

26-10 Mohair Pullover

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Kid Pure [61% kid mohair, 31% nylon, 8% wool; 246 yds / 225m per 0.88 oz. / 25g skein]; color #3; 3 skeins [70g] – *discontinued*
- Pierrot Yarns Super Kid Pure [75% kid mohair, 25% nylon; 306 yds / 280m per 0.88 oz. / 25g skein]; color #5801; 3 skeins [70g] – *discontinued*
- 5.1mm (US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- pattern stitch A: 17 sts and 22 rows = 10cm/4" square
- pattern stitch B: 14 sts and 22 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- bust: one size fits most
- middle of back to end of sleeve 58cm/22.8"
- length 58cm/22.8"

Knitting Tips

Body (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on and knit in pattern stitch A according to schematics, working first one sleeve, body, and then second sleeve. Work twisted increases (one stitch in from the edge) at top crease of sleeve. Knit neck opening without increasing or decreasing. For second sleeve, work decreases (also one stitch in from the edge). (Thread waste yarn in contrasting color through stitches at neck opening and hem to make picking up stitches later easier.) Pick up stitches from hem and work in pattern stitch A. Bind off in pattern.

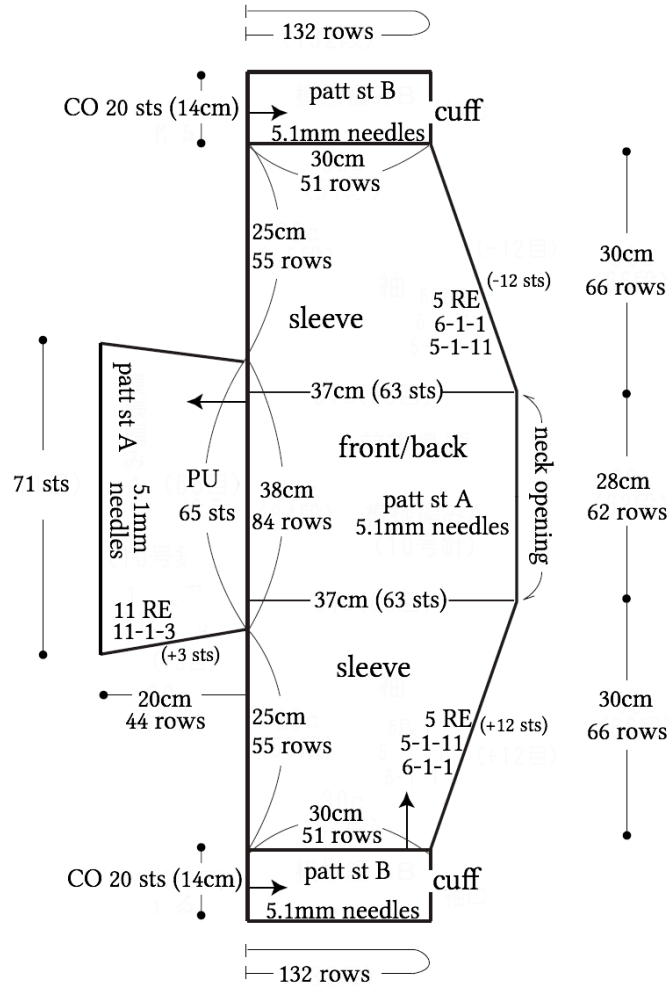
Sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on and knit in pattern stitch B, forming a scalloped edge. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam top sleeve crease with mattress stitch. Seam cuff to sleeve (stitches-to-rows) with scalloped edge facing outward. Seam sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Graft first and last row of sleeve cuffs. Crochet edging in the round at neckline and hem.

❖**Note:** entire garment is worked with one strand of each yarn held together.

Abbreviations: CO = cast on; PU = pick up; RE = row(s) even
