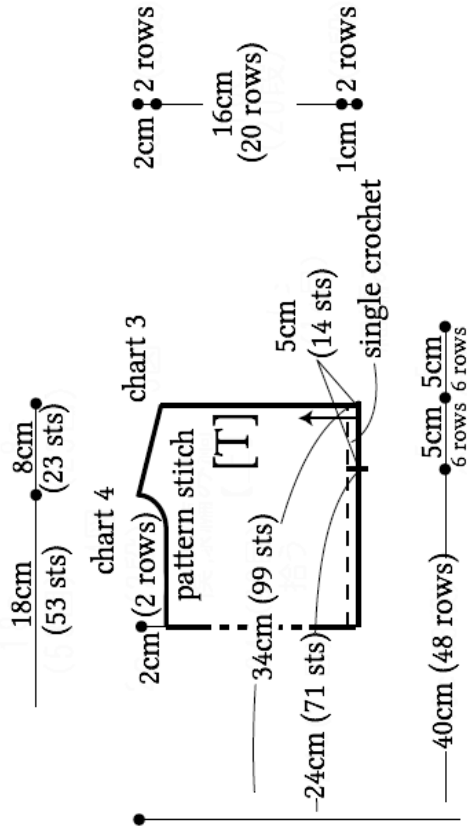
Body: Cast on using C2 and crochet bottom [B] portion side-to-side according to schematics. Gather fabric from places marked in schematic with ★ and work sc according to schematic. Crochet top [T] portion according to schematic.

Sleeves: Work each sleeve according to the same procedure as the front and back, gathering fabric on the bottom [B] portion and continuing to top [T] portion.

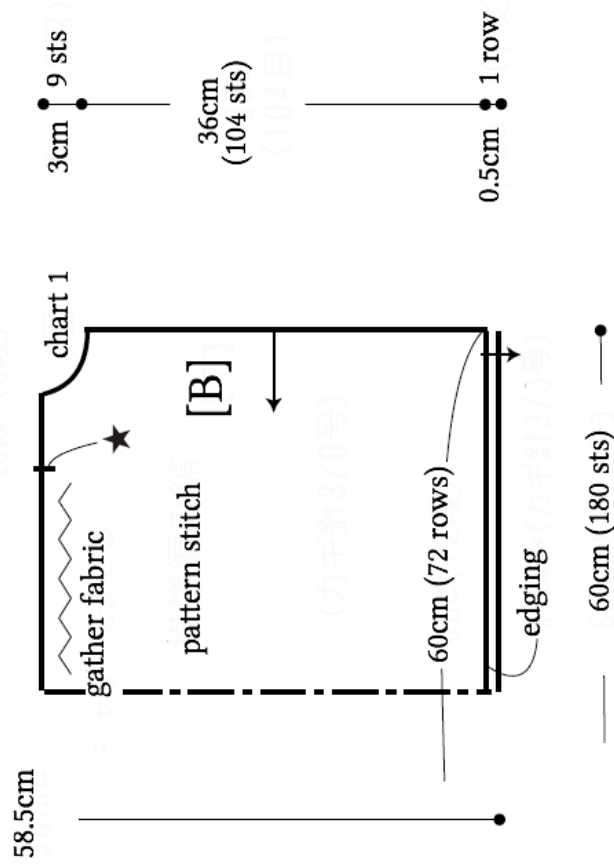
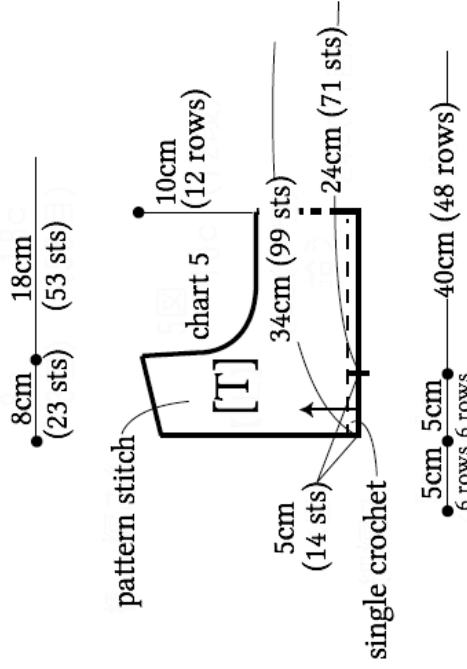
Finishing: Join shoulders with whipstitch, being sure to match up stripes. Join sides and seam underneath sleeves using whipstitch. Use whipstitch to join sleeves to body. Work edging around hem, armholes, and neckline using MC according to chart.

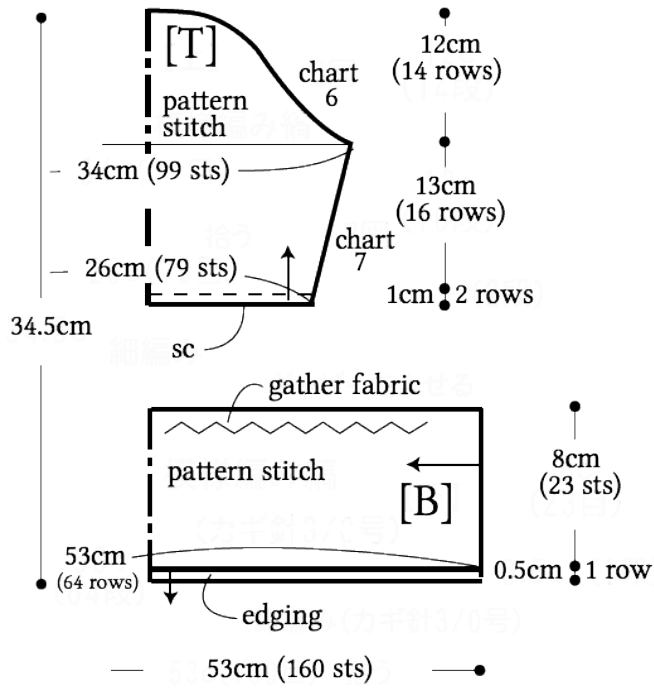

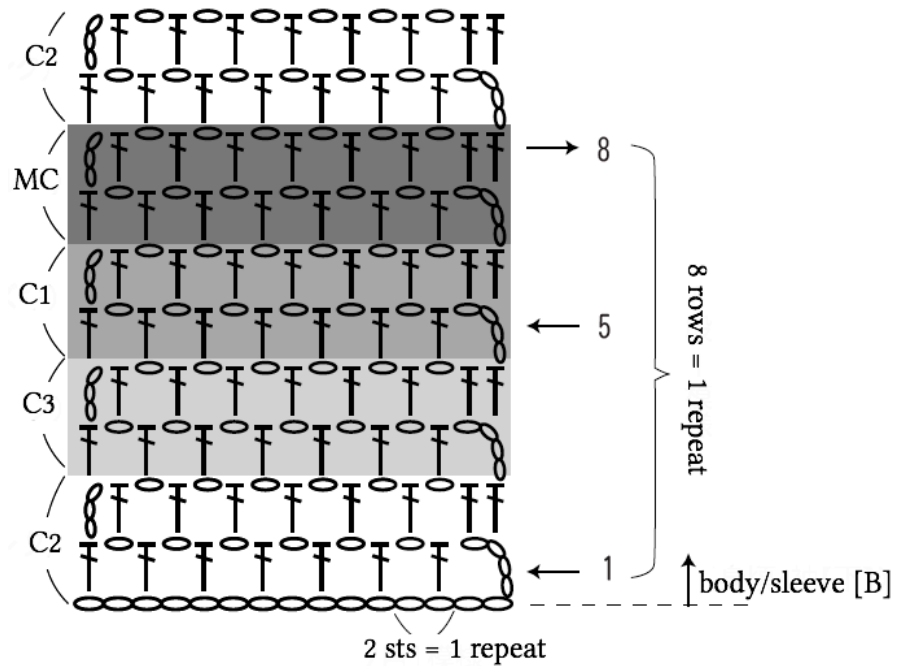
※ Work bottom [B] first, then gather fabric and work top [T].

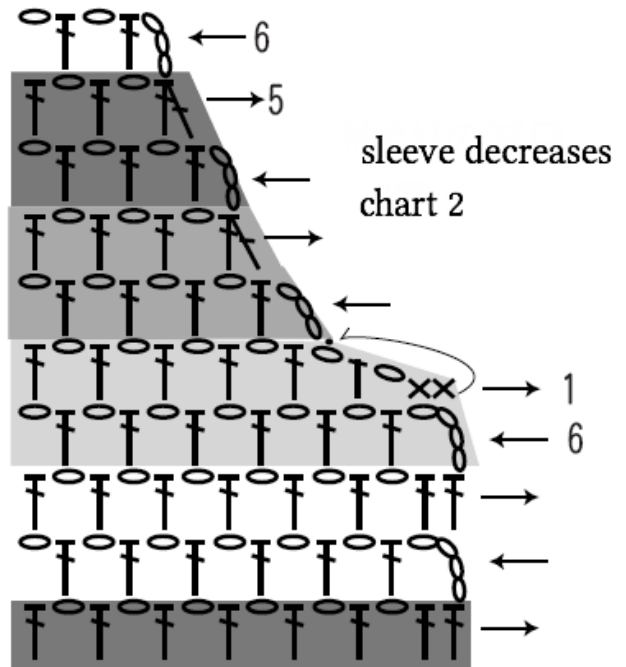
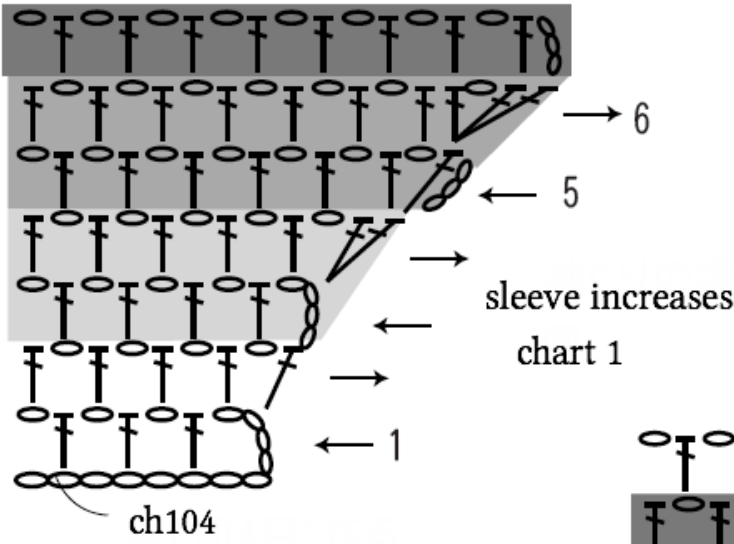

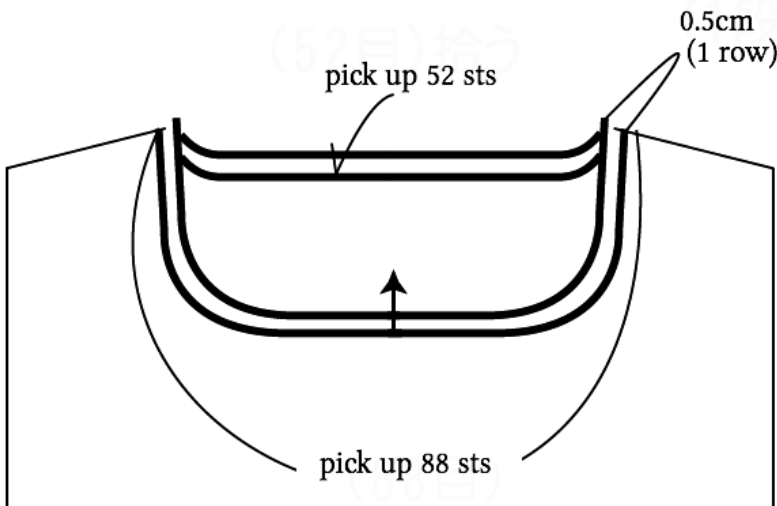
※ Use MC for all edging.

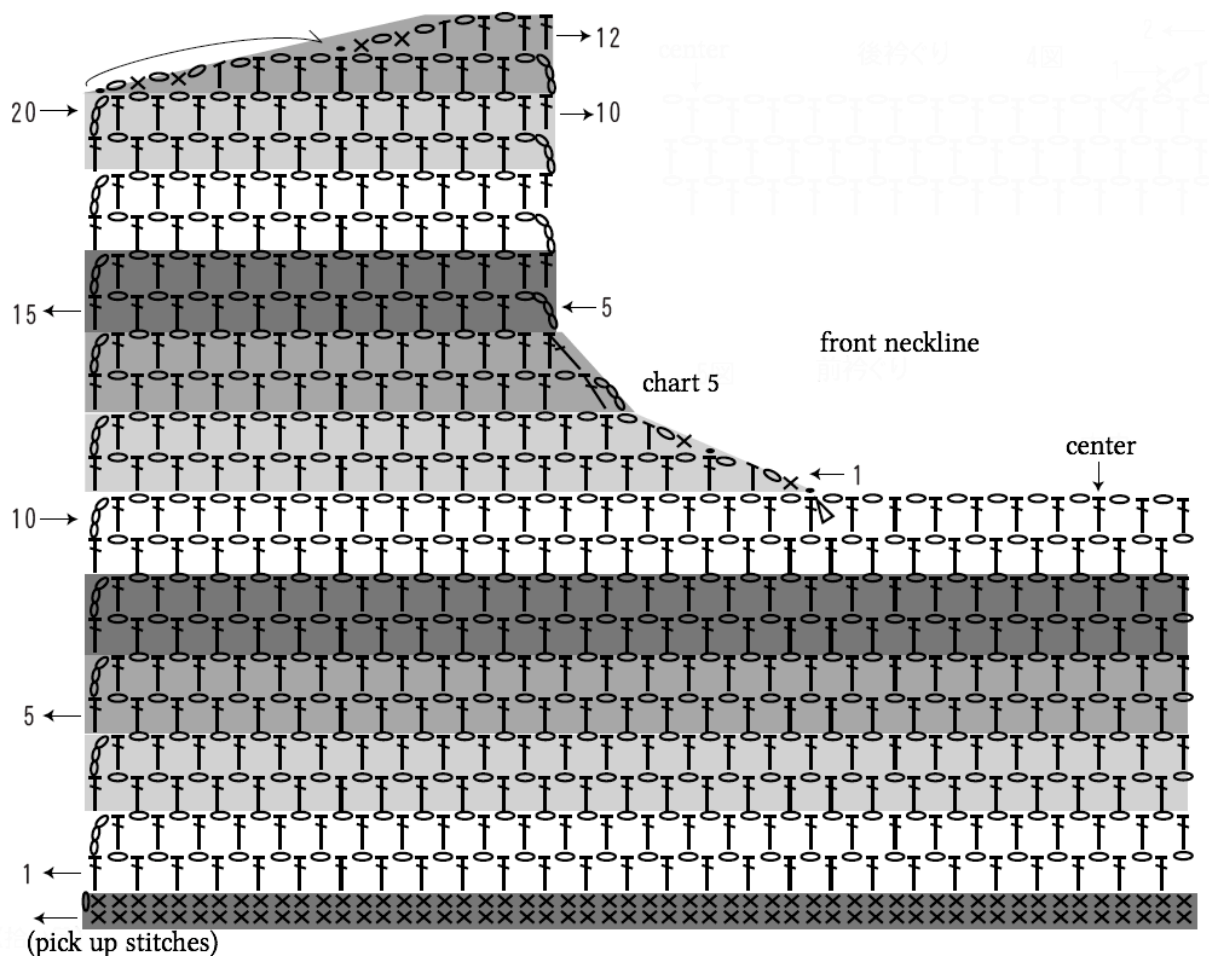
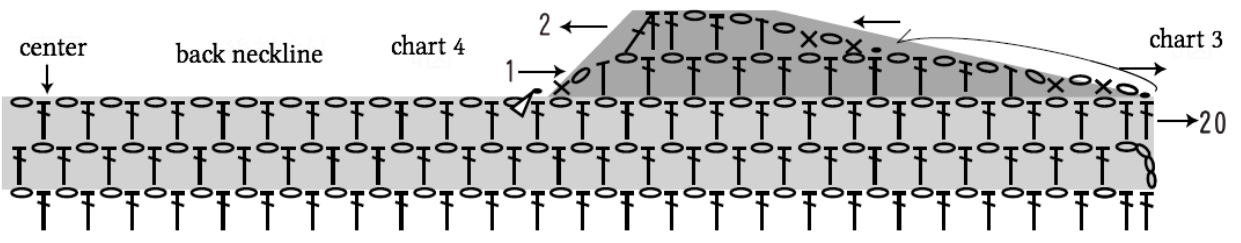
● pattern stitch
