

23-5 Bobble-sleeve Sweater

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Sawayaka Cotton [1005 cotton; 416 yds / 380m per 3.53 oz. / 100g cone]; color #13 maroon; 3 cones [220g]
- standard-gauge knitting machine (4.5mm needle pitch) *or* knitting needles necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- stockinette stitch: 31 sts and 41 rows
- pattern stitch: 40 sts and 17.5 rows

Finished measurements

- bust 96cm/37.8"
- cross back width 37cm/14.6"
- length 53cm/20.9"
- sleeve length 12.5cm/4.9"

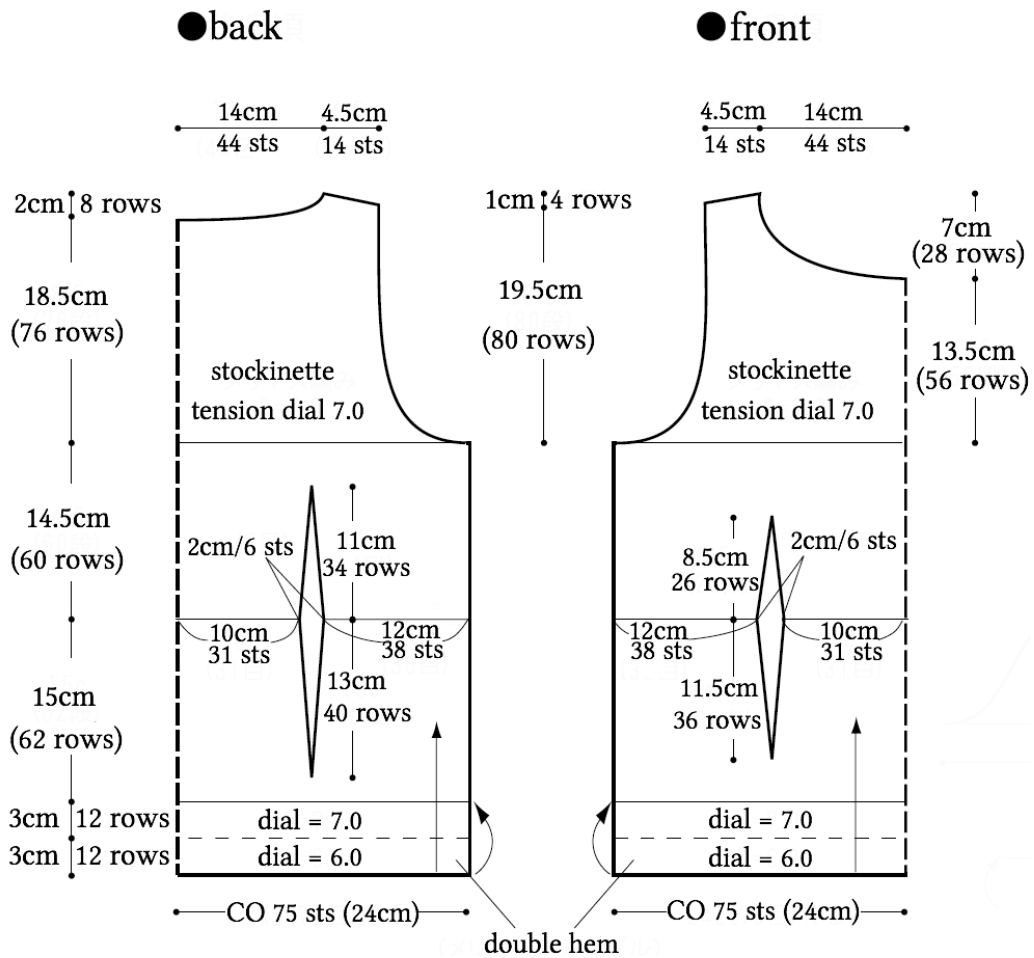
Knitting Tips

Body: Cast on using with waste yarn; knit one row with ravel cord, then change to main yarn. Knit a simple hem (also known as double hem): knit required number of rows, fold along dotted line, and knit stitches of cast-on row together with stitches on needles. Bind off armhole and neckline stitches and place shoulder stitches on hold.

Collar: Place front and back of right shoulder on needles with right sides facing and bind off all stitches. Repeat for left shoulder. Work crochet edging around neckline.

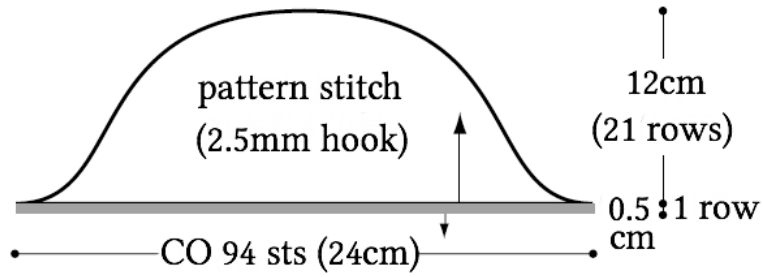
Sleeves: Crochet in pattern stitch according to schematics.

Finishing: Join sides with mattress stitch, and attach sleeves to body with slip stitch.

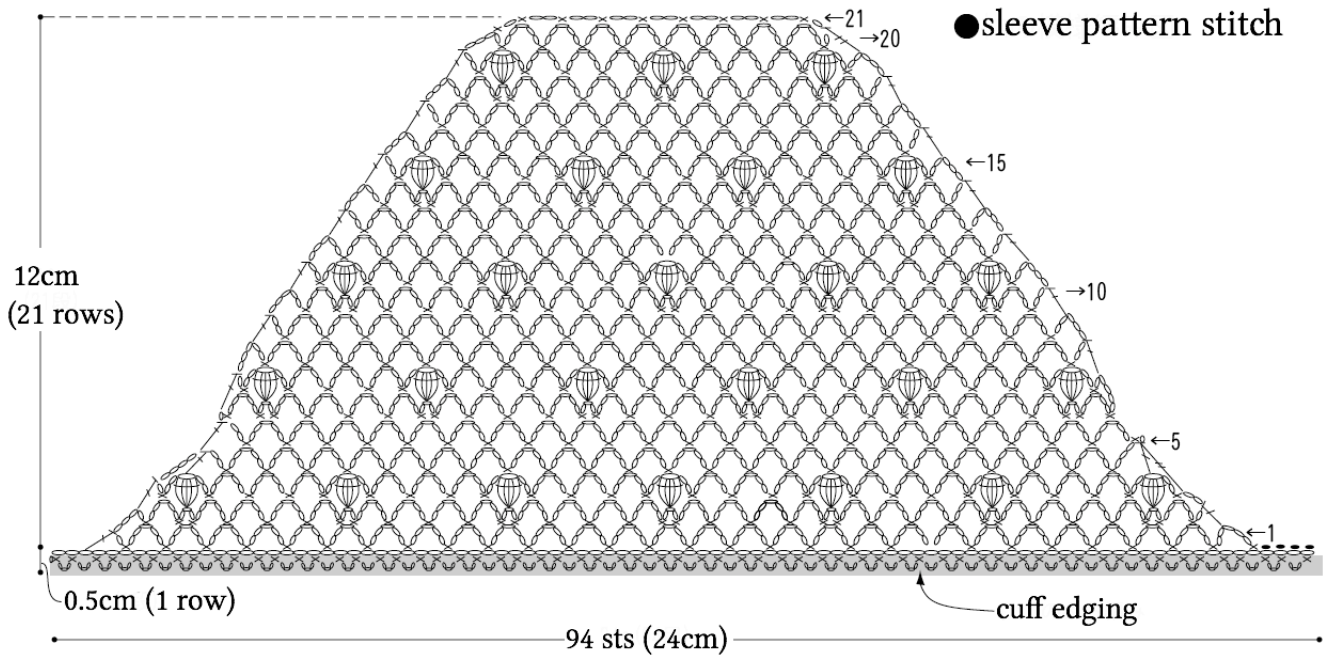


← Fold on dotted line. On wrong side of fabric, knit stitches of cast-on row together with stitches of row represented by solid line.

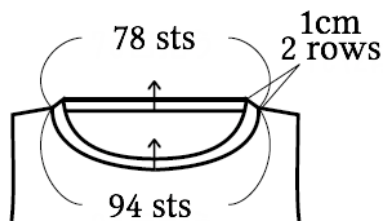
● sleeve
