

27-546B Yuttari Silky Bolero

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Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Yuttari Silky [25% silk, 15% rayon, 60% ramie; 112 yds/102m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #64 ice blue-green; 4 skeins [145g]
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- pattern stitch: 2 pattern repeats and 8 rows = 7.3cm/2.87" square

Finished measurements

- back width 45cm/17.72"
- length 33cm/12.99"

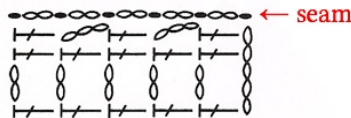
Crochet Tips

Body: Chain to cast on; working first row into bottom loops of chain, work in pattern stitch according to schematics. Join shoulders with woven seam; join sides with slip/chain seam (see below).

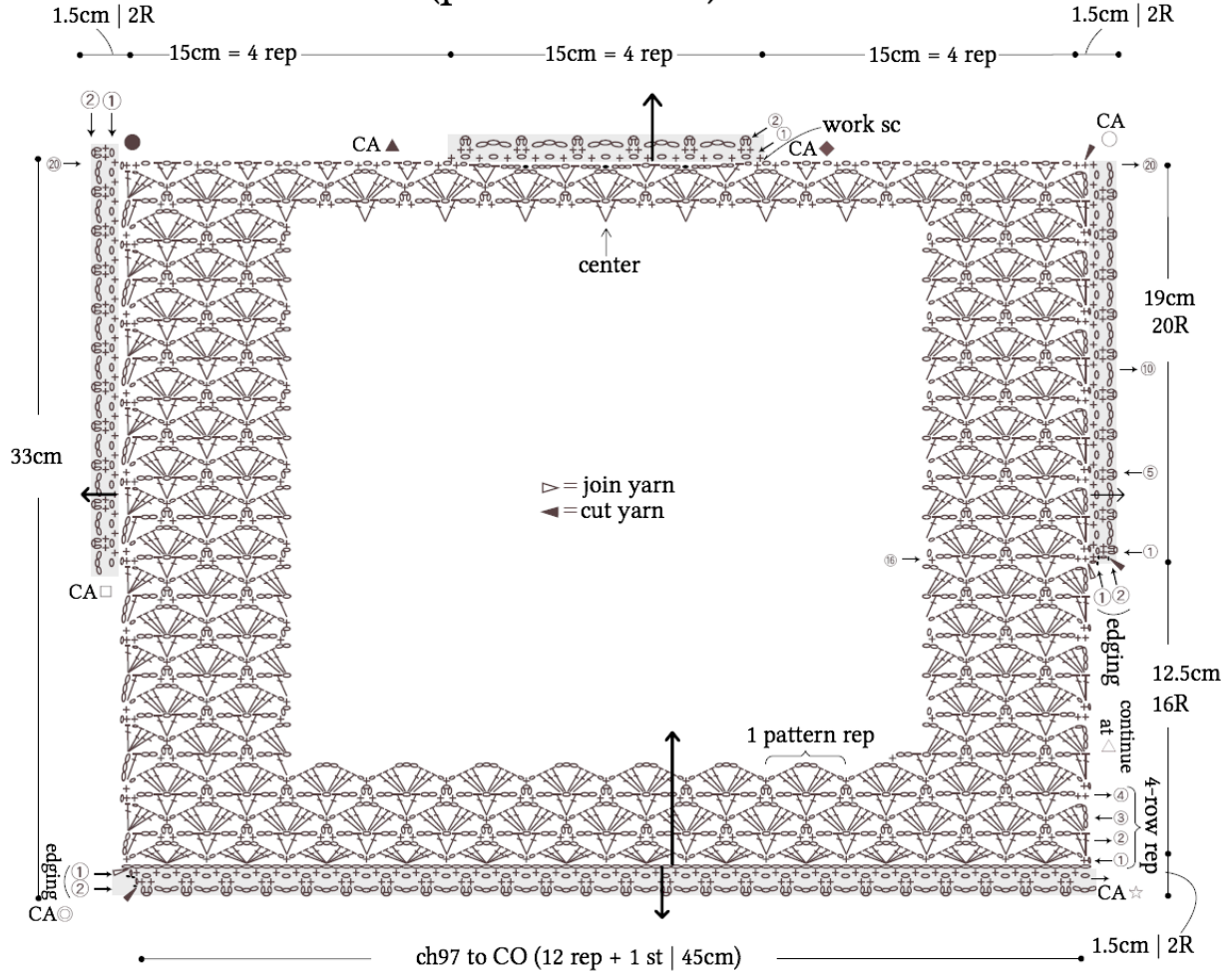
Finishing: Starting at hem, work edging around front, back, and neckline in the round. For the sc in first round of edging, where schematic indicates that you are to continue by working into chain stitch or dc stitch, work sc by picking up entire chain stitch or dc stitch.

Abbreviations: CA = continue at; ch = chain; CO = cast on; dc = double crochet (US); R = row(s)/round(s); rep = pattern repeat(s); sc = single crochet (US)

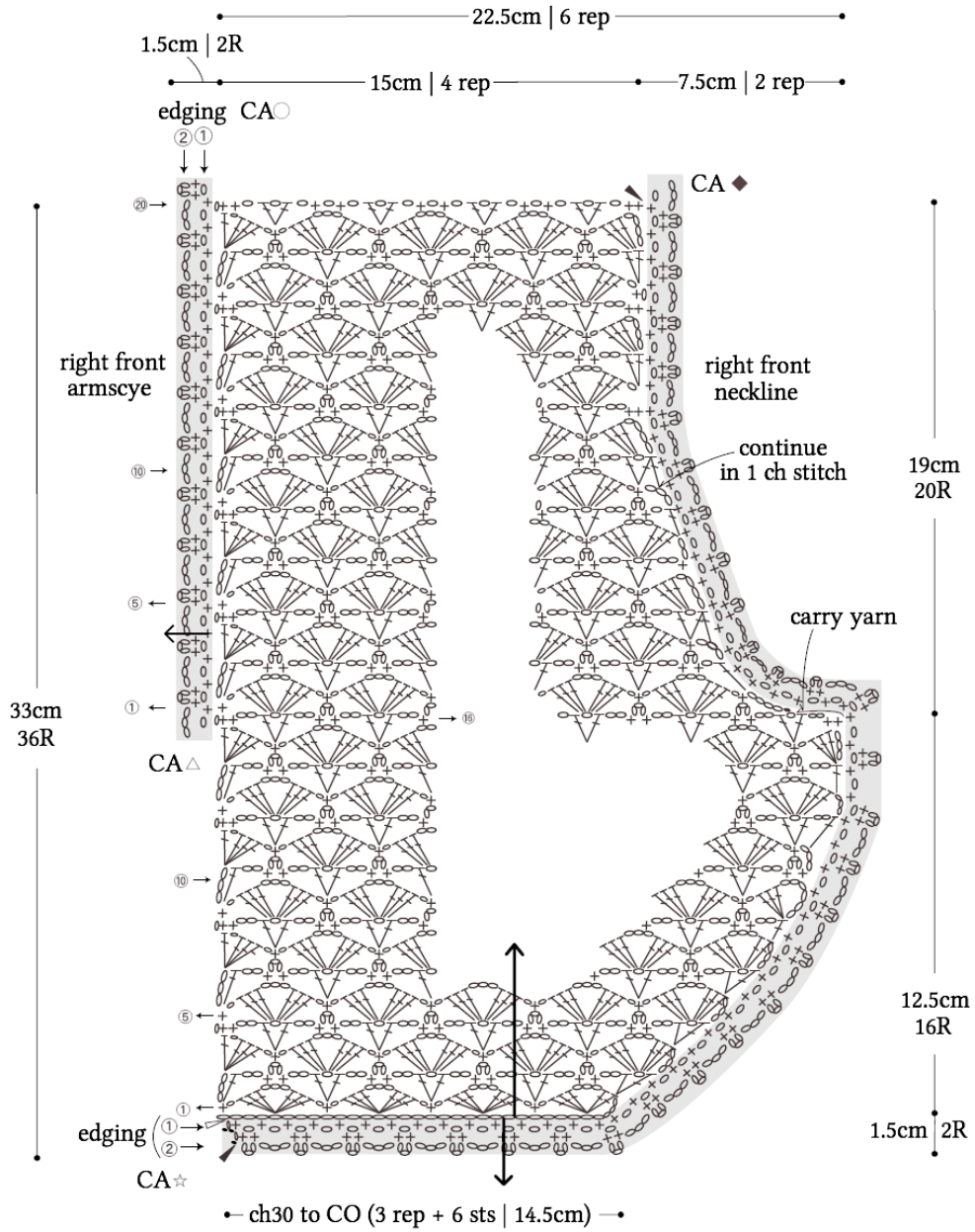
Slip/chain seam: essentially a slip stitch seam with chain stitches interspersed between slip stitches. Sl st through both layers. *ch2, sl st in top of next row*, continue from * to * until end. (Note: use ch2 only for dc. Use ch1 for hdc, ch2 for dc, ch3 for treble, and so on.)
