# 23-8 Sleeveless Sweater

### Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Silk Ramie [70% ramie, 30% silk; 547 yds/500m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #10; 3 cones [260g]
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 2½), 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) circular knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

### Gauge

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

• stockinette stitch: 26 sts and 35 rows

#### Finished measurements

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- length 51cm/20.08"

## **Knitting** Tips


**\*Note**: entire garment worked with two strands of yarn held together.

**Body and armholes**: Make hem by casting on with crochet provisional cast-on method and working in stockinette stitch. Fold hem to wrong side, join, and continue on to body. Shape sides with fully fashioned decreases (worked 1 stitch in from edge) and lifted increases. Work yoke in twisted k1p1 rib, adjusting gauge by changing needle sizes as indicated.

Collar: Pick up stitches from neckline and work decreases evenly spaced around.

Finishing: Join sides with mattress stitch. Work twisted k1p1 rib at armscye edges.

Abbreviations: BO = bind off; CO = cast on; N = neeldes; PU = pick up; RE = row(s) even; st st = stockinette stitch



\* Only first half of hem uses 1 strand of yarn.
