

27-28 Cap-sleeve Girl's Pullover

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Honwaka [100% cotton; 120 yds/110m per 1.23 oz./35g skein]; color #83 beige; 4 skeins [110g]
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) circular knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- stockinette stitch: 26 sts and 32 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- chest 68cm/26.77"
- cross back width 24cm/9.45"
- length 40.5cm/15.94"
- sleeve length 7.5cm/2.95"

Knitting Tips

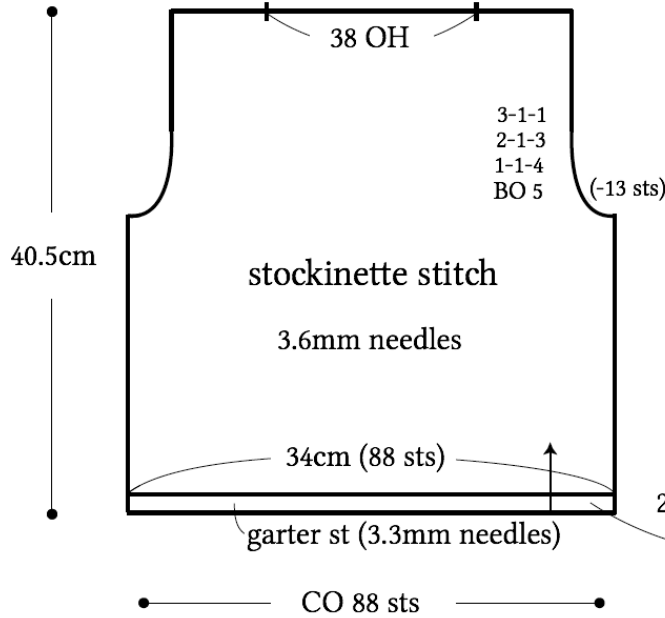
Body and sleeves: With crochet hook, chain to cast on. Pulling up stitches through bottom loops of chain, knit 6 rows of garter stitch. Continue by knitting stockinette stitch. For front only, insert pattern stitch panel at center. Knit sleeves in garter stitch and stockinette stitch. Shape armholes by binding off stitches and decreasing (using k2tog at right edge and ssk at left edge). Place stitches at neckline on stitch holders.

Finishing: Join shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Work collar by picking up stitches around neckline (including stitches on hold) and knitting in garter stitch. Bind off loosely in pattern from wrong side. Join sleeves to body with slip stitch, sewing tucks at sleeve caps while doing so.

Abbreviations: BO = bind off; CO = cast on; OH = on hold; PU = pick up

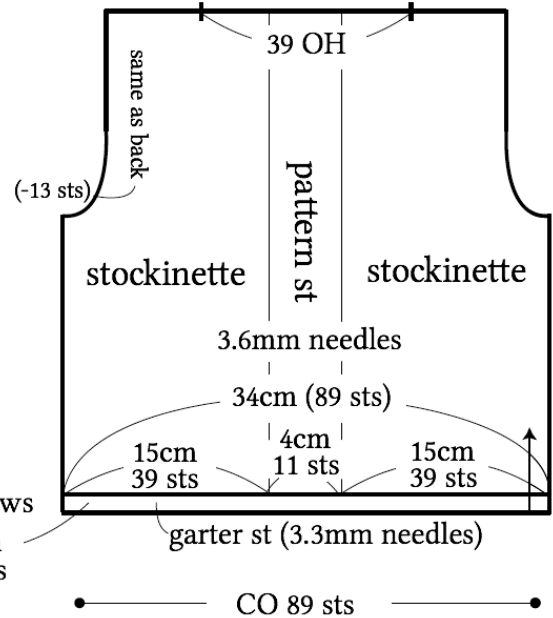

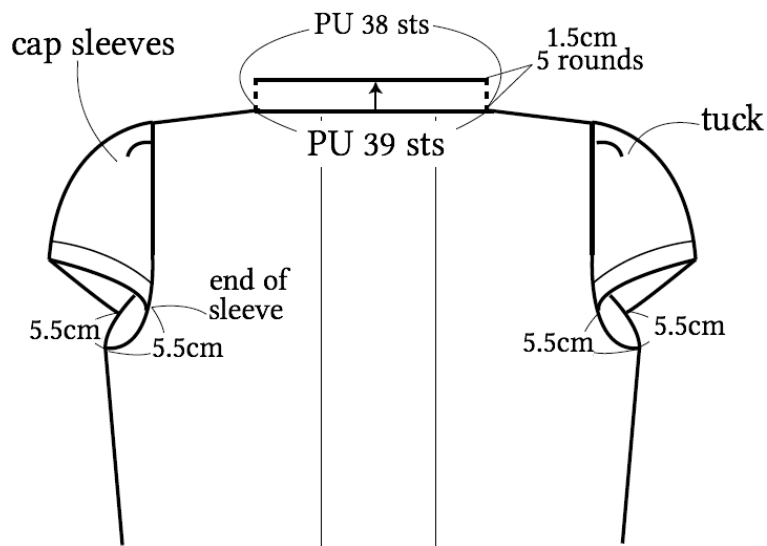

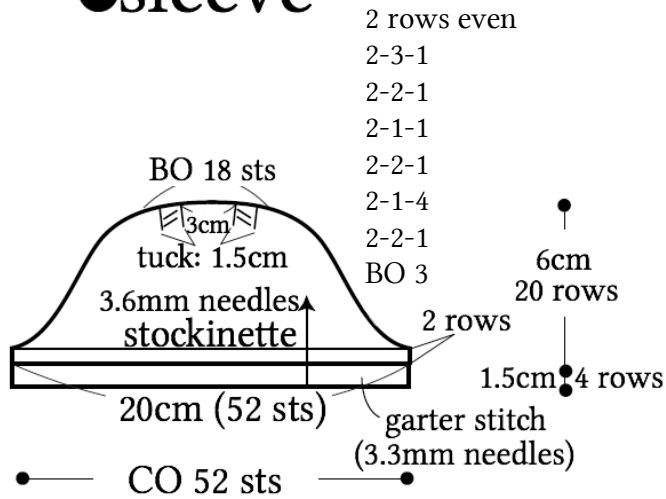


●collar
