

29-22 UV Armwarmers

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Saratto UV [60% acrylic, 40% cotton; 79 yds / 72m per 1.06 oz / 30g skein]; color #4; 4 skeins [105g]
- 2.5mm (US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 buttons (15mm / approx. 5/8")

Gauge

- pattern stitch A: 21 sts and 14.5 rows = 10cm/4" square
- pattern stitch B: 5 pattern repeats plus 1 st = 8cm/3.1" wide; 14.5 rows = 10cm/4" tall

Finished measurements

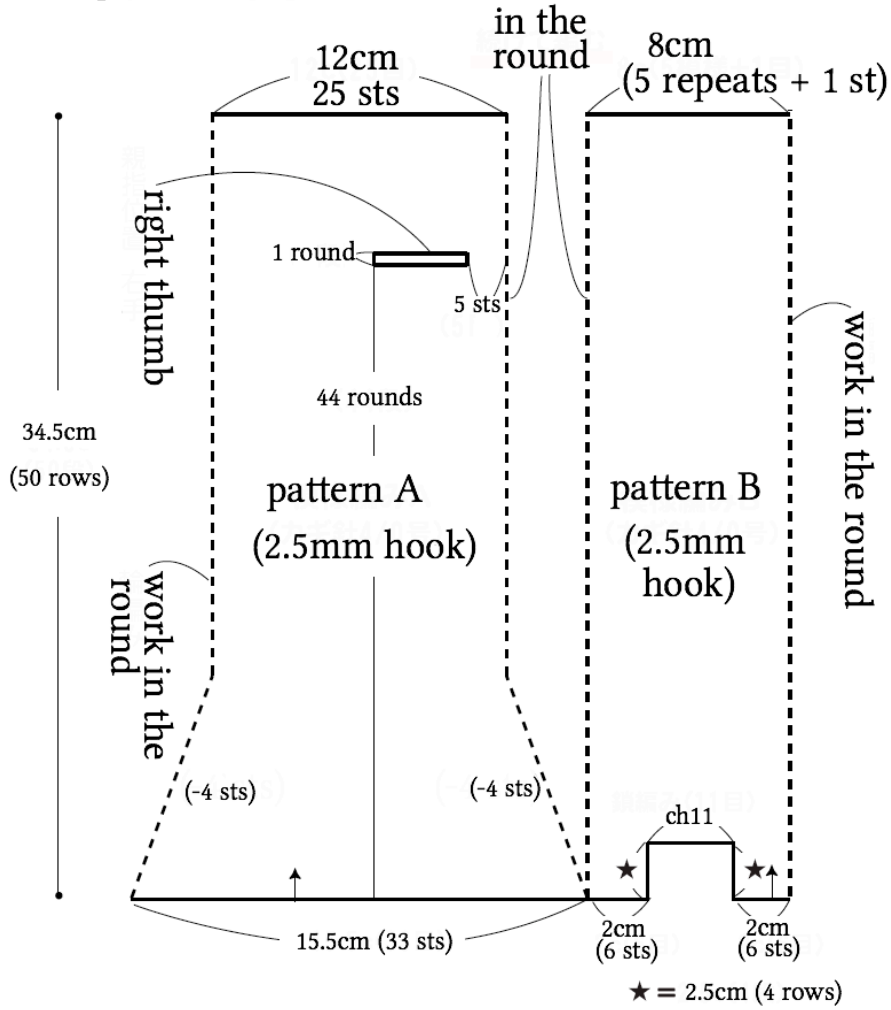
- palm circumference 23.5cm/9.3"
- length 36.5cm/14.4"

Crochet Tips

Belt: Create chain and work through back loop for row 1. Crochet the belt in rows (i.e., work flat, *not* in the round).

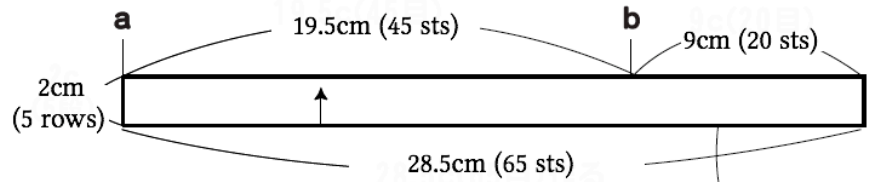
Body of gloves: Working into last row of belt, work through row 4 in rows (i.e., work flat). Begin working in the round starting from round 5. Work holes for thumbs as you go. Attach buttons.

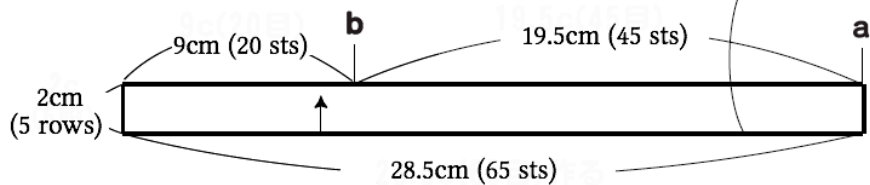


● belt (2.5mm hook) pattern C

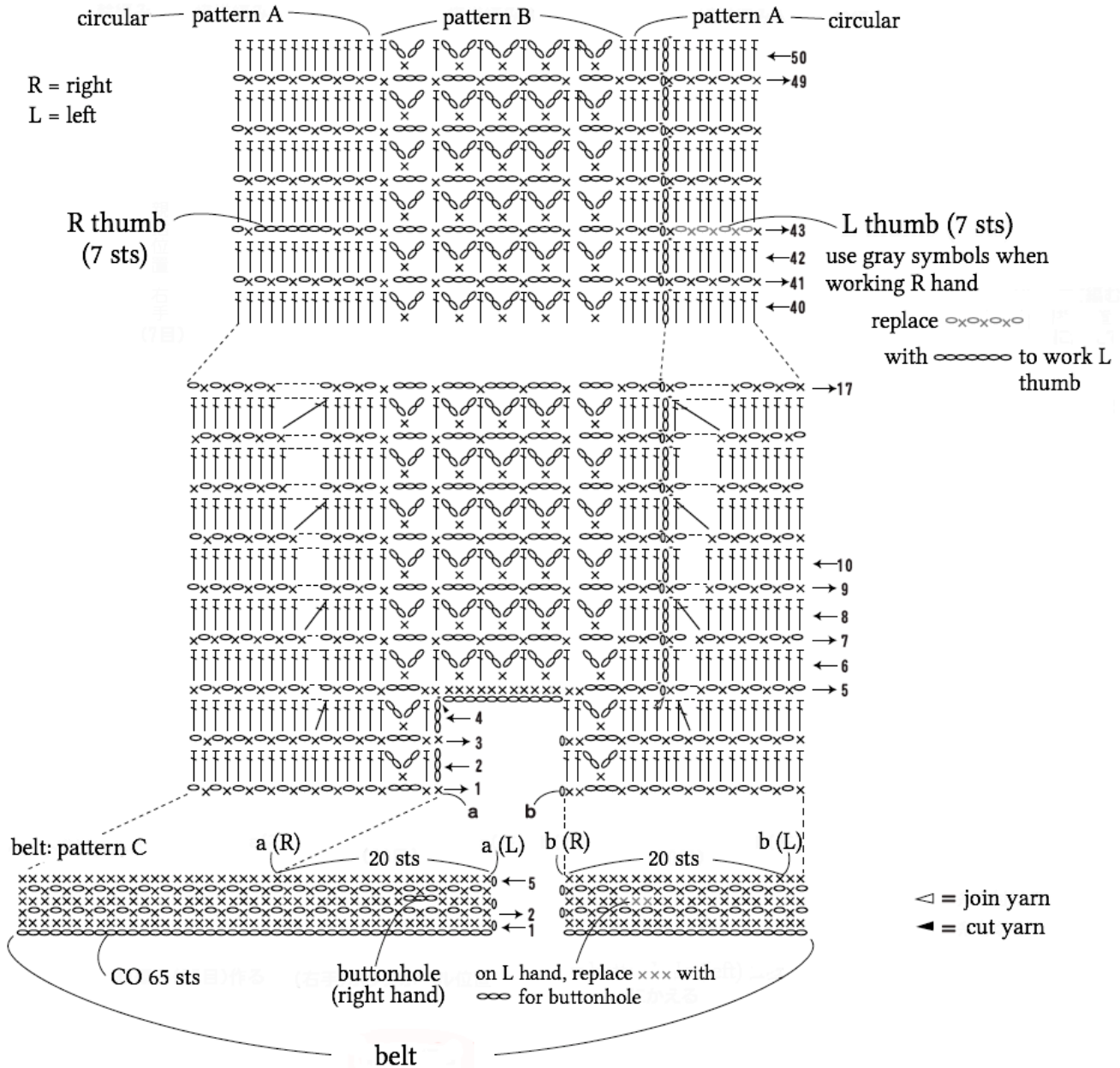
right belt



left belt



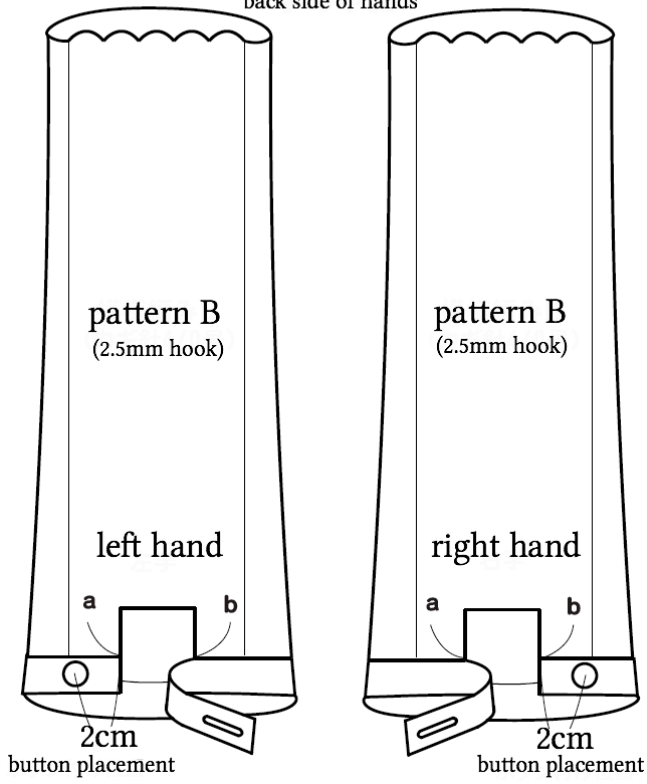
※ work left and right armwarmers symmetrically (2.5mm hook)



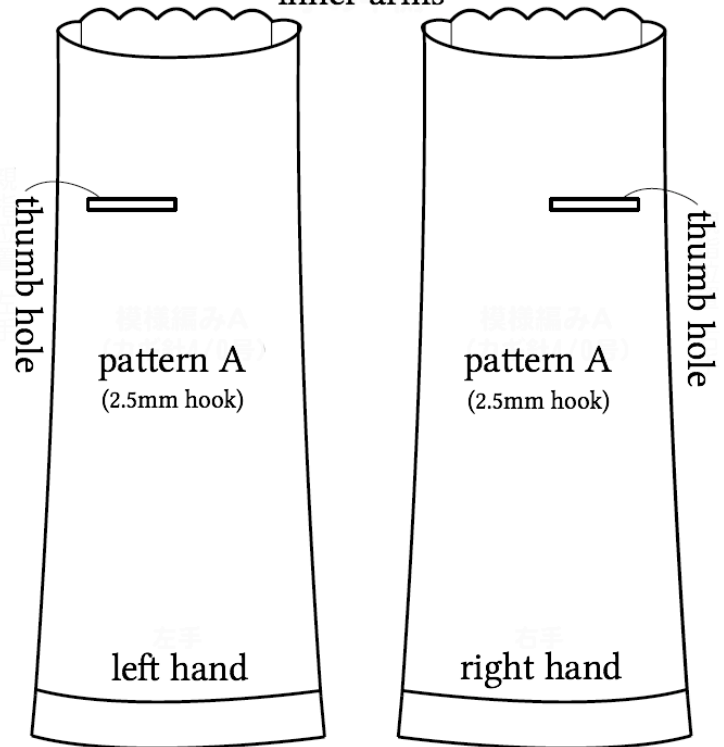
Work symbols in gray (for buttonholes in belt and hand sections, respectively) *for the right hand only*. (They appear in gray only to indicate where to place buttonholes in the left-hand armwarmer.) When working the left hand, replace gray symbols with stitches indicated in diagram.
