

27-13 Frill Pullover

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Shine Lamé [52% polyester, 20% cotton, 28% rayon; 83 yds/76m per 1.06 oz. / 30g skein]; color #2; 11 skeins [330g] – *discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute*
- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.3mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) circular knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- pattern stitch: 23 sts and 33 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- length 56.5cm/22.24"
- cross back width 35cm/13.78"
- sleeve length 42cm/16.54"

Knitting Tips

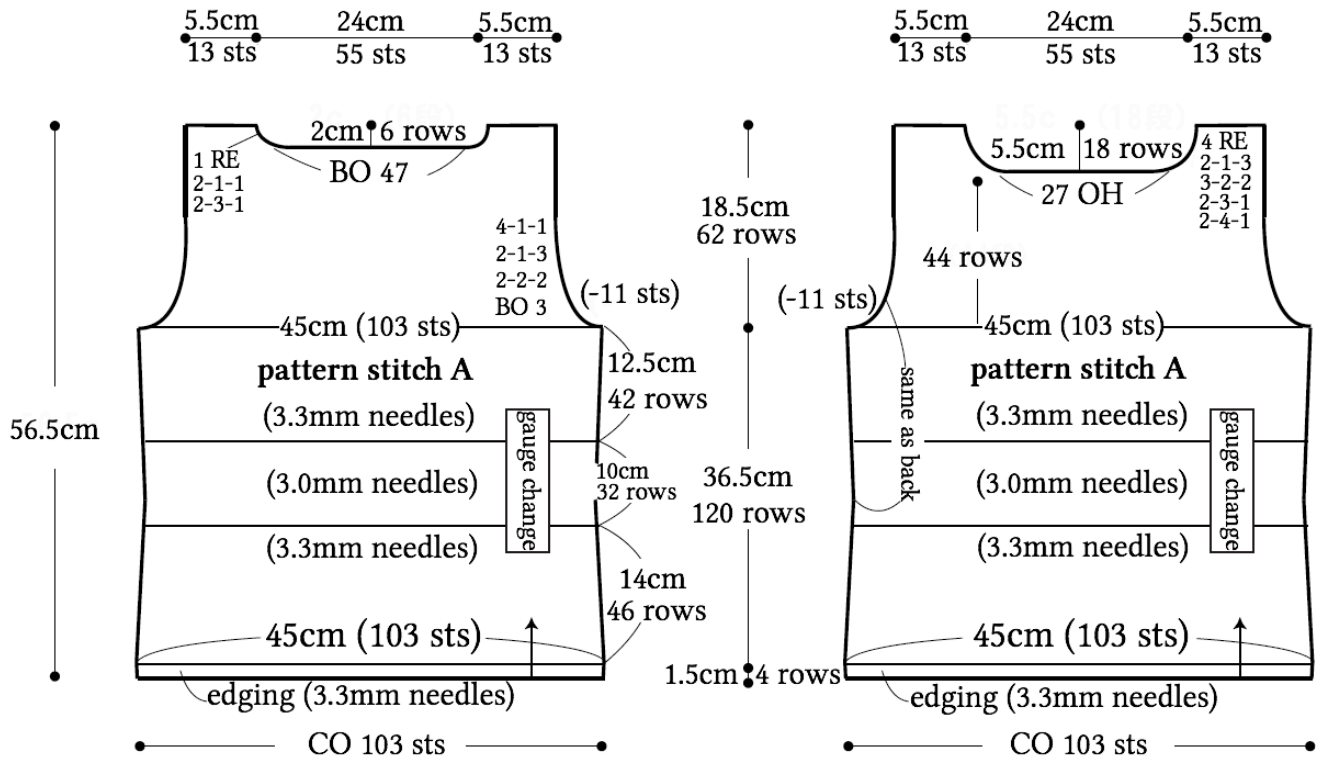
Body and sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on and knit hem edging, then continue on to pattern stitch A. Decrease at armholes and neckline by binding off stitches and working fully fashioned decreases (1 stitch in from edge) as indicated. Knit sleeve in pattern stitch A like the body. For sleeve shaping, use fully fashioned decreases (1 stitch in from edge) and increase with make one increases (1 stitch in from edge).

Finishing: Join shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Pick up stitches around neckline and knit collar in pattern stitch B. On the reverse side, crochet in pattern stitch C and sew down such that it does not show through on the right side. Join sleeves to body with slip stitch.

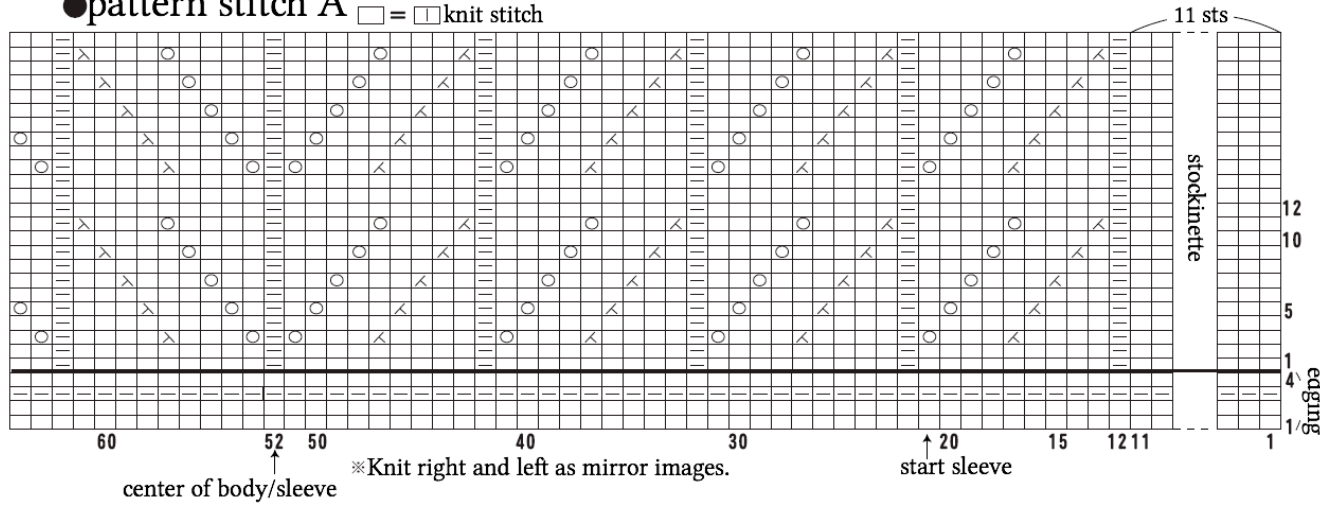
Abbreviations: CO = cast on; BO = bind off; PU = pick up; RE = row(s) even; OH = on hold

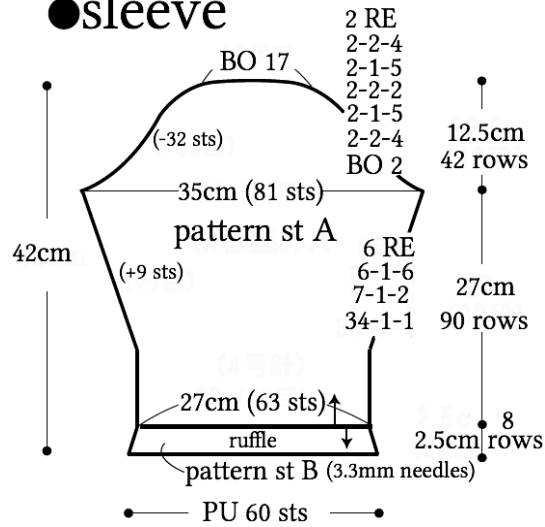

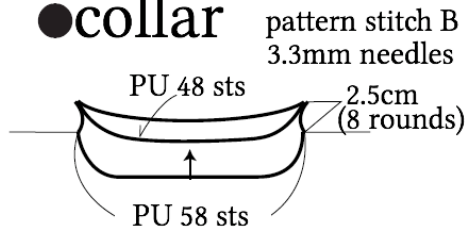
●pattern stitch A □ = □ knit stitch



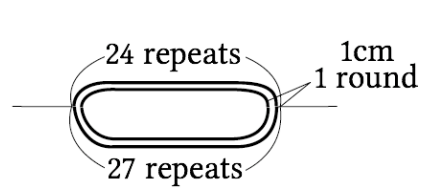
●sleeve



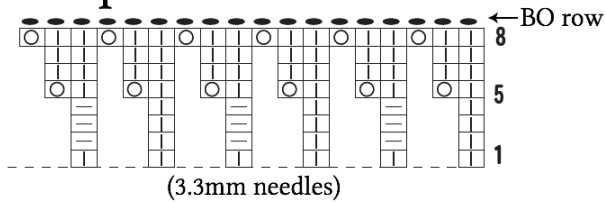
●collar
