

2728-OMO49 Dot Wool Bag

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Dot Wool [100% wool; 558 yds/510m per 3.53 oz./100g cone];
 - MC: color #13 deep brown; 1 cone [100g]
 - CC1: color #5 deep rose pink; 1 cone [40g]
 - CC2: color #6 amethyst; 1 cone [40g]
 - CC3: color #9 emerald blue; 1 cone [15g]
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 pair leather purse straps
- 1 button (20mm / approx. 0.79")

Gauge

- pattern stitch: 23 sts and 30 rows = 10cm/4" square

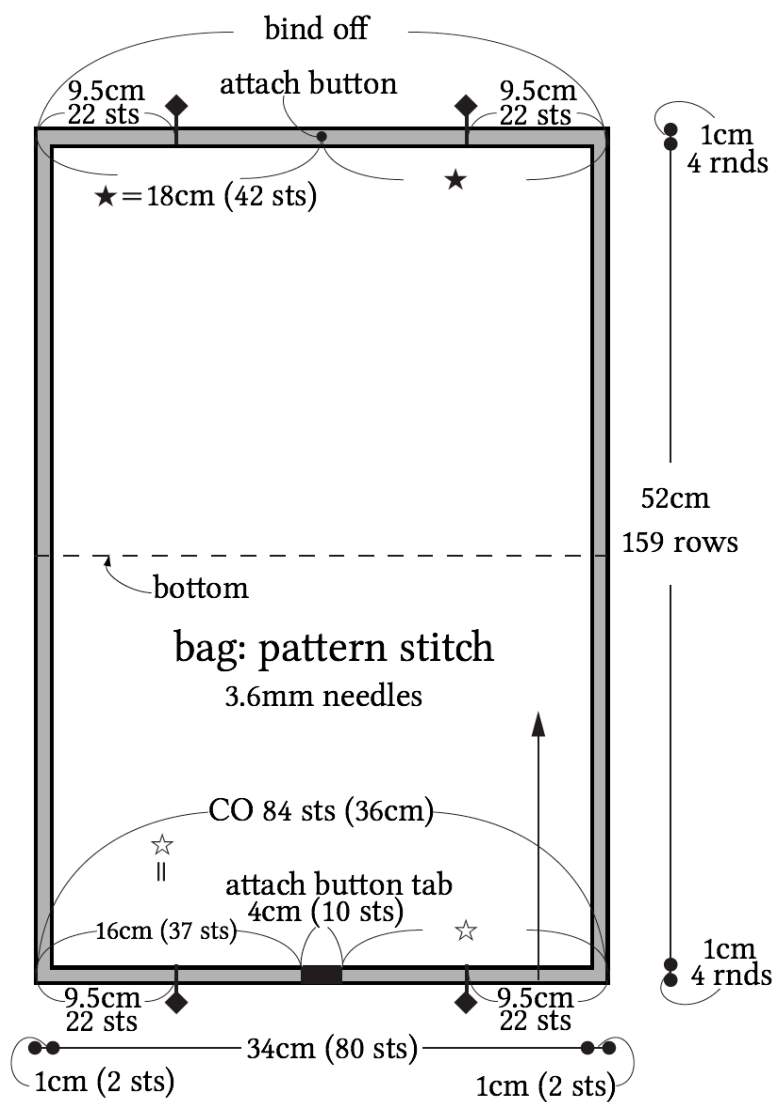
Finished measurements

- width 36cm/14.17"
- length (not including straps) 27cm/10.63"

Knitting Tips

- Cast on by working a chain with crochet hook. Pick up stitches from bottom loops of chain and begin knitting. Knit in intarsia according to schematics, carrying yarn sideways. When finished, bind off in pattern.
- With wrong sides facing, seam left and right sides with mattress stitch.
- Cast on for button tab using the same crochet chain cast-on method used for body of bag. Knit according to schematics.
- Attach button tab, button, and straps to designated locations.

Abbreviations: CO = cast on; rnd(s) = round(s)

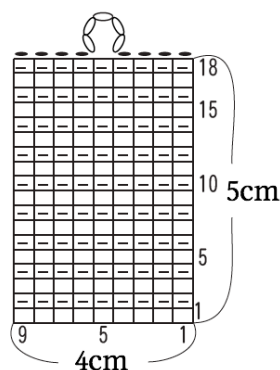


■ = garter stitch, 3 strands of MC
